- The committee discussed and voted on the STEM MBA program and BUS 594 course launch motions.
 - The committee approved (with a friendly amendment) both motions to (1) launch the STEM MBA program and (2) add BUS 594 Capstone course.
- The committee reviewed three individual PhD plans. The following items were discussed:
 - Robert Krueger and his SSPS colleagues were invited.
 - All three student proposals were reviewed and discussed.
 - The CIP code for this program does not have STEM designation. One international student's OPT extension could be impacted by this.
 - Course credits were discussed 30 credits have to be research credits.
 - The interdisciplinary nature of the program was explained.
 - Create separate proposals for each student.

 - Need for a more detailed policy for interdisciplinary PhD programs.
 - Qualifying exam What courses will be covered?
 - How was the curriculum (course mix) designed?
 - Other avenues of conducting the proposed research.
