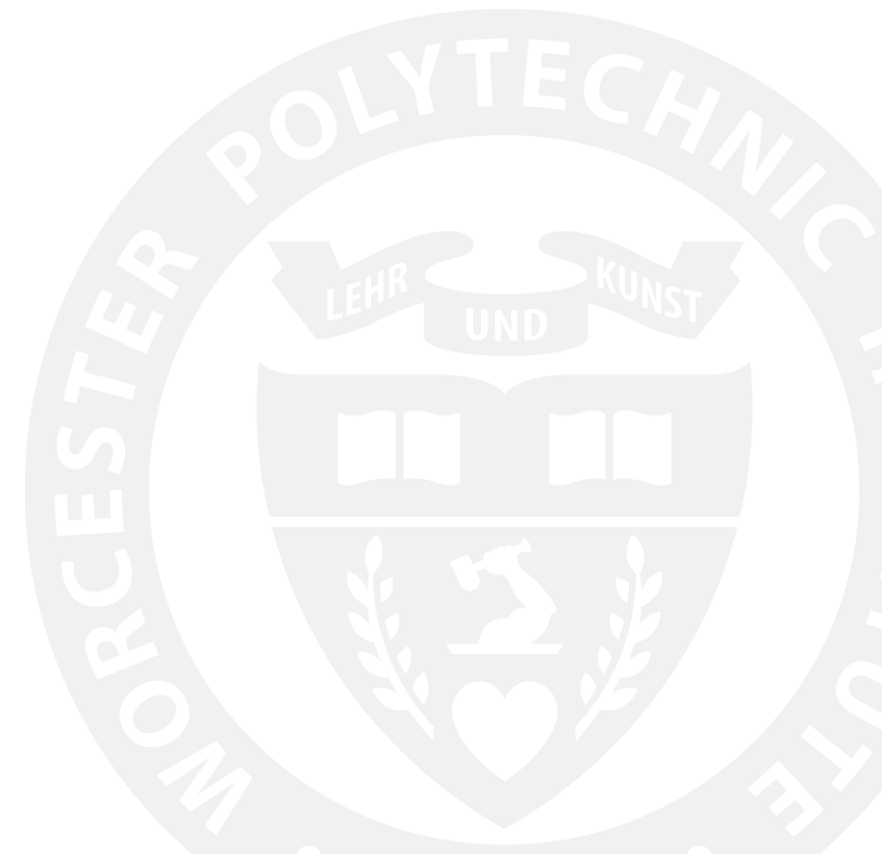

Meet the PASS CS Team



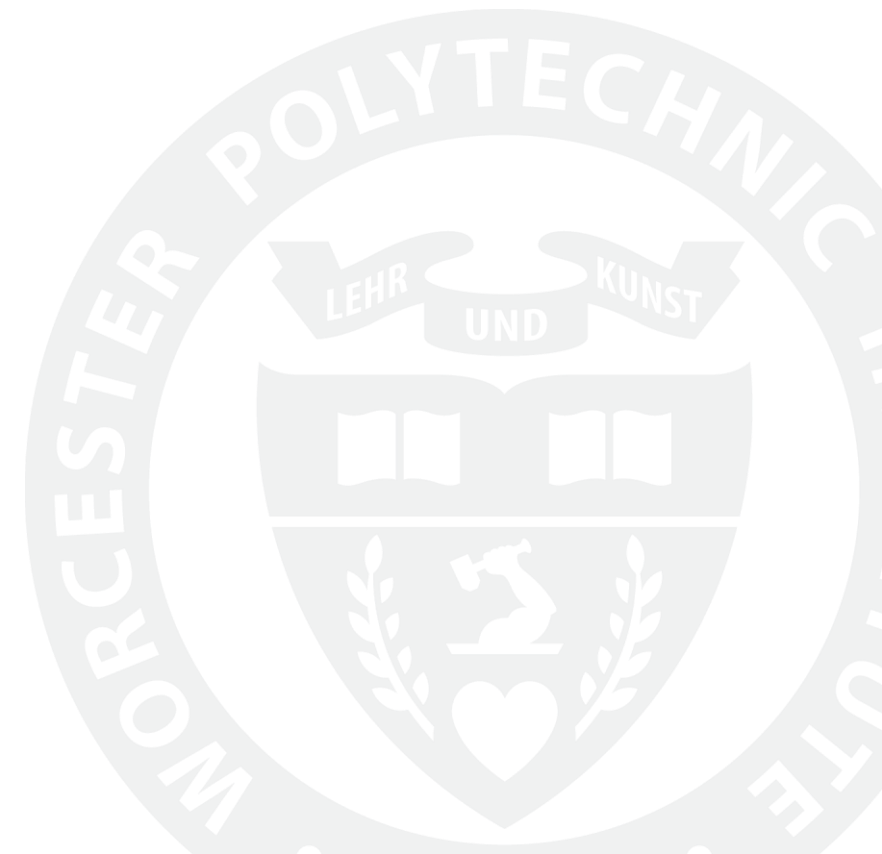

- Continued support through all 4 years at WPI

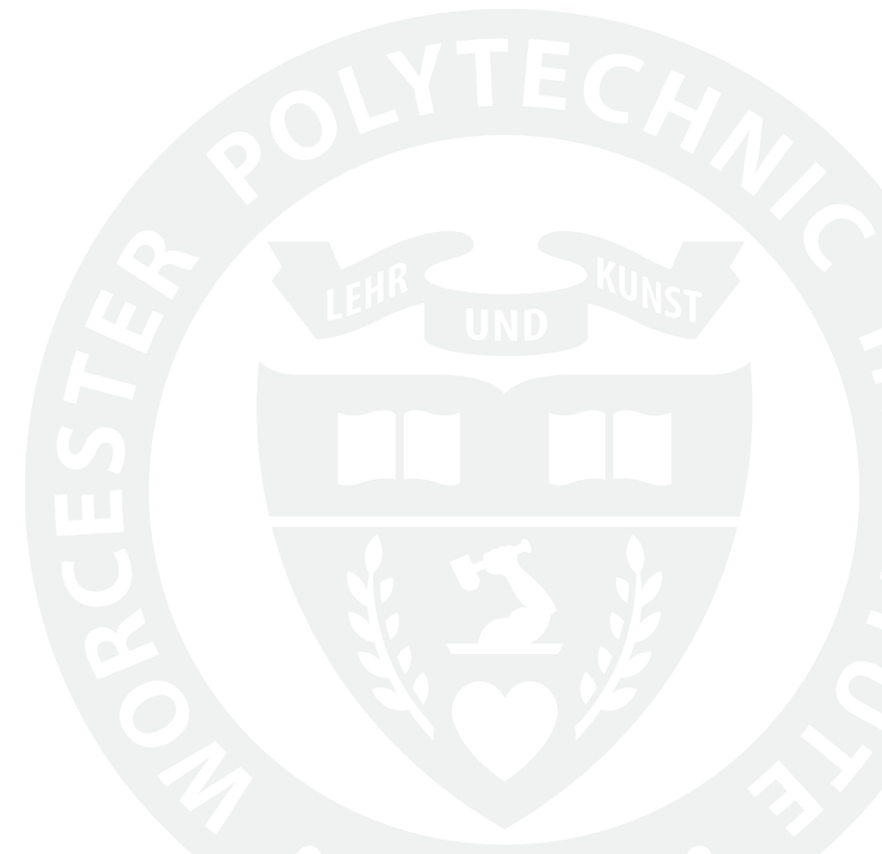


Am I Eligible?

How Do I Apply?

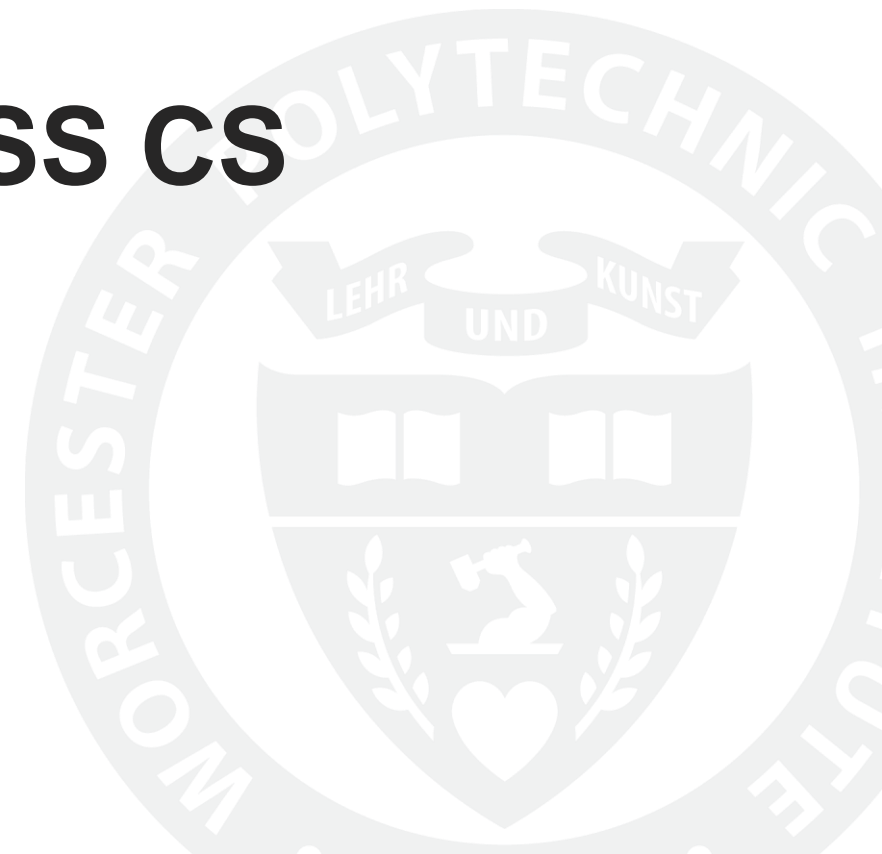
- Eligible students receive an email from the Office of Financial Aid notifying them about PASS CS Scholarship program.
- Students complete a short application for the program.
- Application deadline May 20, 2024.
- Awardees notified the of May 28 - 31, 2024.

Making a commitment

- Once accepted as a PASS CS scholar, you need to commit to the program no later than June 2, 2024.
- We are only accepting 10 students into the program and are looking for students who are excited about the opportunities of PASS CS.
- If we do not hear from you, your spot will be forfeited.



What are the financial benefits of this scholarship?

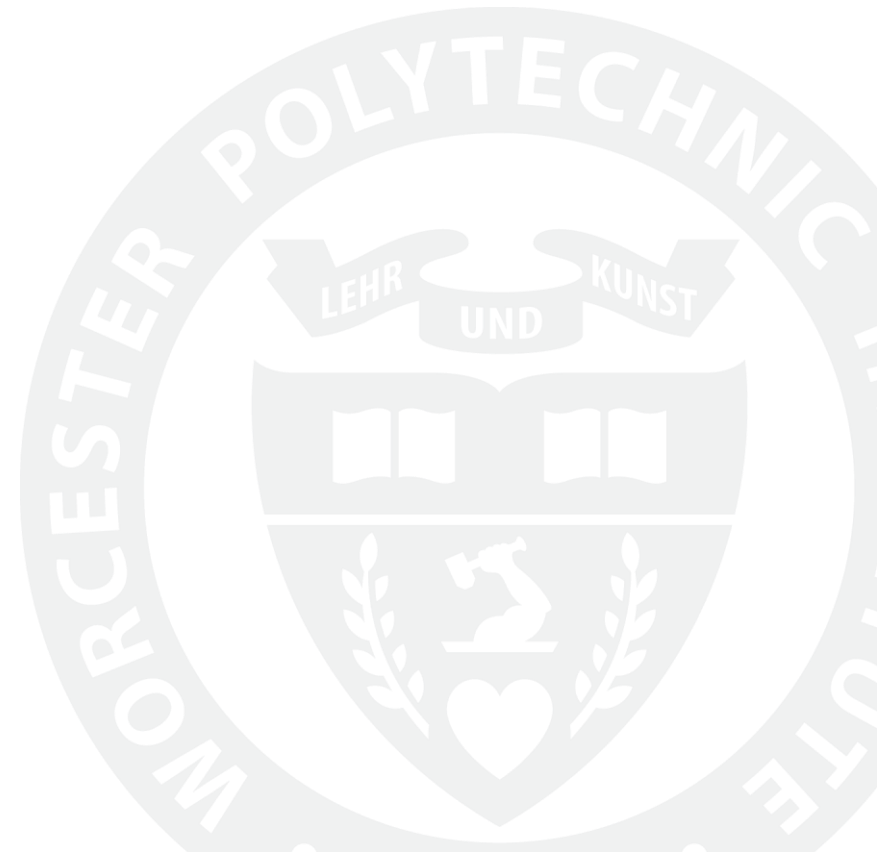
- Up to \$15,000 in funding per year.

A Two-Part Extended Immersion Program with early arrival



Part I - PASS CS Cohort Mini-Bridge: Aug 7-10, 2024

- Introduction to the school and PASS CS Cohort
- Academic Preparation: Goal setting, mentoring and familiarity with the university
- Introductions to faculty, mentors, alumni and computer science professionals
- Active learning activities:
 - Brainstorming sessions
 - Small group discussions
 - Q&A Panels

Goals

- Developing Relationships
- Exploring and creating career profiles
- Unstructured open discussions

Part II – Connections Academic Immersion Experience Program: Aug 10 – 17, 2024

- A jump start and introduction to the WPI course structure, an opportunity to meet WPI faculty, and form relationships with peers
- Any WPI students are welcome to attend the connections program. The PASS CS Cohort is automatically enrolled.
- **Goals:**
 - To positively impact students' awareness and confidence in their own academic, social, and cultural preparedness for college.
 - To provide opportunities for students to experience and understand the expectations of college life and rigor of WPI academics.
 - To build a sense of belonging and confidence in each students' ability find their home within the WPI community.



Enhanced mentoring & academic support during the Fall semester

- Weekly meetings with supportive faculty
- Building social connections
- Demystifying the existing support structures



Enhanced tutoring and near peer mentoring with older CS Students

- Scholars will be assigned a near-peer mentor/tutor to help navigate the hidden curricula of the existing support structures (self-structure)
- Small peer-led group sessions for scholars to have a goals check-in session and reinforce progress towards their goals developed during the mini-bridge
- Scholars taking the same class will meet once a week to share the everyday actions leading to their success or gain insight into how to improve using near-peer mentors and faculty

What else can I expect?

- Scholars will be registered together for the same set of courses (where applicable)
- Check-in events each term with professional development topics
- Additional support for research experiences, conference travel, etc.
- Continued support from grant personnel through all 4 years at WPI

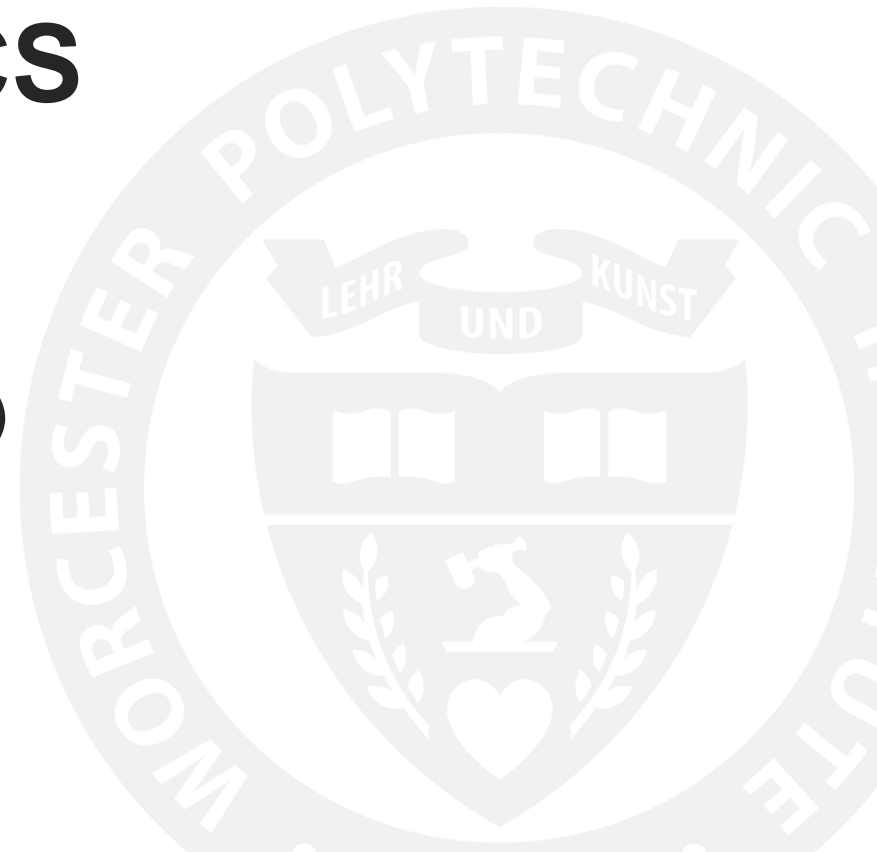
