Admissions and Financial Aid Counselors

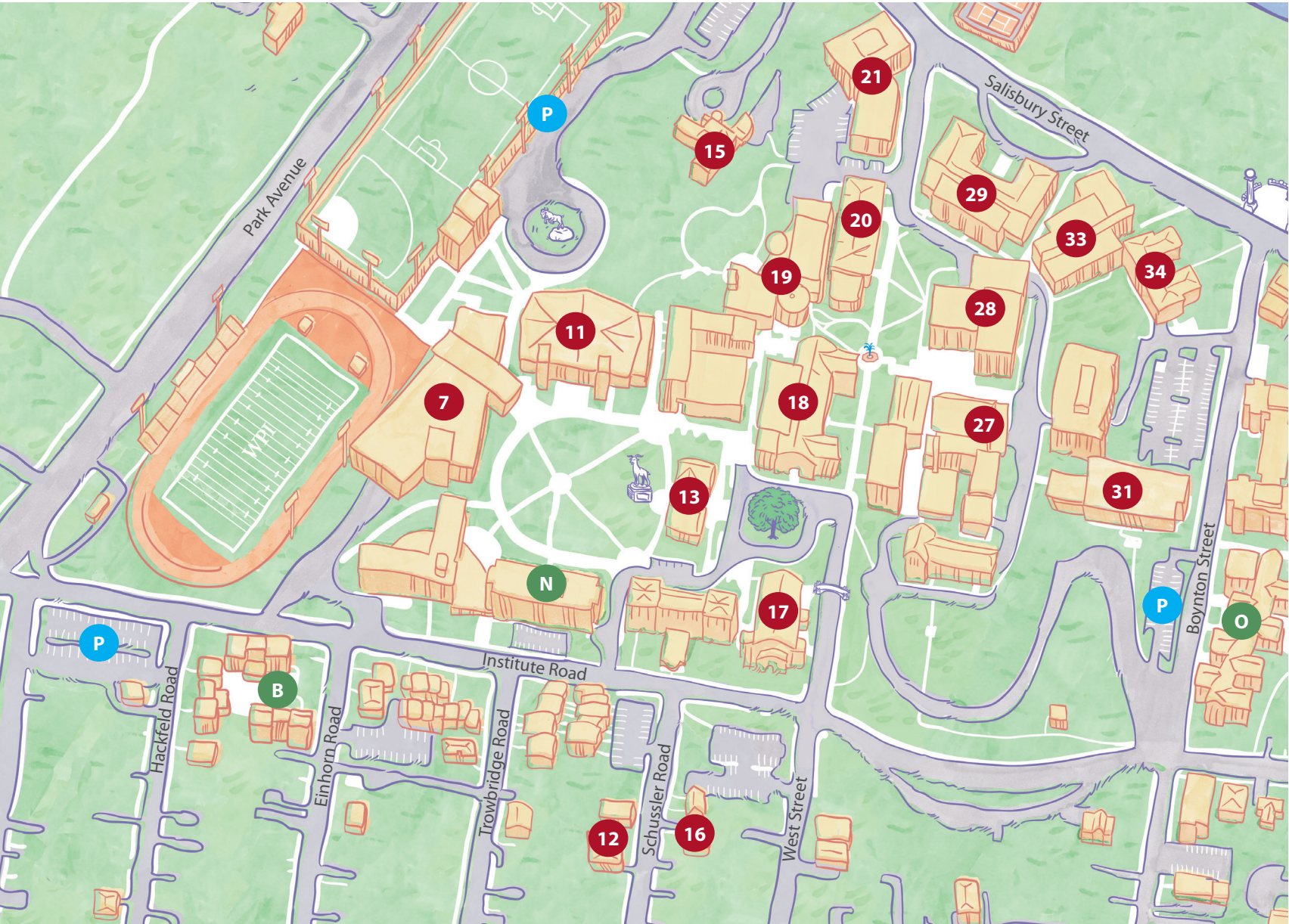
