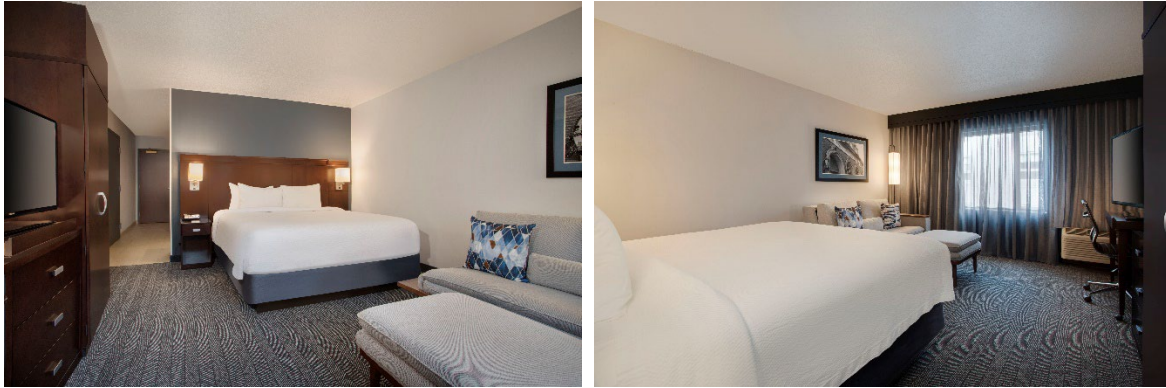

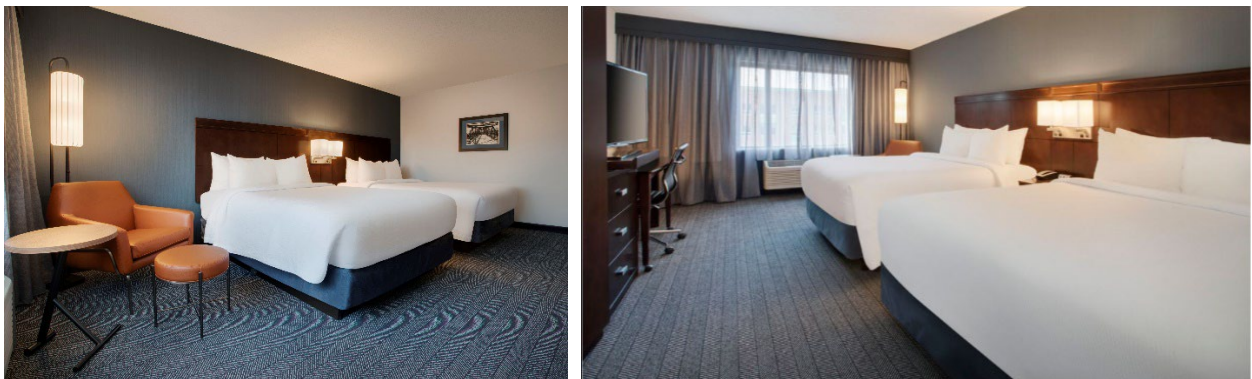
Courtyard by Marriott Worcester – Maximum of 134 Rooms

Below is a photo of the Deluxe King Guest Room with Balcony (16 rooms on-property – limited availability, reserved for requests pertaining to VIP guests):



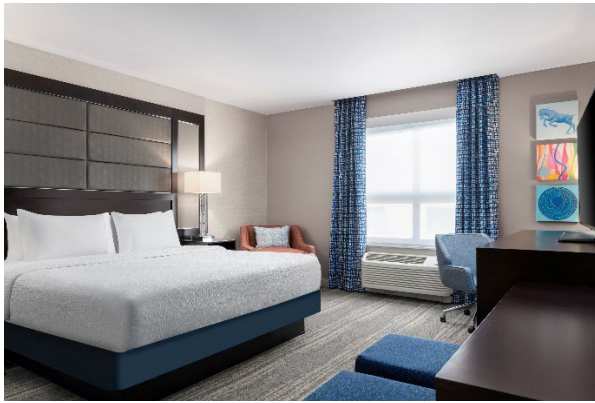
The rates include Wi-Fi in guest rooms and common areas. Breakfast is made-to-order for purchase at the Bistro, including Starbucks coffee (open 6:30AM-9:30AM Mon-Fri / 6:30AM-10:30AM Sat-Sun). Light appetizers and drinks are available to purchase at the Bistro in the late afternoon/evening hours (5:00PM-10:00PM). There is a \$15.00 parking fee per day that's not included within the rate. Additional amenities include a fitness room, indoor pool, and outdoor patio with fire pit.

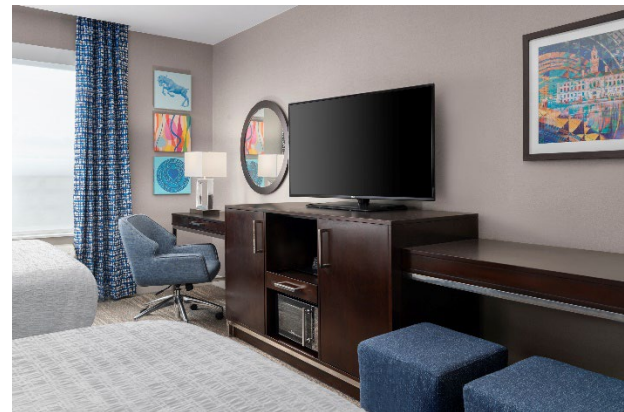
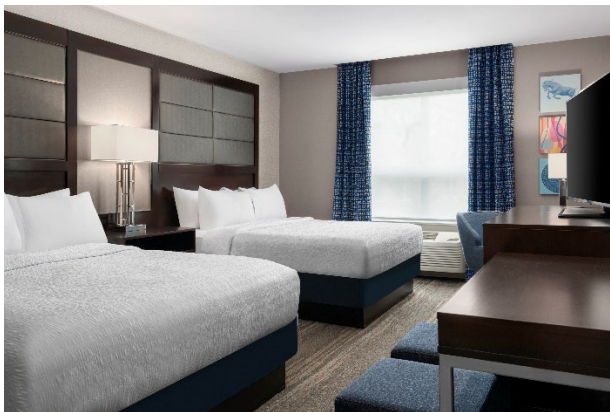
