

Student (mis)behavior at Project Centers: How bad is it?

The following situations involve student behavior that might take place at a project center. Please rank order the situations from 1-10, with 1 being the most serious situation, and 10 being the least serious.

When you are done ranking these situations individually, you will work with the other members at your table to come up with a group ranking for the situations, using the same scale of 1-10 for most to least serious.

Situation	Your rank	Group rank
1. A student is consistently late for their meetings with their on-site project sponsor.		
2. A student is arrested by the local police authorities for public urination.		
3. A student leaves town for the weekend but does not submit a travel form with the faculty advisor.		
4. You receive a complaint from the director of the on-site housing facility that a WPI student allegedly made very derogatory/racist comments about a member of the housekeeping staff.		
5. One of the students at your project center is a little odd and is consistently being alienated and left out of group activities in the evenings and on weekends.		
6. In the housing complex at the project site, some neighbors are complaining about the noise level from some of the student apartments late at night and especially on weekends.		
7. One of your project teams has been having difficulties working together since the group was first formed back at WPI. You receive a complaint from the project sponsor about the poor quality of their work and lack of productivity.		
8. One of the female students in your project group has been spending a significant amount of her free time with a local man. One Thursday morning, her apartment mates report that she did not come home the previous evening and they have no idea where she is.		
9. One of the project teams submits a final project which contains plagiarized material.		
10. A student gets into a brawl in a local dance club. He shoves one of the patrons who falls and cuts their head and is taken to the hospital.
