
- <u>April 2011</u>: WPI Faculty voted to eliminate the "Three- and Five-Year Rule"
  - Rule: No full-time non-tenure track teaching appointment may extend for more than <u>three consecutive years</u> or for more than <u>a total of five</u> <u>years</u>. Appointment beyond this limitation must be as a tenure-track Faculty member.
- Effect of the rule: (....the problem we wanted to solve...!)
  - In principle, it prevented WPI from establishing long-term relationships with non-tenure track faculty members.
- Concerns about eliminating the rule:
  - Tenured and tenure-track (TTT) Faculty wanted to maintain its primary role in delivering WPI's academic curriculum.
  - TTT Faculty wanted to ensure that its commitment to delivering the curriculum (to a rapidly growing student body) did not work against them in expanding their other activities.


- The tenured and tenure-track (TTT) Faculty at WPI are committed to delivering a *significant majority* of the academic credit offered to WPI students.
- WPI meets this commitment by ensuring that the TTT Faculty increase at a rate that is commensurate with the University's growth and strategic needs.
- Non-tenure track (NTT) faculty members enhance new and existing educational programs, and complement and expand scholarly expertise on campus.
- The Committee on Governance will present a report (<u>for open</u> <u>discussion</u>) to the Faculty each year concerning the distribution of teaching done by TTT faculty members and NTT faculty members.












### Faculty Population: Fall 2004 to Spring 2017






### Changes in the Number of Faculty and Credits: Fall 2004 to Spring 2017



- <u>Summary: From AY 2004-5 to AY 2016-17</u>
  - Student credit enrollments have <u>increased</u> by 61%
  - Tenured and Tenure-Track Faculty:
    - Headcount has <u>increased</u> by **13%**
    - Fraction of total credits delivered has <u>decreased</u> from **65%** to **49%**
    - Credits delivered per TTT has increased by 7.5%
  - Non-Tenure Track Faculty:
    - FTEs have increased by 137%
    - Fraction of total credits delivered has <u>increased</u> from **35%** to **51%**
    - Load (in credits) per (FTE) NTT has <u>decreased</u> by **0.8%**
- <u>Observation: From AY 2015-16 to AY 2016-17</u>
  - Student credit enrollments increased by 2.3%
  - Tenured and Tenure-Track Faculty:
    - Headcount <u>decreased</u> by **1.2%**
    - Fraction of total credits delivered <u>increased</u> from **49.1%** to **49.3%**
    - Credits delivered per TTT delivered <u>increased</u> by **3.9%**
