2. 1/3 unit English Capstone Experience. This can be either a 1/3 unit Independent Study/Project in English or a 3000-level course approved by the student and advisor. The capstone course must be taken last.

Notes: No more than one unit of work for the Humanities and Arts Requirement may be applied toward the English minor. Any student at WPI is eligible to pursue the minor in English except for students majoring in Humanities and Arts with a concentration in literature.
