



## WPI Facilities & Policies

### Access to WPI Facilities

On Orientation Day, you will be given a temporary WPI ID to use during the STI. This ID will allow you access to WPI facilities including the athletic facilities and some buildings/classrooms. The ID will also have a week-day daily allotment of \$10 stored on it that may be used in both the Campus Center food court and Dunkin Donuts.

### Places to Eat

Week day lunch is included with your course registration fee and will be provided on the WPI campus. You will be allotted \$10 per day for lunch at the WPI food court located in the Campus Center Forkey Commons.

*Note:* The Campus Center facilities are closed on the weekends.

You are responsible for dinners during the STI. There are many restaurants located in the WPI area. A list, complete with maps will be provided in the info packet.
