

STATE GRANT APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts and all states that have state grant reciprocity agreements with Massachusetts require you to file the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) by the state deadlines listed below in order to be eligible for these grants. Federal Student Aid Programs will automatically send your FAFSA data to your state agency and to the colleges listed on your FAFSA. If the FAFSA is not received and processed by the state deadline, your late application will not be considered for state financial aid. Make certain that your state agency has on record your correct school of enrollment and your correct social security number. **Comply with your state's required FAFSA receipt deadline.**

Please note that these deadlines are not updated until after January 1 of each year once the FAFSA becomes available.
