Meeting Minutes

5th CAP Meeting of 2020-21

Monday, November 2 at 2 PM. Meeting held over Zoom due COVID 19 restrictions.

1. Secretarial responsibilities for the remainder of the year were agreed upon as follows

B 2020: Adrienne Hall-Phillips; C 2021: Jennifer deWinter and D 2022: Oleg Pavlov.

- 2. The committee welcomed new members Jennifer deWinter and Oleg Pavlov.
- 3. The committee reviewed a list of unfinished items, and prioritized items to address now, address later, or delete from list.
- IQP and MQP survey data for past reports: Jeanine Dudle will check with Anna Gold of the library
 to determine the current status of these surveys which have not been available for the past few
 vears.
- A change to one of our graduation dates from September 1 to August 31st for reporting reasons: Sarah Miles will bring a motion to the committee in 2 weeks.
- Guidelines to faculty on excused absences for students: The problem that needed addressing was not clear. Jeanine Dudle will review past records to see if there is something that needs committee attention.
- Financial Implications when undergraduate students take graduate courses as overloads: This item was set aside for now and may be removed from the committee's agenda.
- WPI Growth Issues (raised in NEASC 2012; 2016): This item was referred to the NECHE accreditation committee and removed from the list.
- Graduate students teaching undergraduate courses: This item was removed for now pending any additional concerns being raised.
- Evaluating teaching at WPI: The addition of teaching portfolio requirements for tenure and promotion candidates likely addressed this issue so it was removed from the list.
- Effect of Strategic Plan and Global School initiatives on academic policy: Discussion of this item was deferred to a future meeting.
- Advisor of Record policy for qualifying projects: This was deferred until after eProjects 2.0 and Workday project practices are put in place.
- Courses with large number of students (different resource issue): This issue seemed not to have a systemic basis and so was removed from the list.
- Students with disabilities in upper level courses: This issue seemed not to have a systemic basis and so was removed from the list.
- Review of WPI's academic programs; assess what constitutes an "active" WPI program: This discussion was deferred to a future meeting.
- 4. An additional item to be added to a future agenda was a discussion of institutional plans for Project Presentation Day 2021. Suzanne Weekes intends for there to be a Virtual

- Undergraduate Research Showcase again as was done in 2020. Departments can decide whether to join this initiative or do something on their own.
- 5. Discussion of questions identified in the previous meeting's minutes regarding the TechFlex model of course delivery will be continued at a future meeting.
- 6. The committee will review data regarding the impact of COVID 19 related changes to the academic year calendar.
- 7. Add/drop policies, and dissemination of information regarding "remote" classes and students were also added to the list of agenda items for future meetings.
