Suggestions for **humanities courses**: The humanities requirement at WPI is three courses in a depth area (courses of thematically related work), one course outside of the depth area, one additional course, before completing the Inquiry Seminar or Practicum in the same depth area. Your depth area should include at least one course at the WPI 2000 level. At RVCC, most majors require at least two humanities courses, and you can start taking those to work towards fulfilling your depth at WPI. History and Philosophy have courses that transfer to WPI at the 2000 level (e.g., HIST 201, HIST 202, HIST 239, HIST 250, PHIL 114, PHIL 210).
