WPI's newest residence hall, Faraday, opened in 2013 at 10 Faraday Street, Worcester, MA. The 89,000-square-foot building is located a short walk from the main WPI campus at the intersection of Faraday, Grove, and Lancaster streets. The 3-person, suite-style rooms are equipped with private bedrooms, shared living rooms, kitchens, bathrooms, and air-conditioning. The building also offers tech suites where you can watch TV, a pool table, laundry facilities, a large outdoor courtyard, and dedicated parking. Faraday Hall's unique design elements were inspired by Michael Faraday, an English scientist whose work in electromagnetism and electrochemistry paved the way for modern technology.

A hot buffet **breakfast** will be provided on weekdays for those staying in Faraday Hall.

Weekday **lunches are included for everyone**. Opening day group lunches will be held. On other weekdays, you may use the Goat Bucks on your WPI ID to purchase food in the Rubin Campus Center at both the Food Court and Dunkin Donuts.
