## Committee on Advising and Student Life (CASL): Minutes

Meeting #2: 9/21/2020 via zoom

- 1. The meeting was called to order at 3:03pm.
- 2. Dean Snoddy led a discussion about the annual Academic Integrity Report published by the Division of Student Affairs. Some questions/comments included:
  - Should the report be shared with faculty, staff, and students?
  - Can additional guidance be provided to students regarding online academic integrity?
  - Professor O'Cathain suggested a 1-page document be considered to help students and advisors understand plagiarism.
  - Feedback was provided by Professor Weekes and Professor Harrison on the format of the Academic Integrity Report.
  - A discussion ensued regarding the variety of software tools on the market for proctoring exams such as honorlock.
- 3. Professor Weekes announced that the course catalog will not be available before academic advising day. This year the catalog will be made available in May 2021.
- 4. Professor Weekes shared a question from Dean Heinricher that CASL should consider "what is the impact of Covid-19 testing protocols on student life?"
  - Dean Snoddy shared that there is a broad group from student affairs who are looking at enhancing student engagement on campus.
  - Dean Snoddy also shared that students who have not completed testing requirements are not allowed to be active on campus and are being moved to online academic activities.
