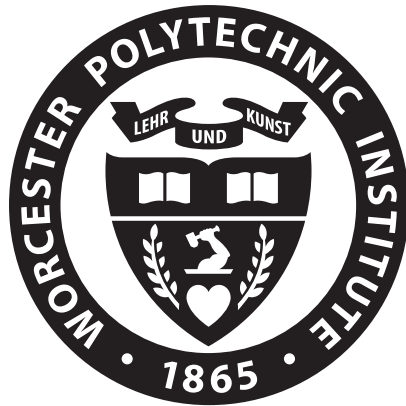

As an undergraduate, you co-founded with your classmate, Tom Daly, the company now known as Dyn, a private firm primarily engaged in the provision of managed domain name systems, email delivery, domain registration, and other Internet performance solutions. You have guided Dyn from its earliest stages and now serve as its CEO, responsible for communicating strategic direction, hiring and retaining the best talent, and generating revenue. Under your leadership, Dyn has become the fastest growing Internet performance solutions provider in the world with some of the biggest brands, such as Twitter and CNBC, as customers. Dyn was named to the Deloitte Technology Fast 500 in 2013, was dubbed one of *Business New Hampshire* magazine's "Best Companies to Work For" from 2007 to 2011, and has made the *Inc.* magazine 5000 List from 2007 to 2013.

You have never forgotten your WPI roots. As a member of the Tech Advisors Network you offer advice and insights to WPI students who wish to pursue

entrepreneurship. You have also given generously of your time and talent to the WPI School of Business Dean's Council of Strategic Advisors, the Management Executive Council, and the Collaborative for Entrepreneurship and Innovation. In addition, you have advocated for corporate support for WPI. Contributions from Dyn, combined with your personal contributions, established the User Experience and Decision Making Lab in the School of Business. Dyn has also opened its doors to WPI students and alumni seeking internship, project and employment opportunities.

Your engagement as a leader in your community in southern New Hampshire also brings pride to WPI. You are a member or leader of several civic, business, and higher education boards. You have earned a long list of honors and awards, among them Ernst & Young "Entrepreneur of the Year" finalist for New England in 2012, New Hampshire High Tech Council Entrepreneur of the Year in 2012, and Small Business Administration "Young Entrepreneur" in 2008.
