 - a. ME 3310, ME 3320,
 - b. ME 4320, ME 4322, ME 4429,
 - c. ME 4505, ME 4506, ME 4810.

Students seeking an ME Minor should complete this form and submit it to the ME office as early in the program of study as possible. The chair of the ME Undergraduate Curriculum Committee will be responsible for review and approval of all ME Minor requests.

WPI policy requires that no more than one unit of course work can be double counted toward other degree requirements.
