

WPI Yellow Ribbon Program Application Undergraduate students

2023-2024 Academic Year

WPI has entered into an agreement with the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) to participate in the Yellow Ribbon Program during the 2023-2024 academic year. WPI will award a maximum of 50 Yellow Ribbon scholarships to eligible undergraduate and graduate students combined. The maximum award per year will be \$35,000 (will not exceed full tuition when combined with other WPI merit and need based aid and Post 9/11 VA benefits funding), half funded by WPI and the matching award provided by the VA. Students who had this funding in the prior academic year will be given priority to receive benefits under the Yellow Ribbon Program:

- 1). You must submit an application for Post 9/11 benefits to the Department of Veterans Affairs. You can do this online at http://www.gibill.va.gov or by calling 1-888-GIBILL1 (1-888-442-4551). You will receive a Certificate of Eligibility explaining the VA's decision regarding your eligibility for the Yellow Ribbon program.
- 2). You must submit a copy of your Certificate of Eligibility to WPI along with this completed application.
