


RefWorks: Importing Search Results from ISI Web of Knowledge

In [ISI Web of Knowledge](#) databases ([Web of Science](#)), results of a search can be imported into [RefWorks](#).


1. On the **Search Results** screen, select the citations you wish to import into RefWorks by clicking in the checkboxes to the left of the appropriate citations. Click **Add to Marked List**.





2. Click the **Marked List** link near the top of the Search Results page



3. On the output page **leave the bold fields checked**. Make sure the **ISSN** box is checked as this enables WPI's FullTextFinder to work from within your RefWorks account. Check the **Abstract** field if you want to include article abstracts in your RefWorks database.



4. Under "Step 2" make sure the pull-down menu is set to "**Field Tagged**" (the default option.) Then click "**Save to File**" & save file to your computer and remember where's it's saved.
 - o **Note:** Do *not* click  this works with EndNote but not with RefWorks.
5. Now open <http://www.refworks.com> in a new browser window or tab & login.
6. Once you have successfully opened your account, select "**References > Import**" to open the RefWorks Import Form.



7. Select the **ISI (Institute for Scientific Information)** filter in the first pulldown menu (Import Filter/Data Source). Select **Web of Science**. Then click the **Browse** button on the right.
8. Choose the .txt file you saved, click **Open**.
9. At the bottom of the form, click the **Import** button.
10. After a few seconds, you will see a message ("Importing references, please wait). RefWorks will tell you how many records were imported.
11. Click "**View last imported folder**" to view and edit your imported citations.
