

## BEHAVIORAL CONTRACT FORM NCSSSMST Student Conference

This form must be signed!

NCSSSMST Conference attendees have established a record of good behavior, primarily because the rules are clearly spelled out in the following contract, which must be reviewed, signed and returned in the registration package. Students must read the rules and sign this document to indicate they accept the responsibility for good behavior throughout the conference.

***No student will be allowed to accompany a group to the conference until the student has agreed, by signing this contract, to abide by the rules and has obtained parental consent to make the trip.***

Parents of student delegates also are required to sign the Behavior Contract as an indication of their willingness to release the student to the care of the advisor or chaperone approved and designated by the school.

### NCSSSMST Student Conference Rules

1. Students should be in their assigned rooms after curfew. Curfew is 11:00 P.M. on Thursday and Friday and midnight on Saturday.
2. Possession of weapons is prohibited.
3. Displays of affection and sexual activities are not allowed.
4. Students should not visit students of the opposite sex in their hotel rooms without the consent of supervision of their advisor. Visitation is prohibited after curfew.
5. Students should make their whereabouts known to their supervisor in charge at all times.
6. Students should wear appropriate clothing at all times.
7. Students should refrain from going anywhere alone.
8. Smoking is prohibited: The conference is a school event.
9. A room inspection by the advisor should be done before students check-in to note any damages or problems so that students will not be blamed for damages or problems.
10. A room inspection by the advisor should be done after student check-out to note any problems. Damages become the responsibility of the students in the room and the advisor or chaperone.
11. Damages to hotel property, conference sites, equipment, or property must be paid for by the students responsible before the close of the conference.
12. Any student found in possession of, under the influence, and/or supplying other students with alcohol or drugs will be dealt with by the appropriate authorities.
13. Students should understand they represent their schools and the NCSSSMST, as well as themselves. Students should understand that the hotel has many other paying guests who must not be annoyed by inconsiderate or disrespectful behavior by NCSSSMST Conference attendees.

The chaperones or advisor of any student who is found in violation of the Behavior Contract may attend the NCSSSMST Board meeting to represent the student who has committed an infraction of the conference rules.

## CONSEQUENCES OF MISBEHAVIOR

A STUDENT WHO VIOLATES ANY OF THESE RULES WILL FACE ONE OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING CONSEQUENCES

- Notification of advisor.
- Notification of parents.
- Notification of school principal/director.
- Suspension of student from NCSSSMST Conference activities with confinement to hotel room.
- Immediate dismissal from the conference with transportation at parental expense.
