



Graduate Credit

You have the option of earning WPI graduate credit for your coursework during the STI. Although your online PLTW pre-registration form asked if you would be opting for graduate credit, we do not require you to register for graduate credit until Wednesday, July 22nd. This gives you an opportunity to gain an understanding of the coursework involved before making the decision.

Requirements for earning Graduate Credit:

To earn graduate credit you must:

Take a final exam (administered by your course instructors on Thursday, July 30th), and earn a passing grade of 80% or above.

Complete work above and beyond the standard STI workload. This additional coursework is many times in the form of a project or extension of a project. Your instructor(s) will help you to determine a framework for what you need to do to satisfy this requirement.

Additional Graduate Credit Details:

Graduate Credit Hours allotted for WPI STI: 3

Total Cost: \$630.00 (this is a discounted rate). This amount is paid in full to WPI through the Accounting Office (see payment options below).

Registering for Graduate Credit

Your instructor will have course registration forms to be completed by Wednesday, July 22nd.

Forms must be brought to the K-12 Outreach Office in Higgins Labs Room 203 where you will pay for the credit (see payment options below).

Payment options

Checks are accepted and should be written out to WPI.

Transcripts

You can request a transcript from WPI that reflects your credits earned. The STI course will be listed as, "Project Lead the Way, Independent Study" on your transcript.

To purchase a transcript after the completion of the course, you must complete and send a Transcript Request Form to the WPI Registrar's Office.
