Minutes of CGSR Meeting #5 on 11/9/2021

The Committee on Graduate Studies and Research (CGSR) held its third meeting of AY '21/'22 on November 9, 2021 (Tuesday) via Zoom.

Prof. Korkin called the meeting to order at 3:01 pm.

- 1. The minutes of meeting #4 were reviewed and approved.
- 2. Discussion item: proposal for four new FBS courses (BUS 631, BUS 632, BUS 633, BUS 651).
 - a. D. Strong (Department Head, The Business School) attended as a guest and presented the motion.
 - b. The proposed courses are intended for students in a growing executive PhD program.
 - c. The committee requested that the originator submit a revised motion addressing questions about expected enrollment, proposed enrollment limitations, and resources needed to teach the proposed courses.
 - d. There was discussion about how much detail a new course motion should contain, and agreement that this should be standardized within CGSR so that petitioners can efficiently supply the information that will be requested.
- 3. Voting item: petition for a graduate student to transfer to WPI.
 - a. D. Strong (Department Head, The Business School) joined the meeting to answer questions regarding the circumstances necessitating a PhD student to transfer to WPI after completing the majority of their degree at another institution.
 - b. The committee voted and approved the petition.
- 4. Voting item: the committee reviewed and approved a motion from the RBE department to add a new course RBE 522: Continuum Robotics with minor edits to the intended audience.
