1. Minutes of 4/5 meeting were approved with minor revisions.

Chair Claypool informed the committee that an ad hoc group composed of the current and past CTAF chairs, the chair of COG and the secretary of the faculty have been working on formalizing the procedures for handling academic freedom cases, ultimately to be incorporated into the faculty handbook. - 6. The committee discussed issues surrounding a possible proposal for a flexible tenure clock, specifically when faculty would have to commit to their year of review. Generally, the committee thought 6 months in advance would be sufficient.
