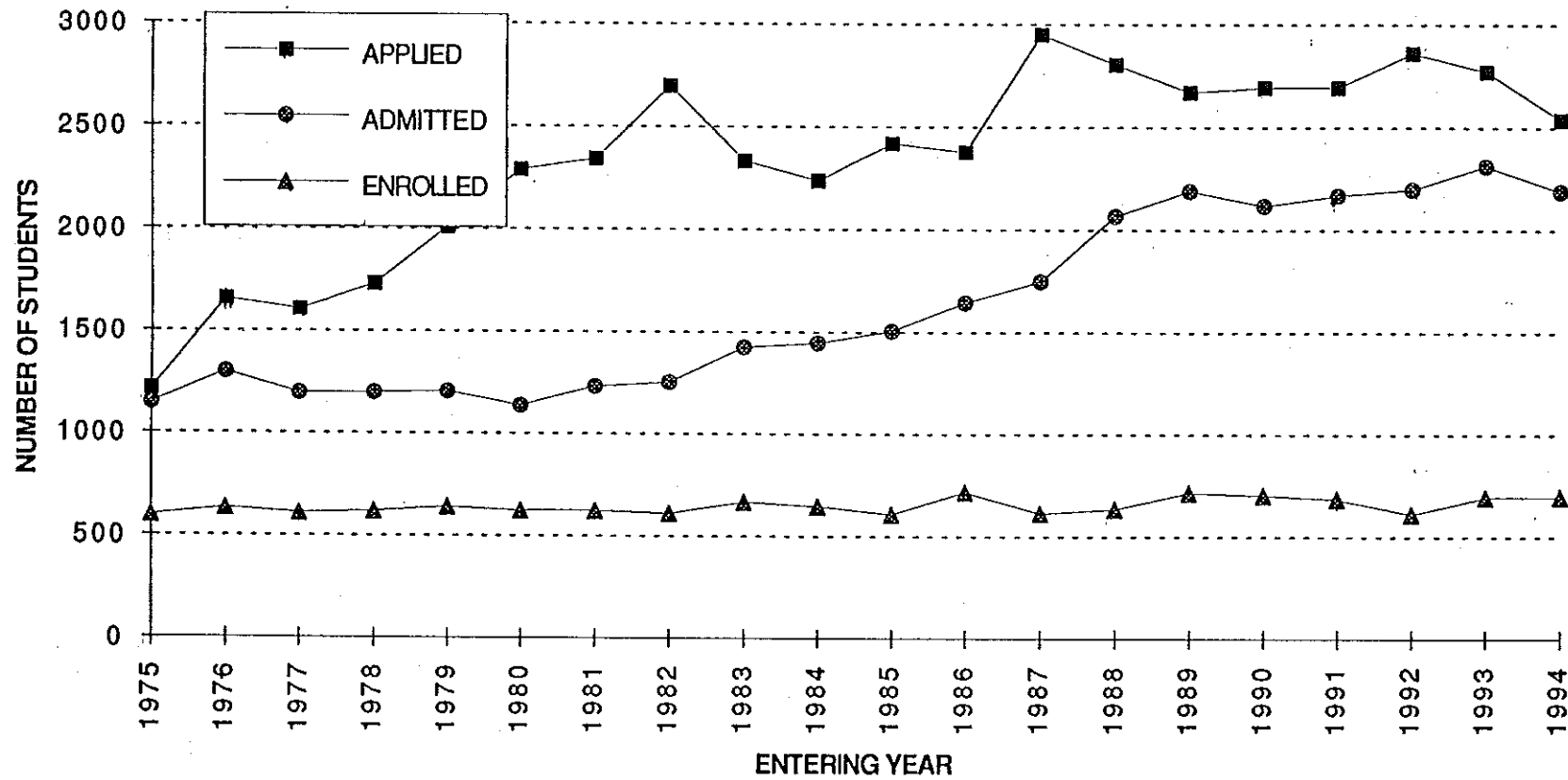

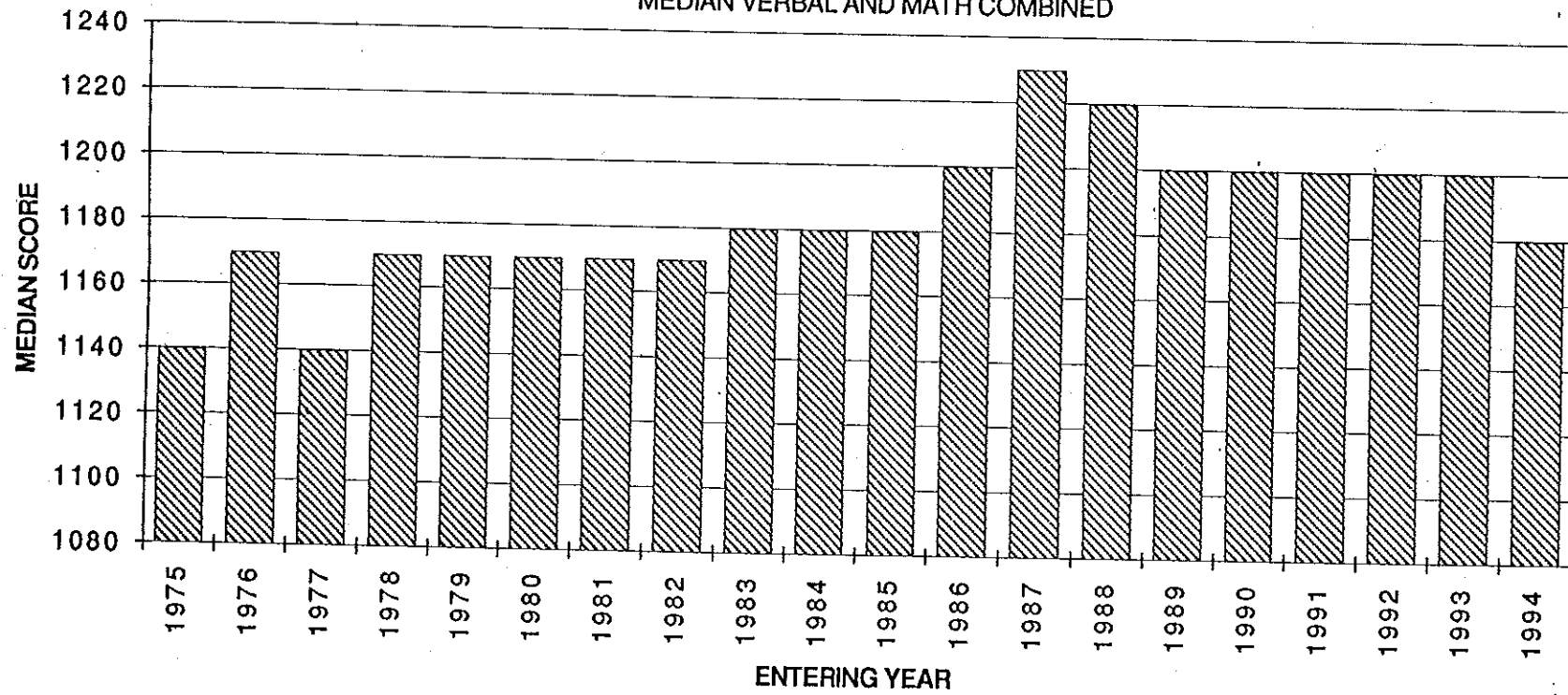

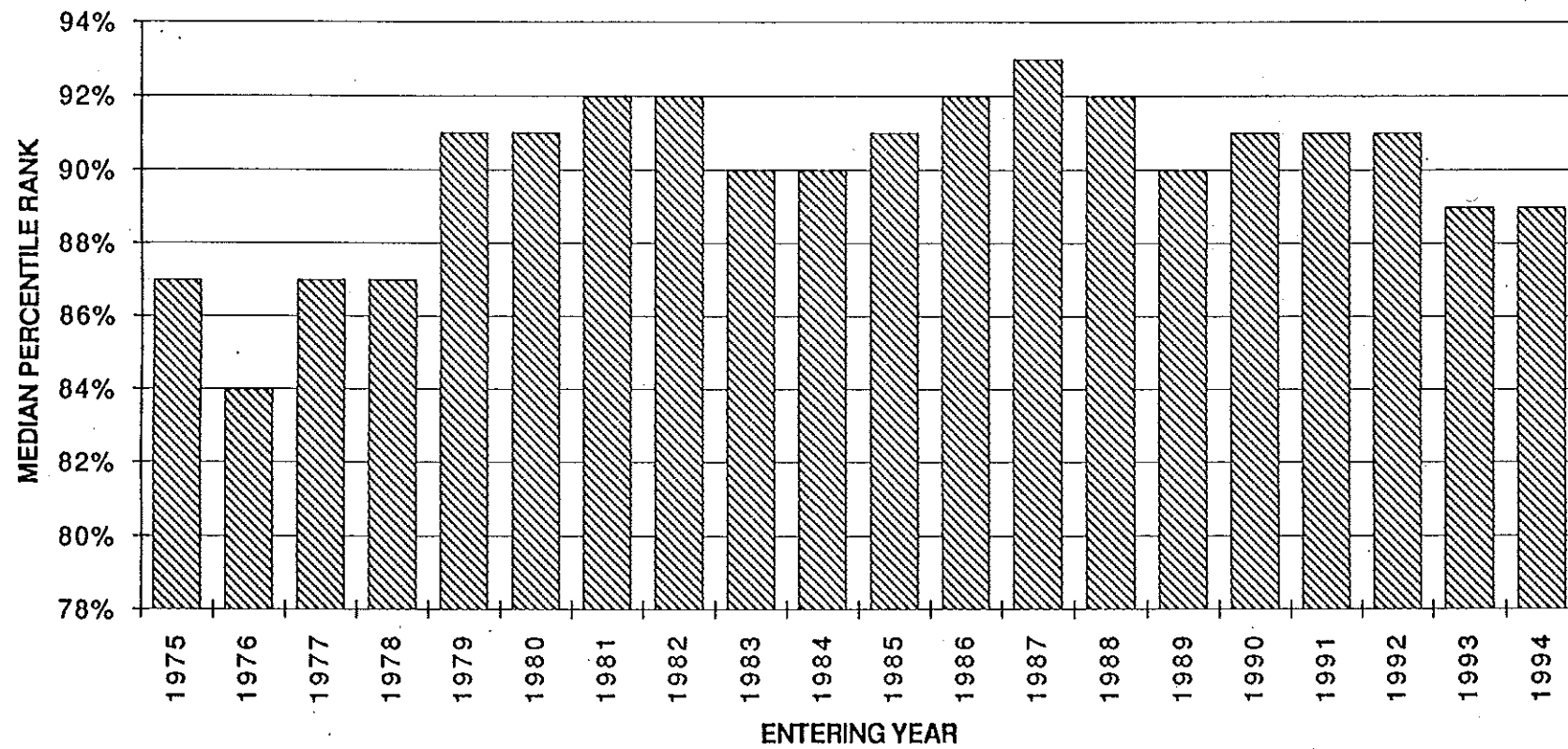


SAT SCORES

HIGH SCHOOL CLASS RANK



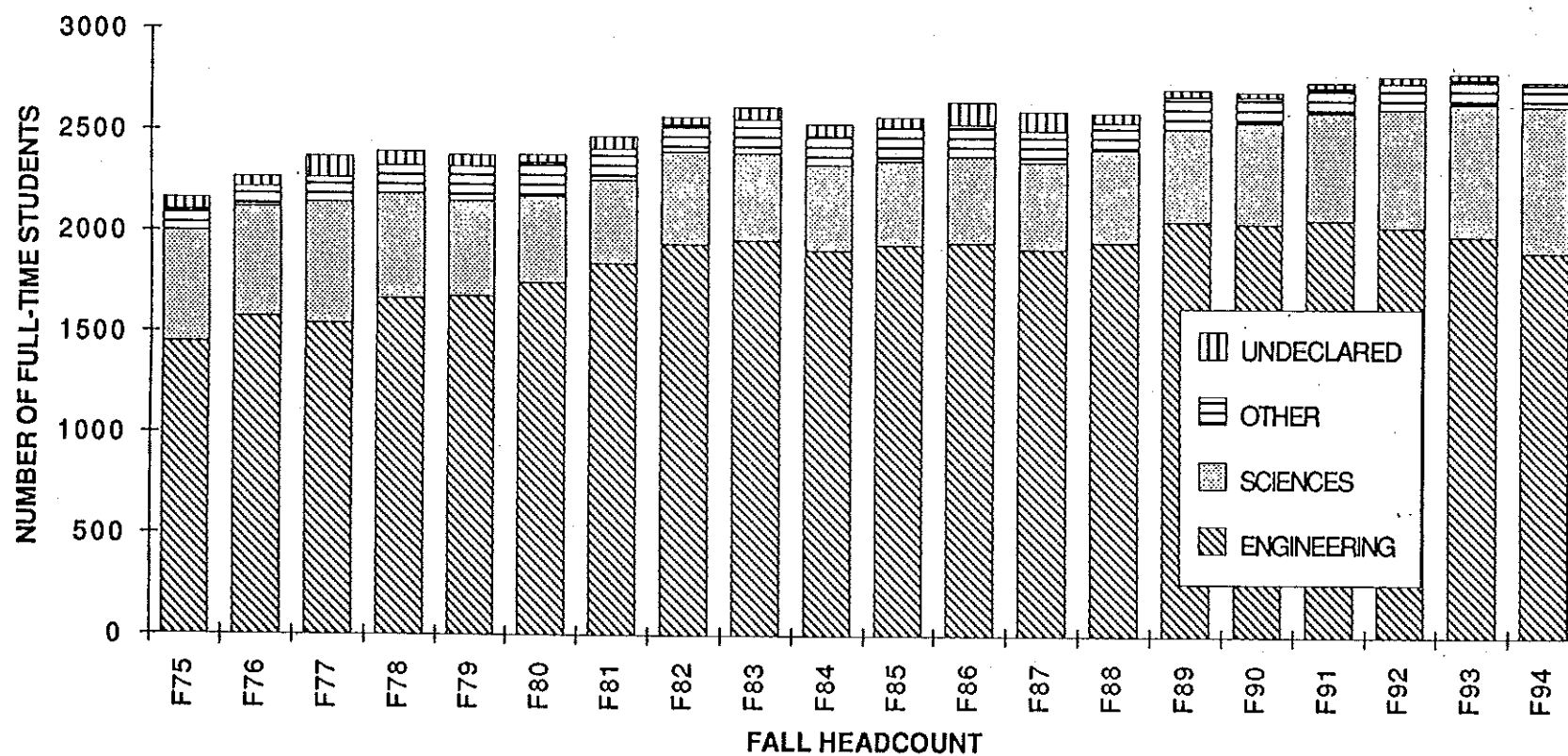

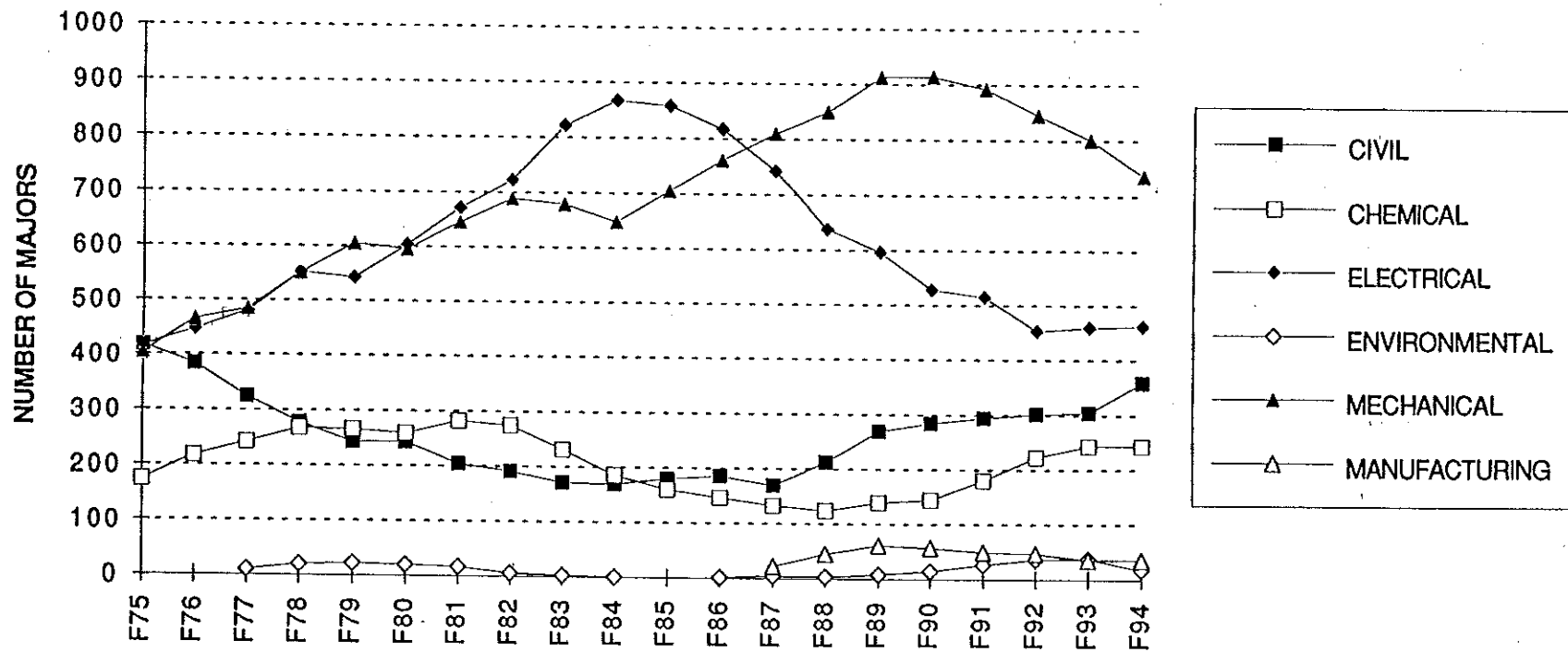

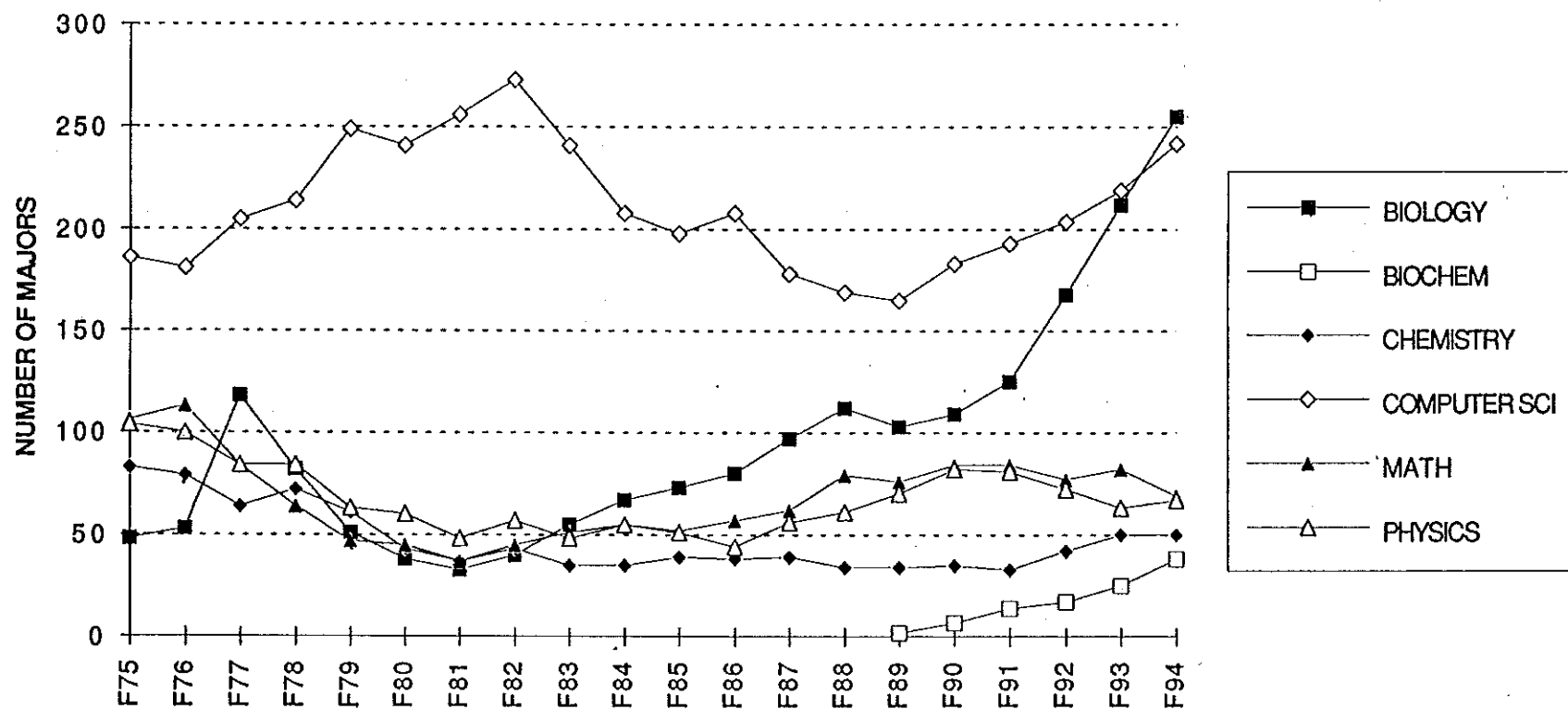
UNDERGRADUATE ENROLLMENT BY CATEGORY



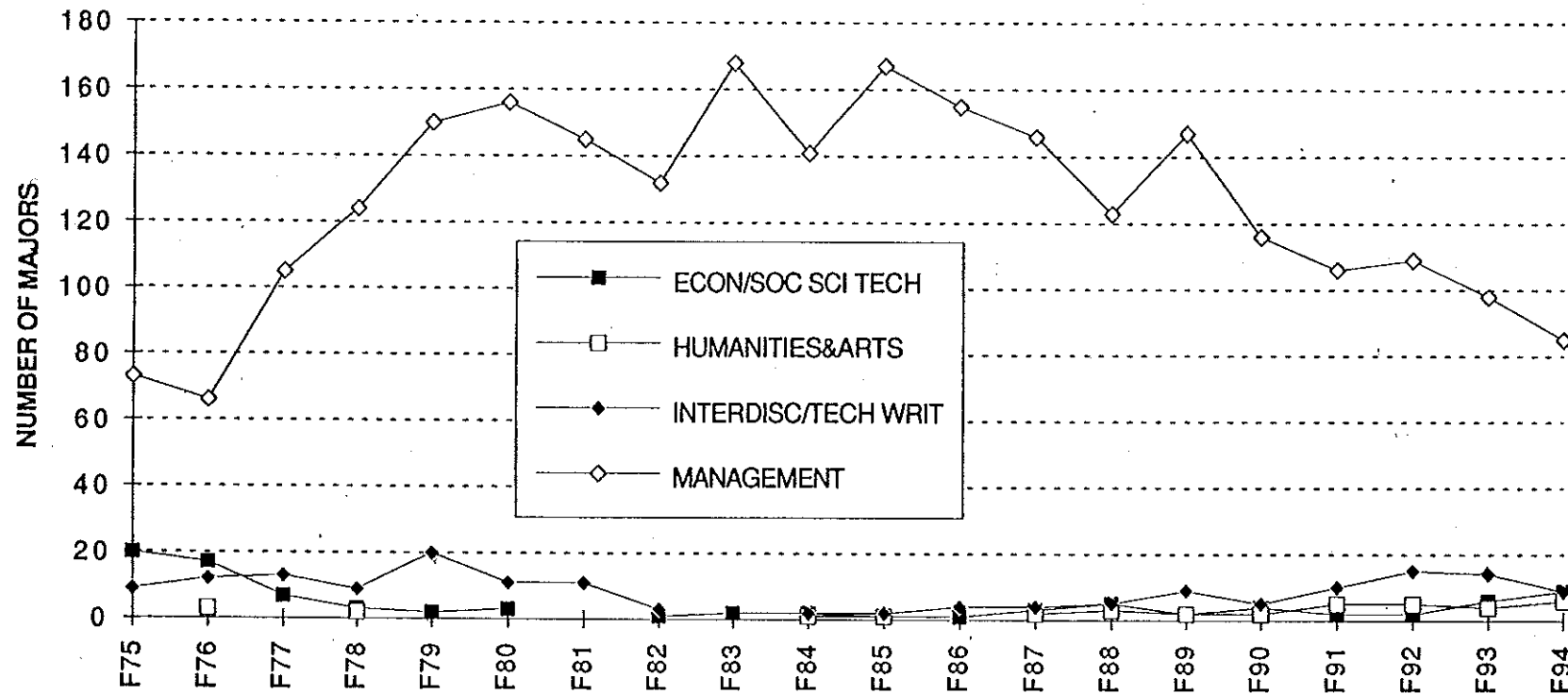
UNDERGRADUATE ENROLLMENT IN ENGINEERING



UNDERGRADUATE ENROLLMENT IN SCIENCE



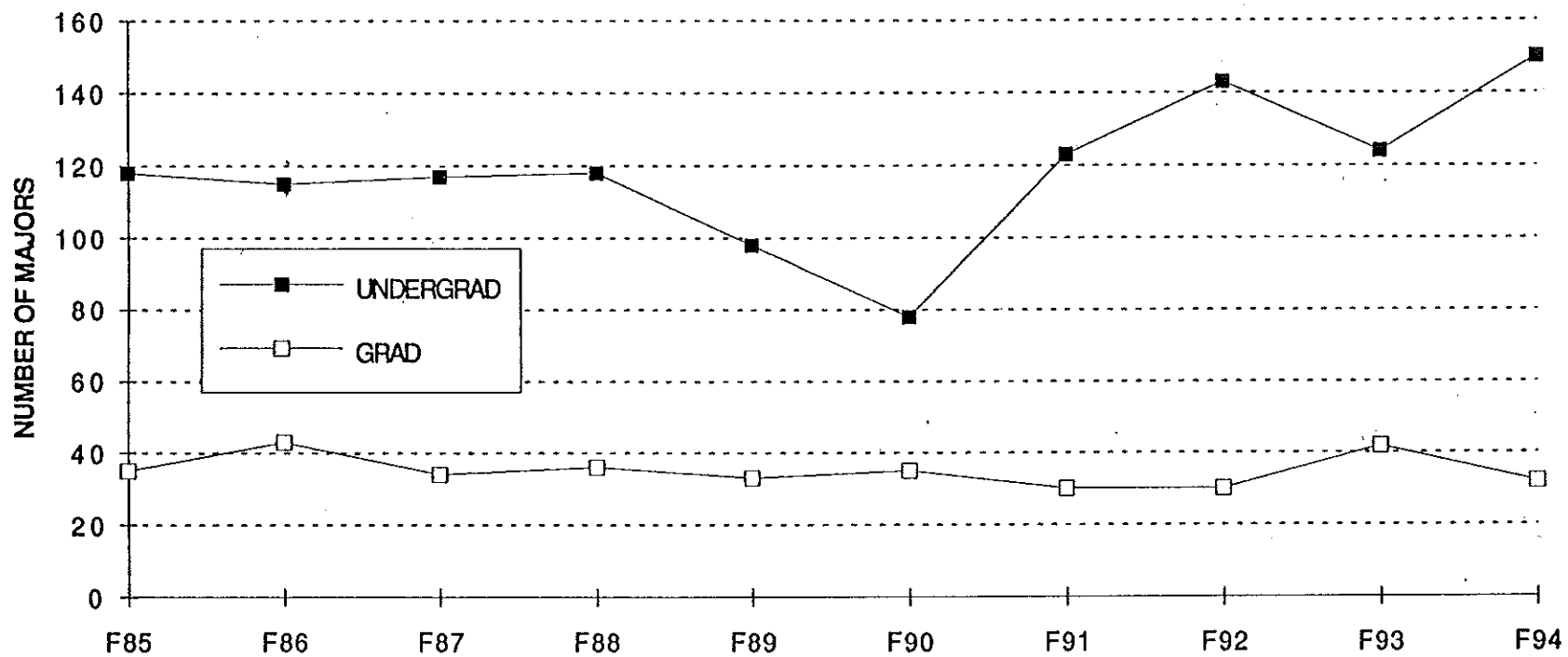

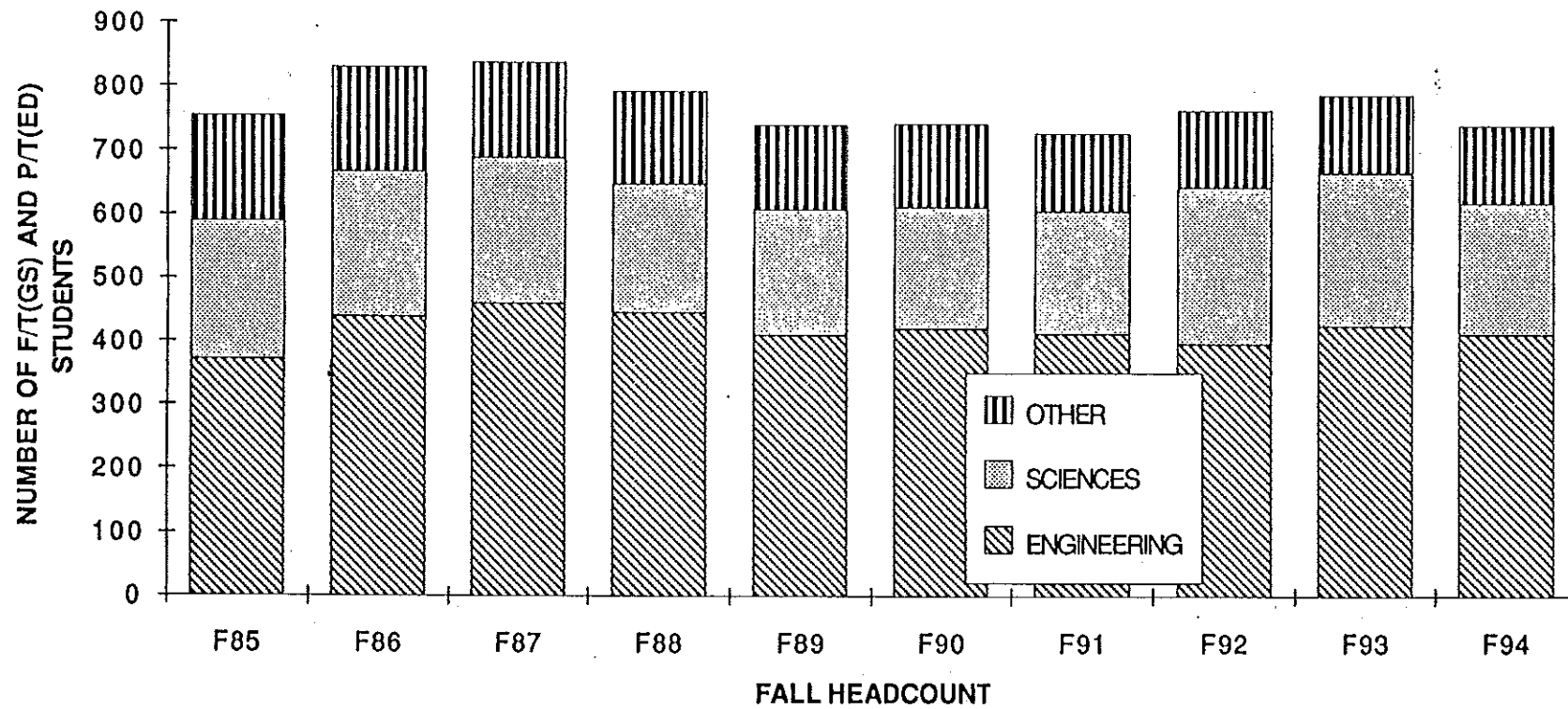

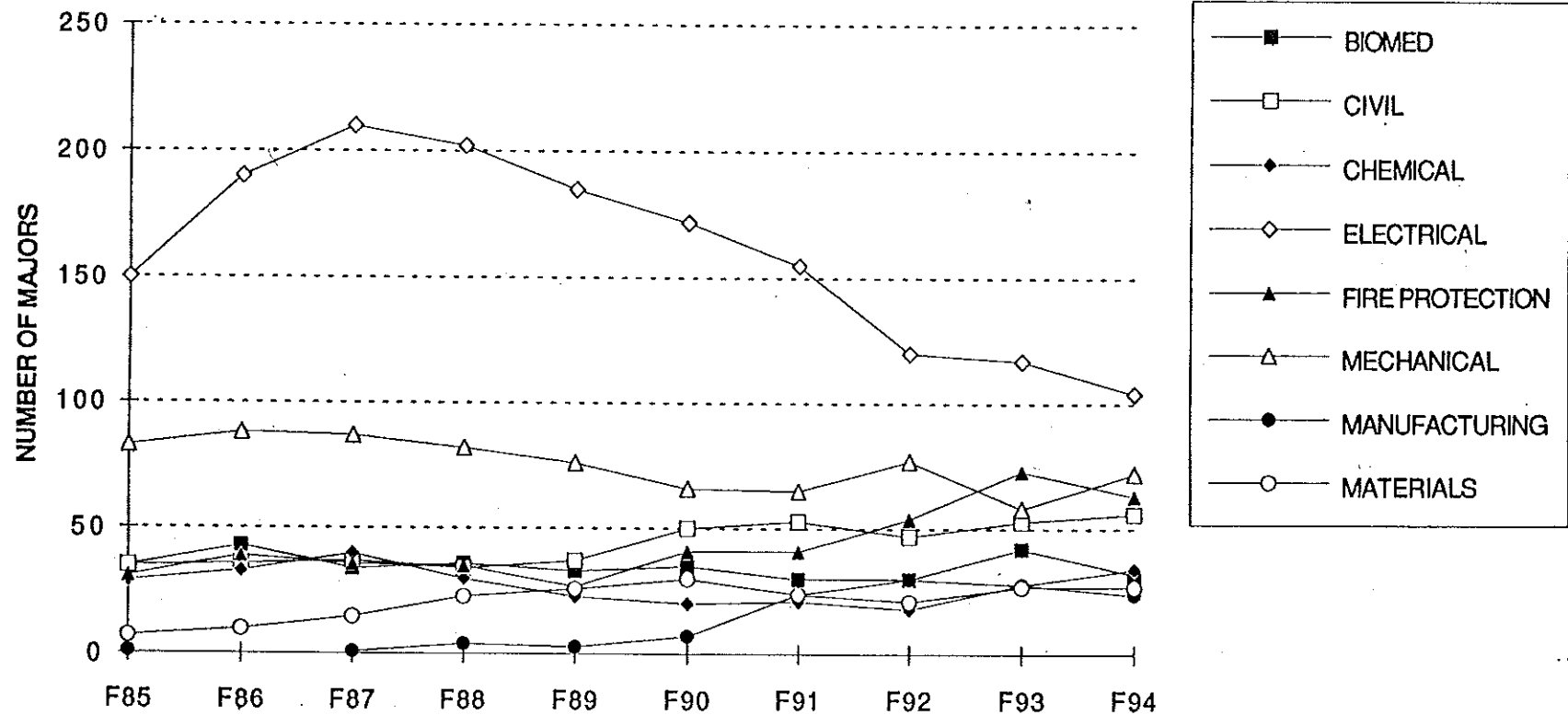

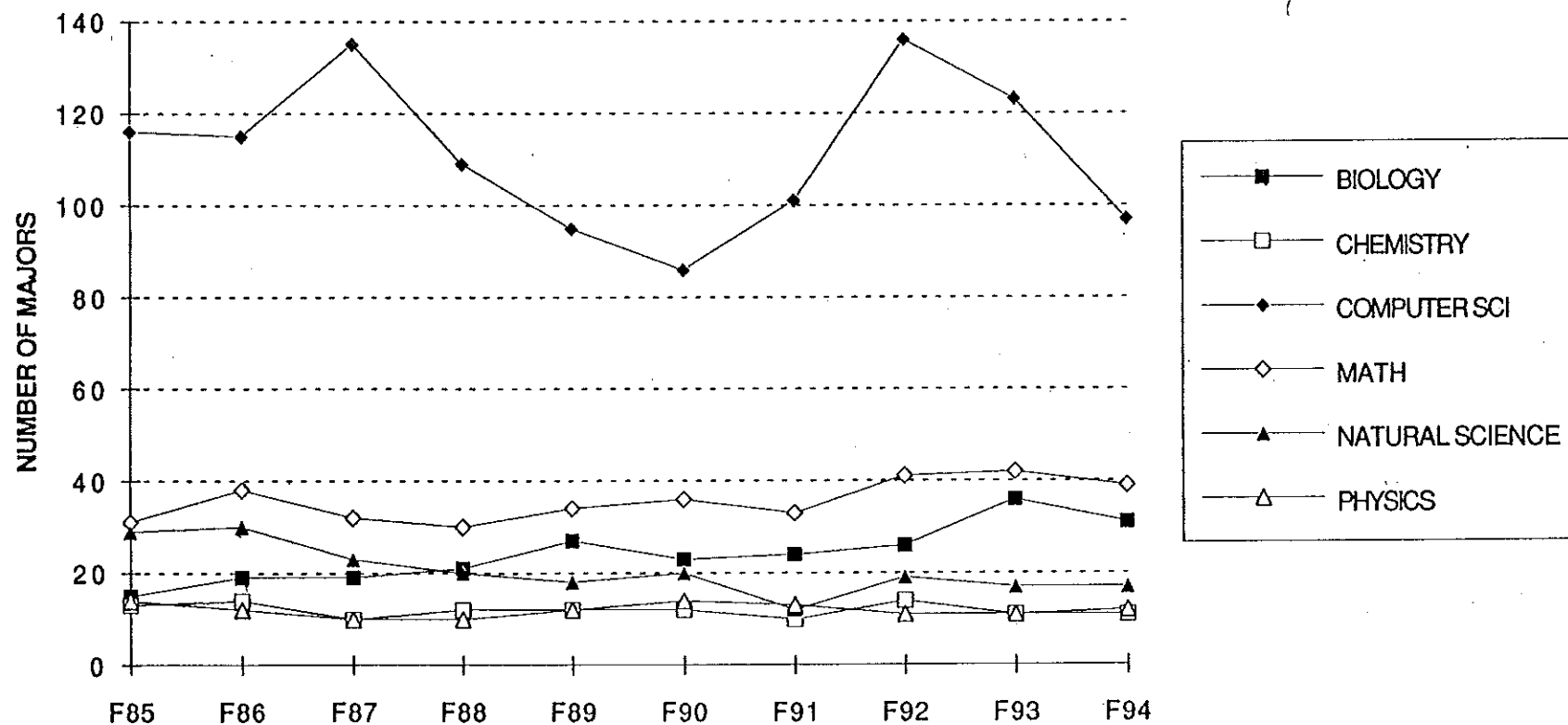
GRADUATE ENROLLMENT BY CATEGORY



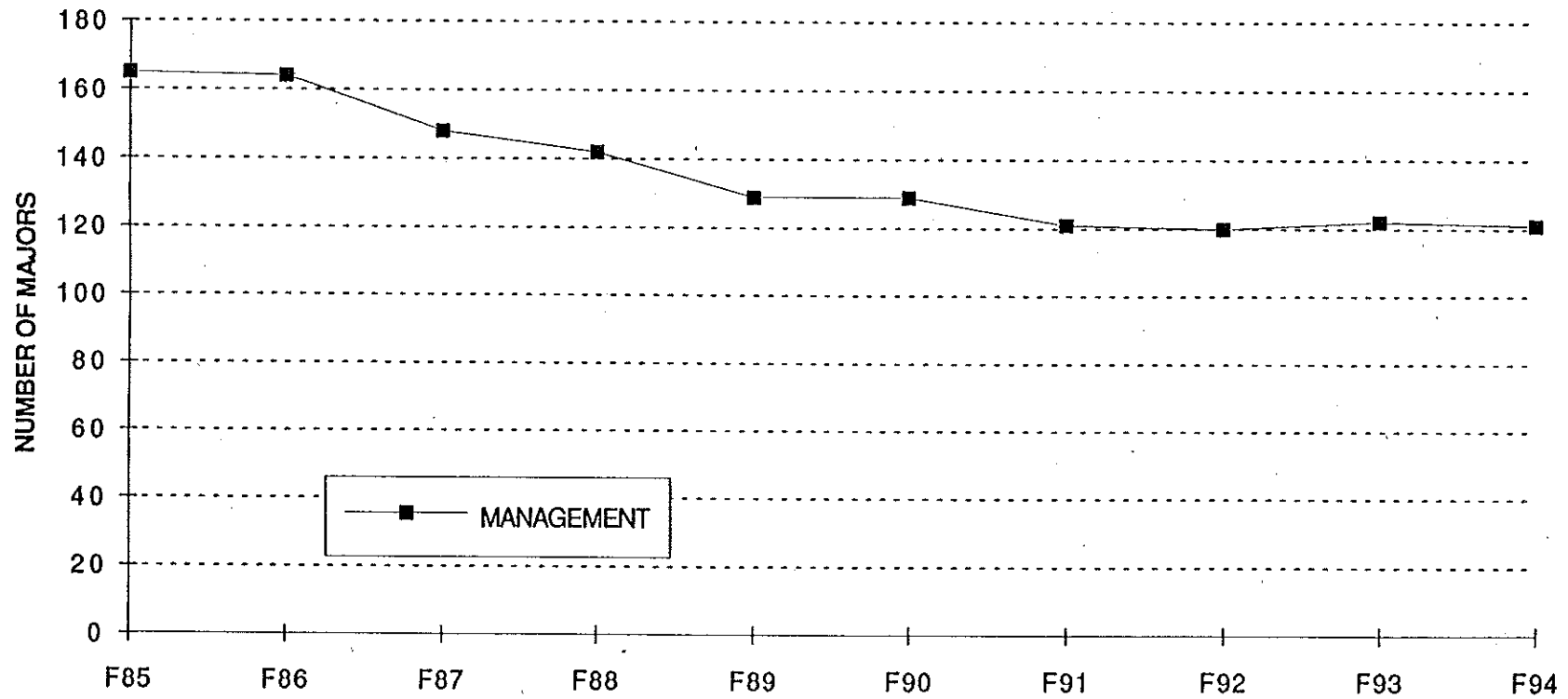
GRADUATE ENROLLMENT IN ENGINEERING

GRADUATE ENROLLMENT IN MANAGEMENT

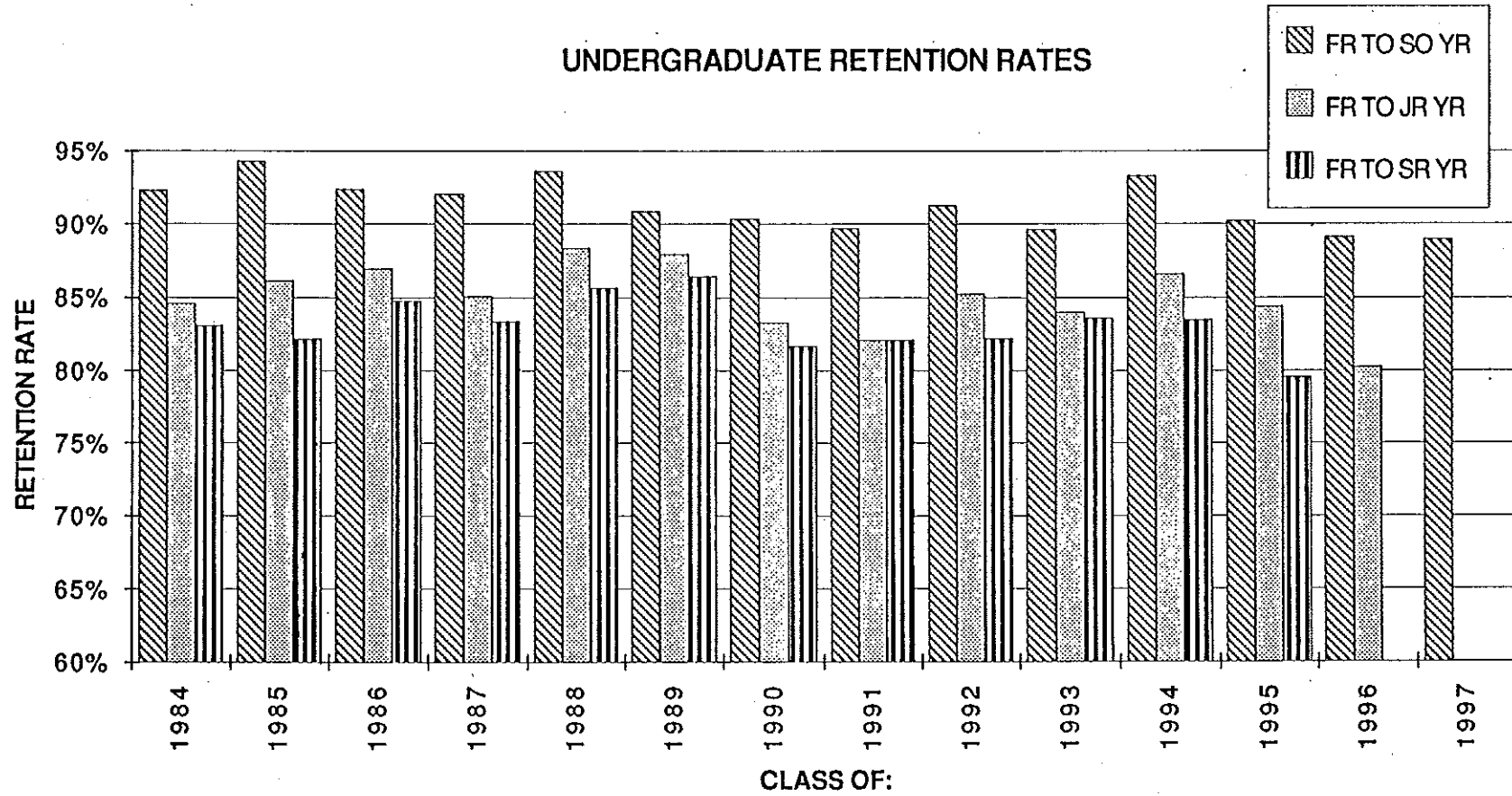

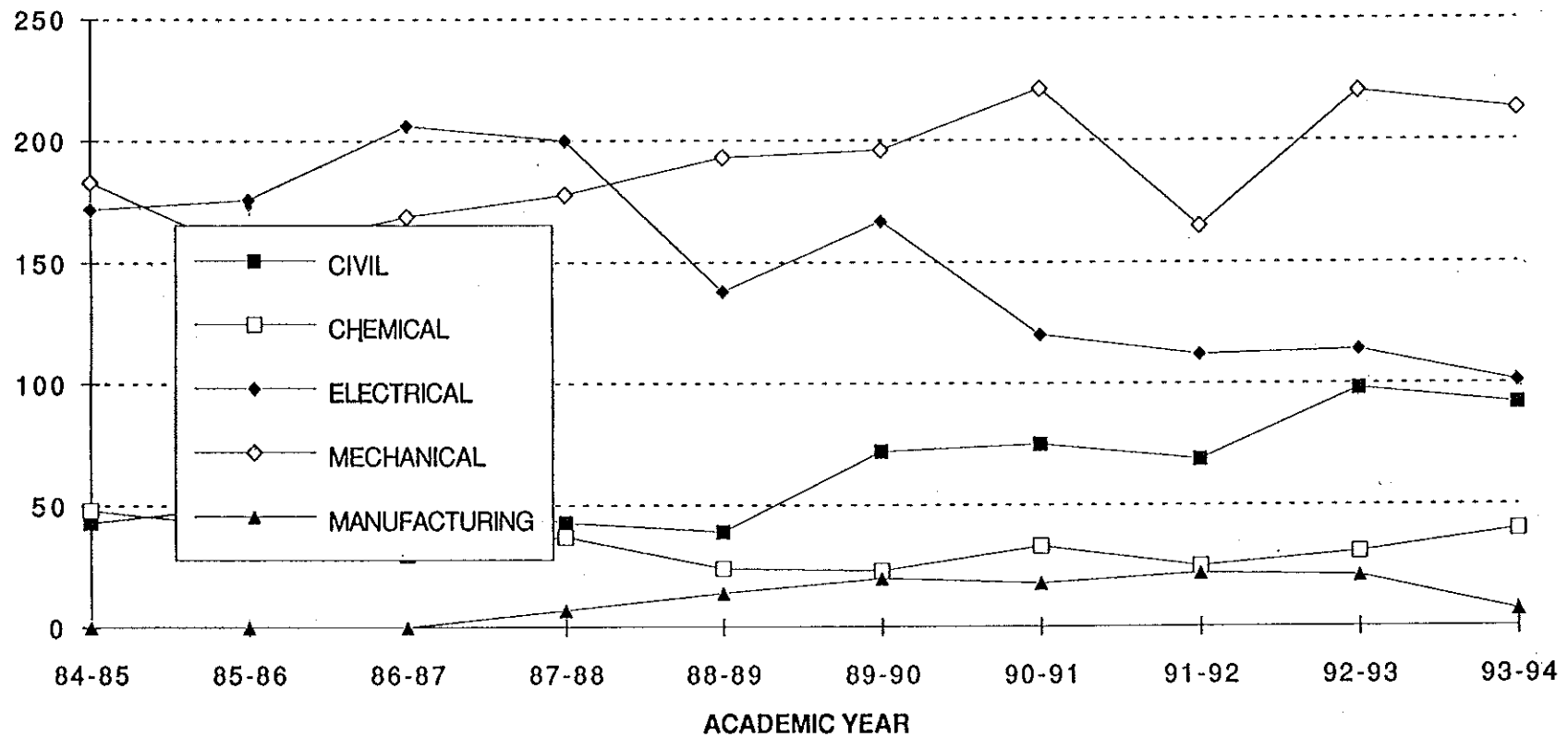

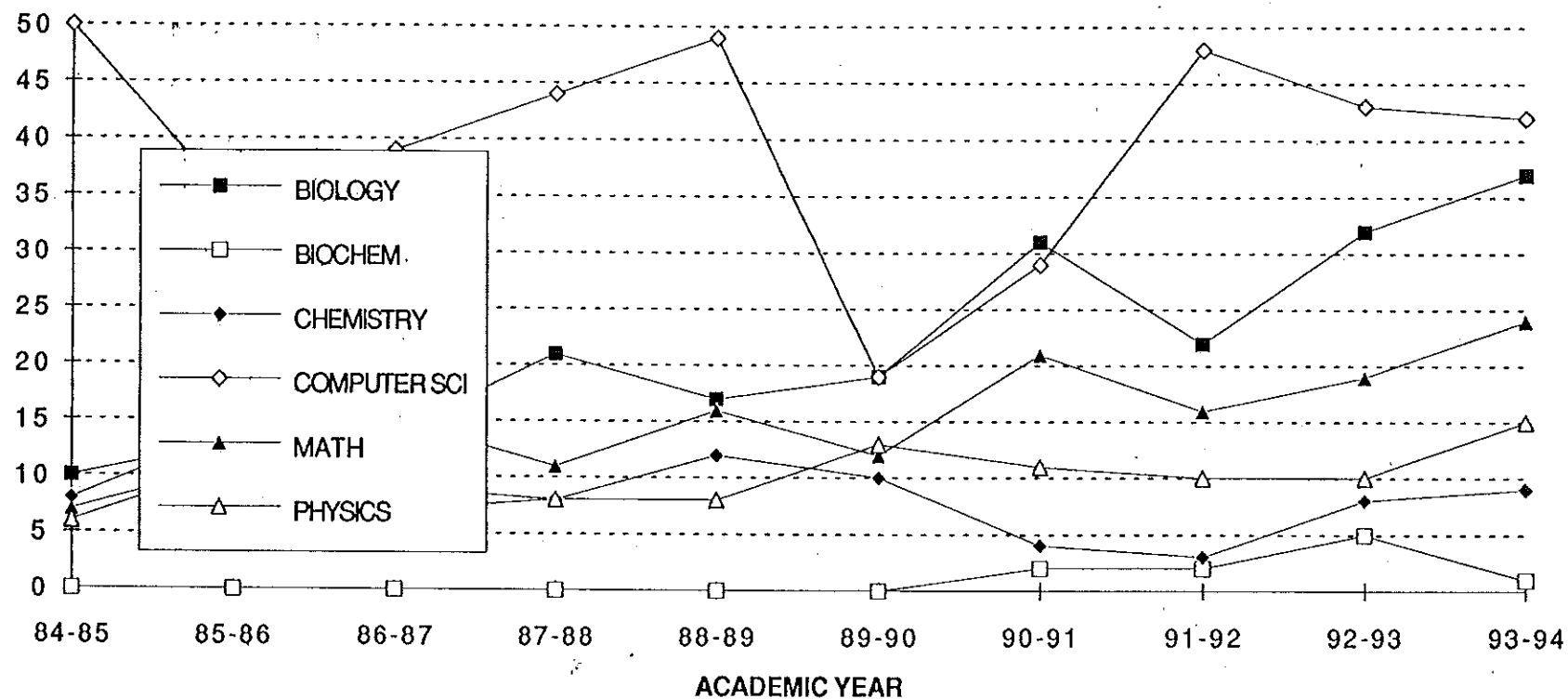

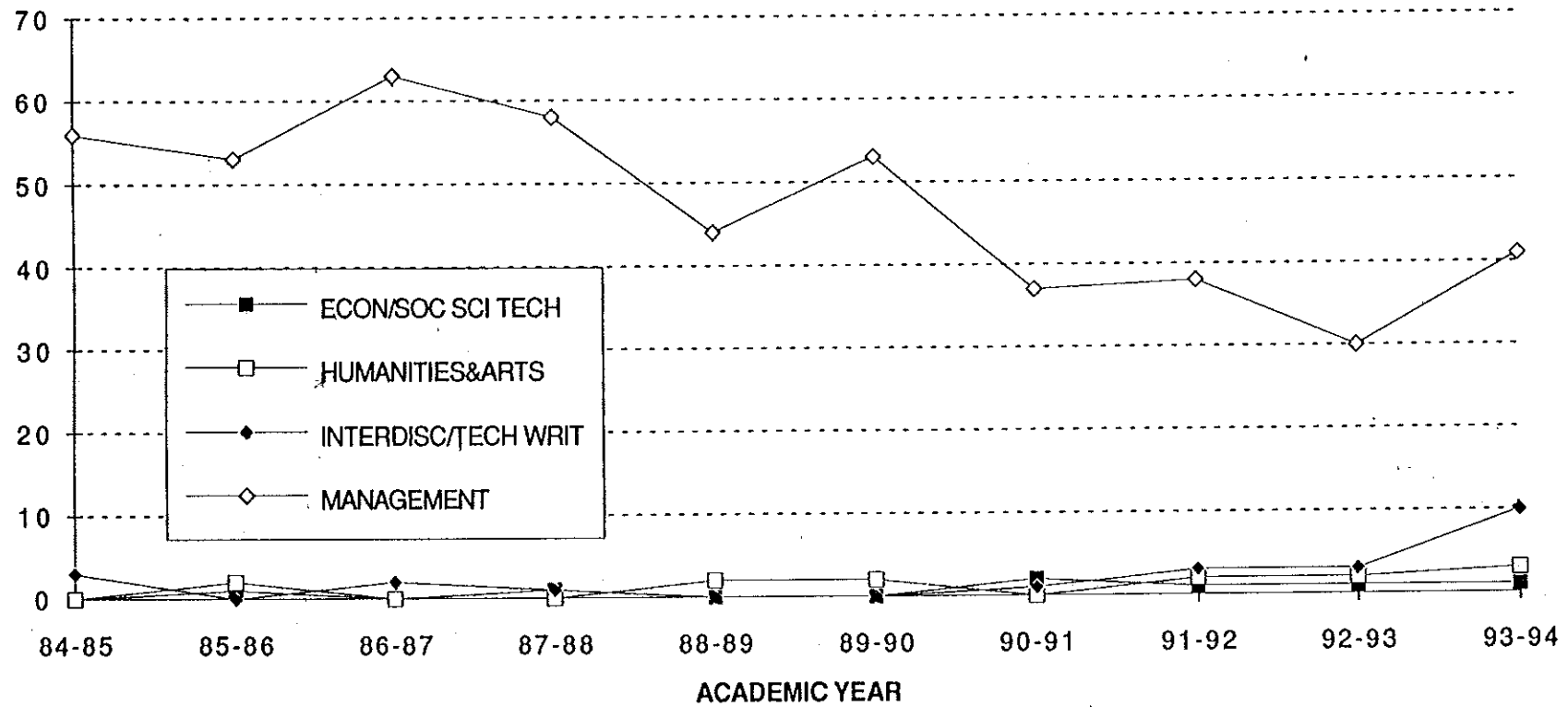
B.S. DEGREES AWARDED - ENGINEERING



B.S. DEGREES AWARDED - SCIENCES



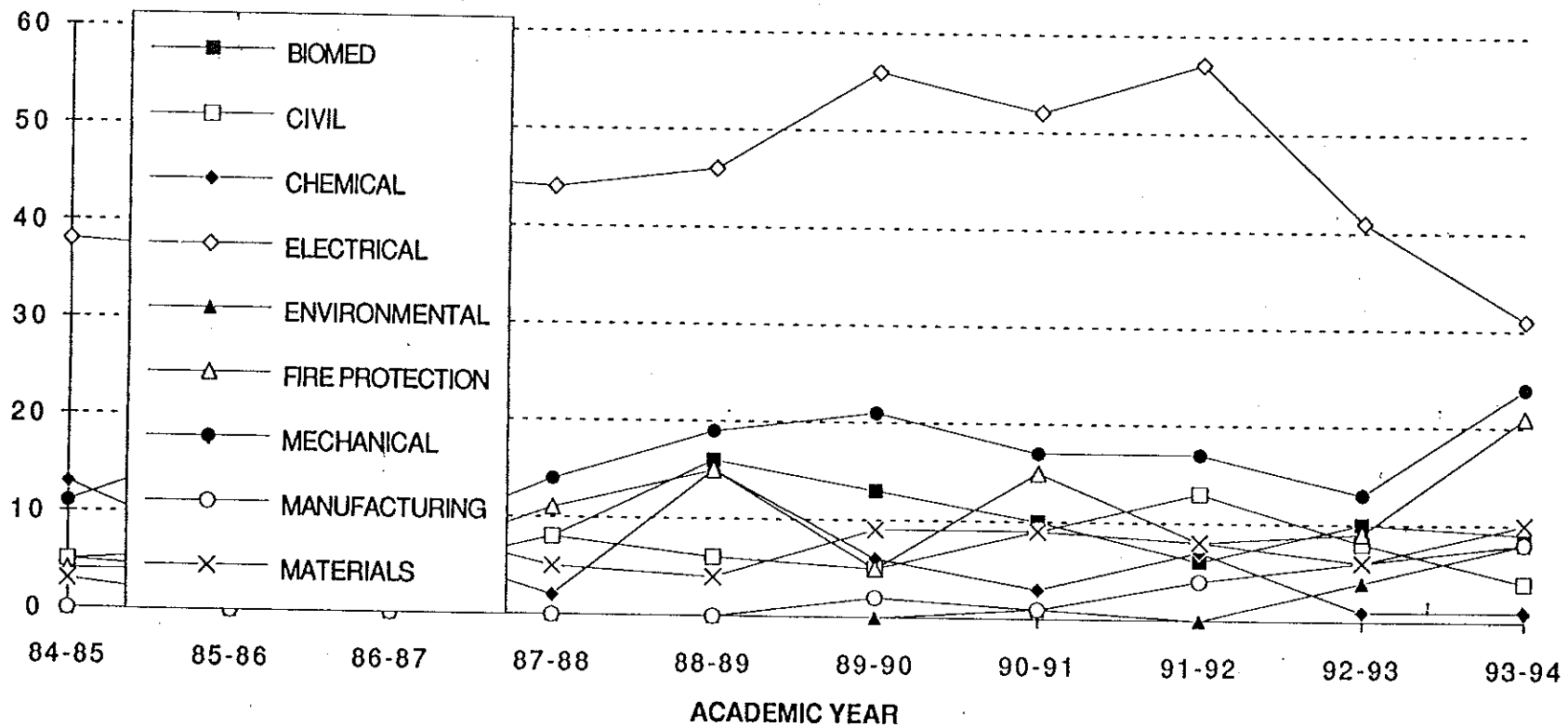

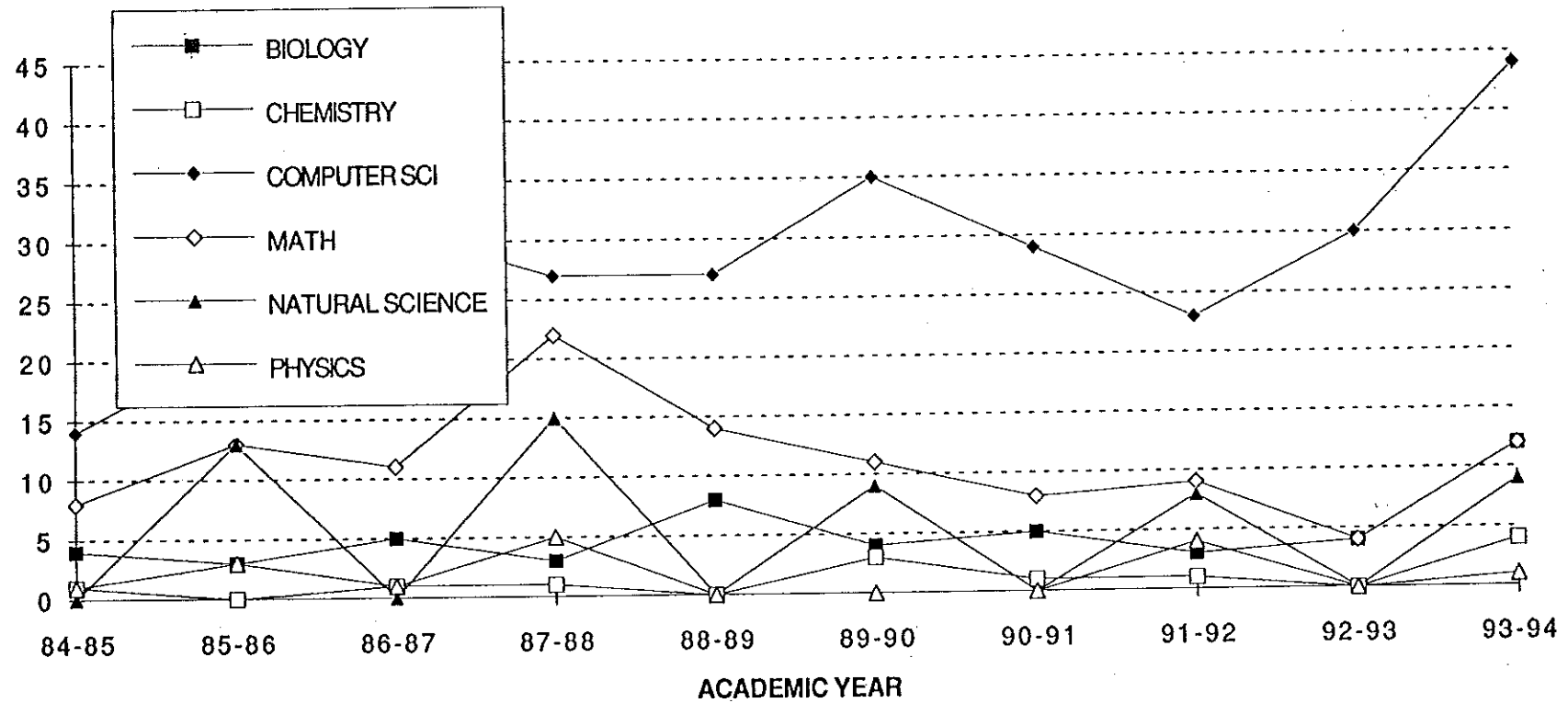

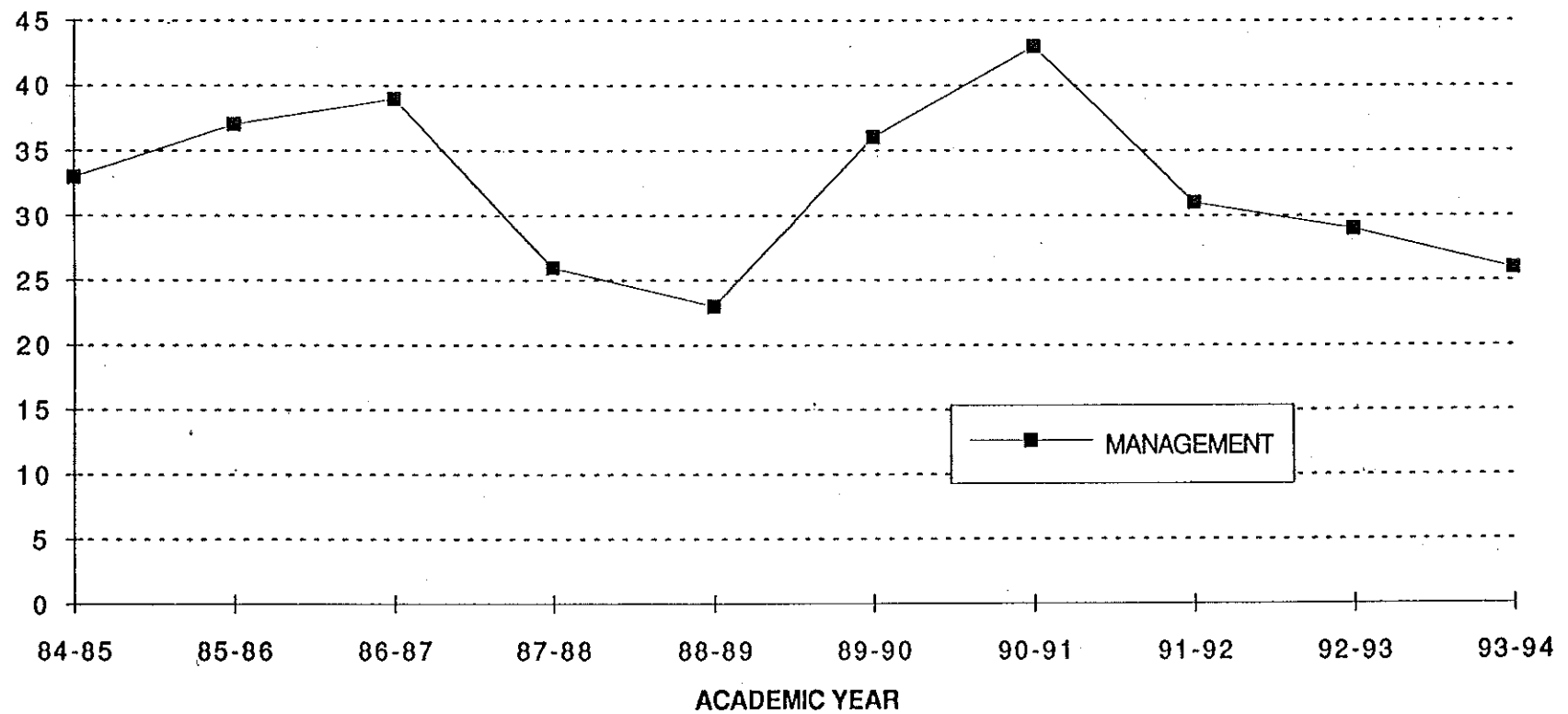
MASTERS DEGREES AWARDED - ENGINEERING



MASTERS DEGREES AWARDED - SCIENCES



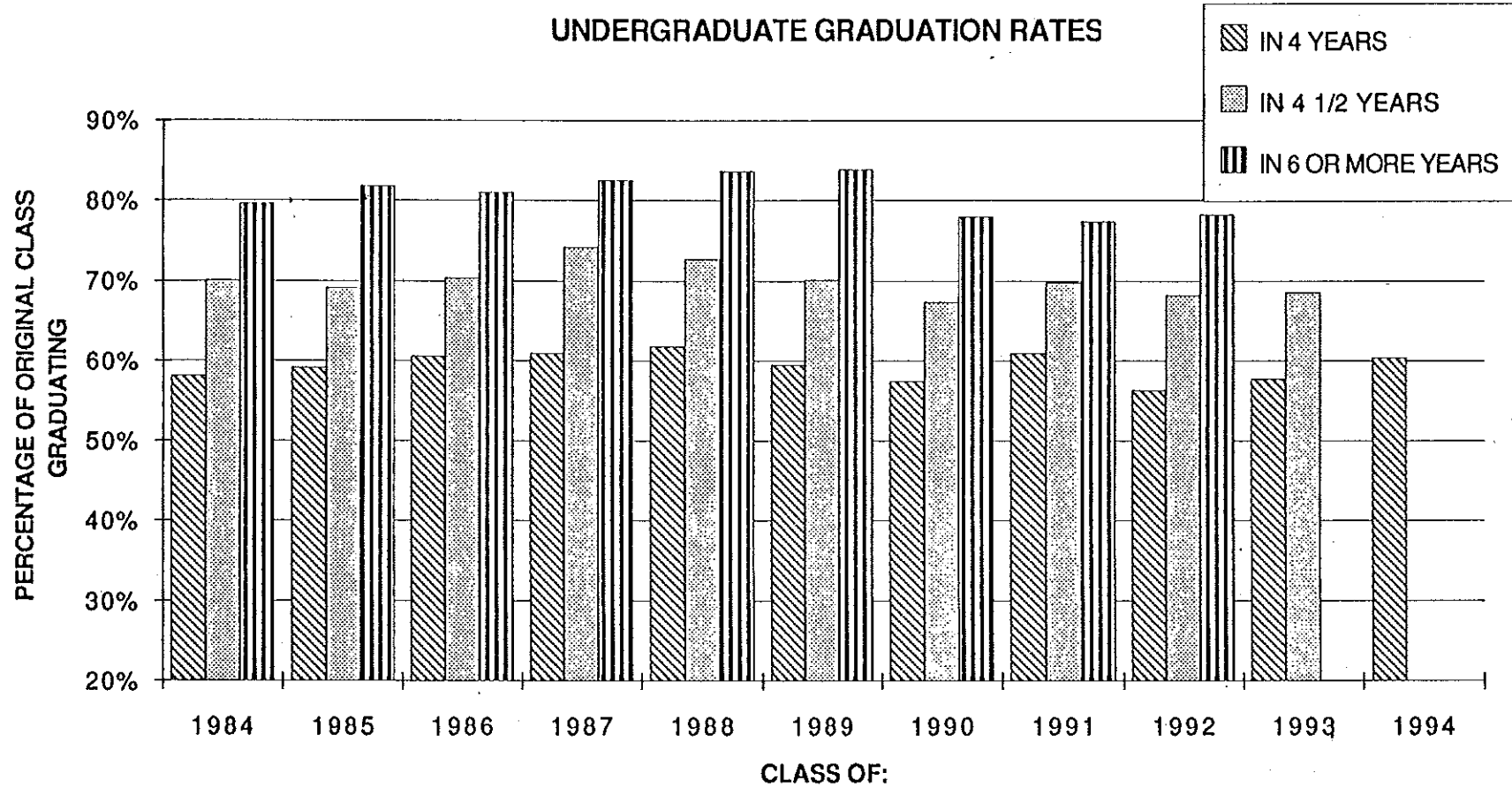
MASTERS DEGREES - MANAGEMENT

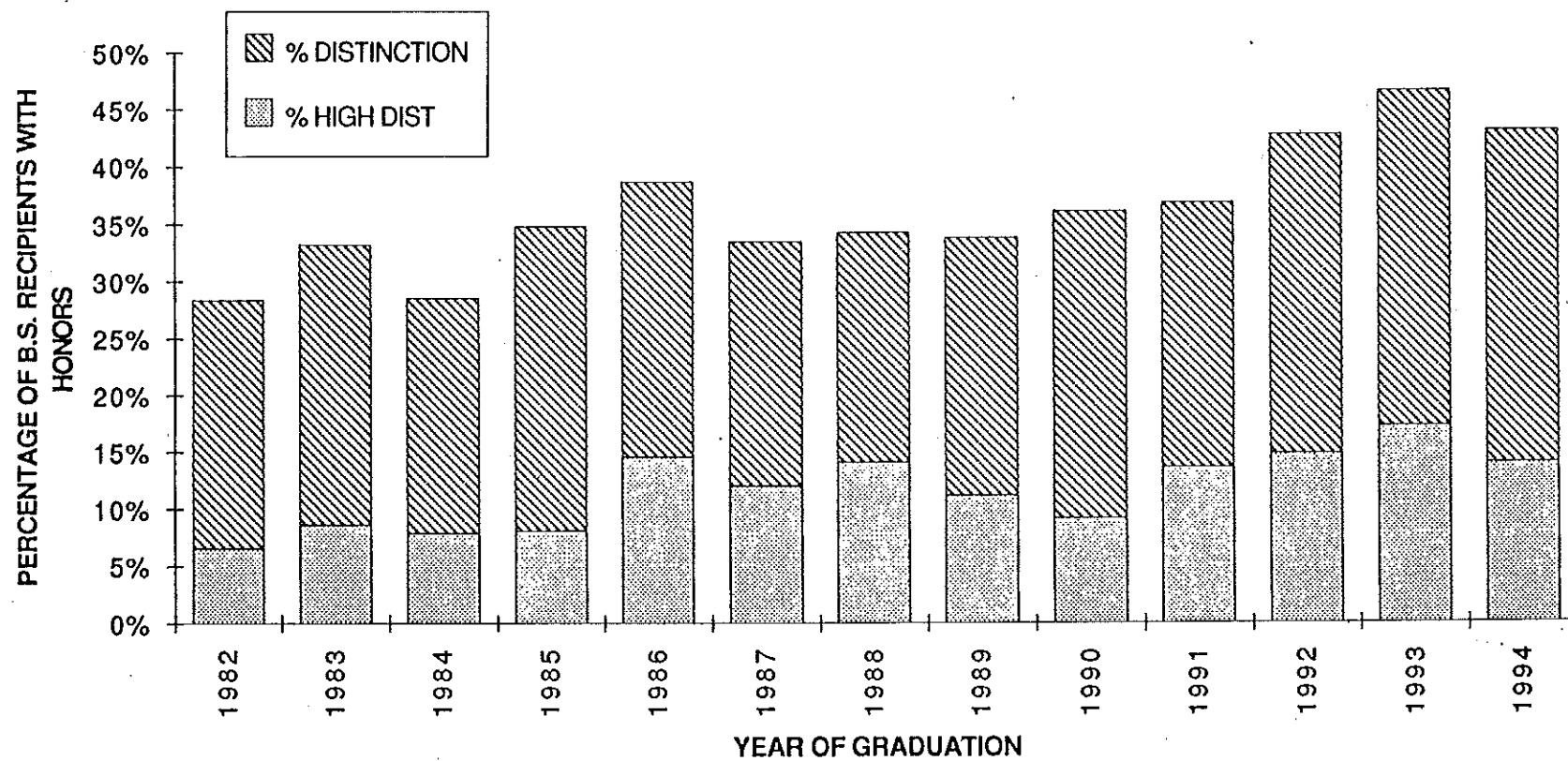

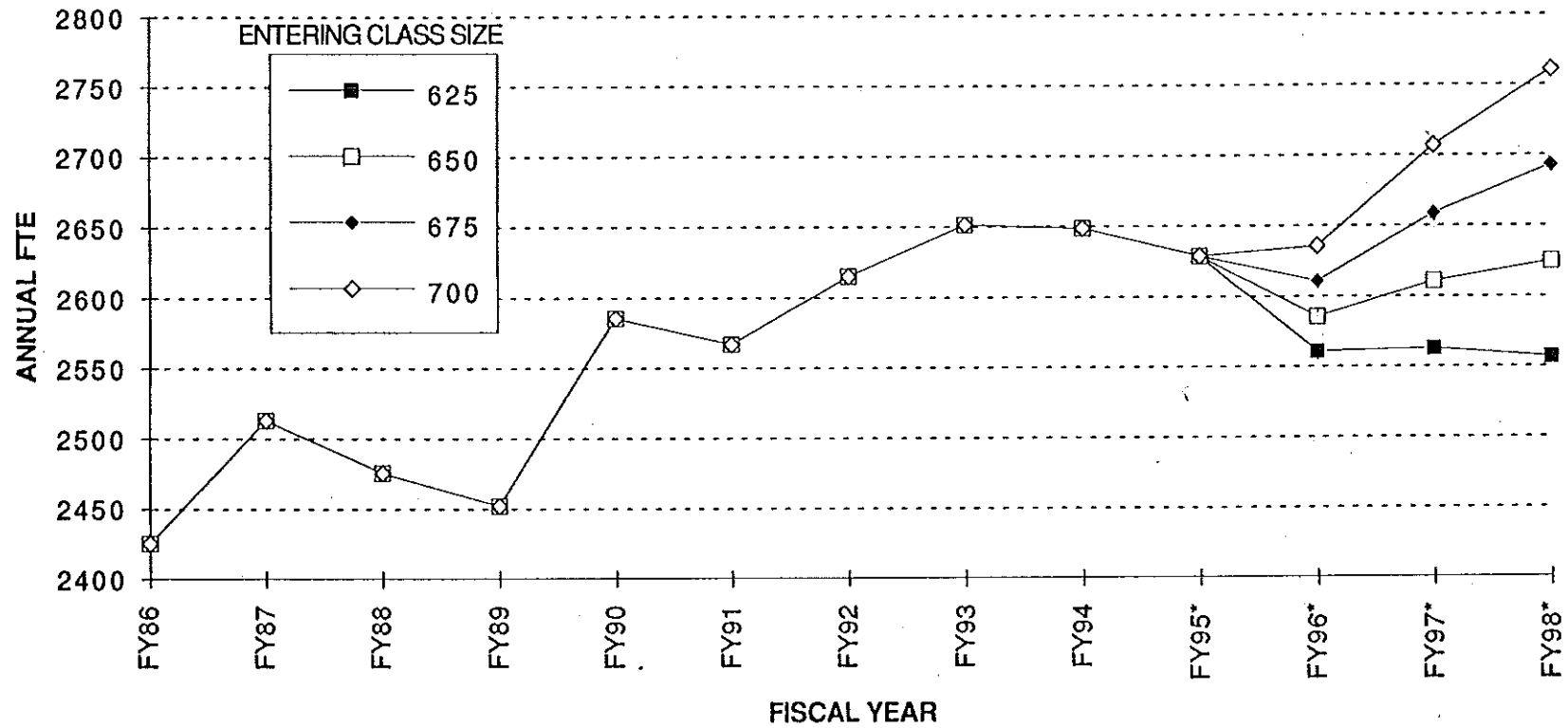
