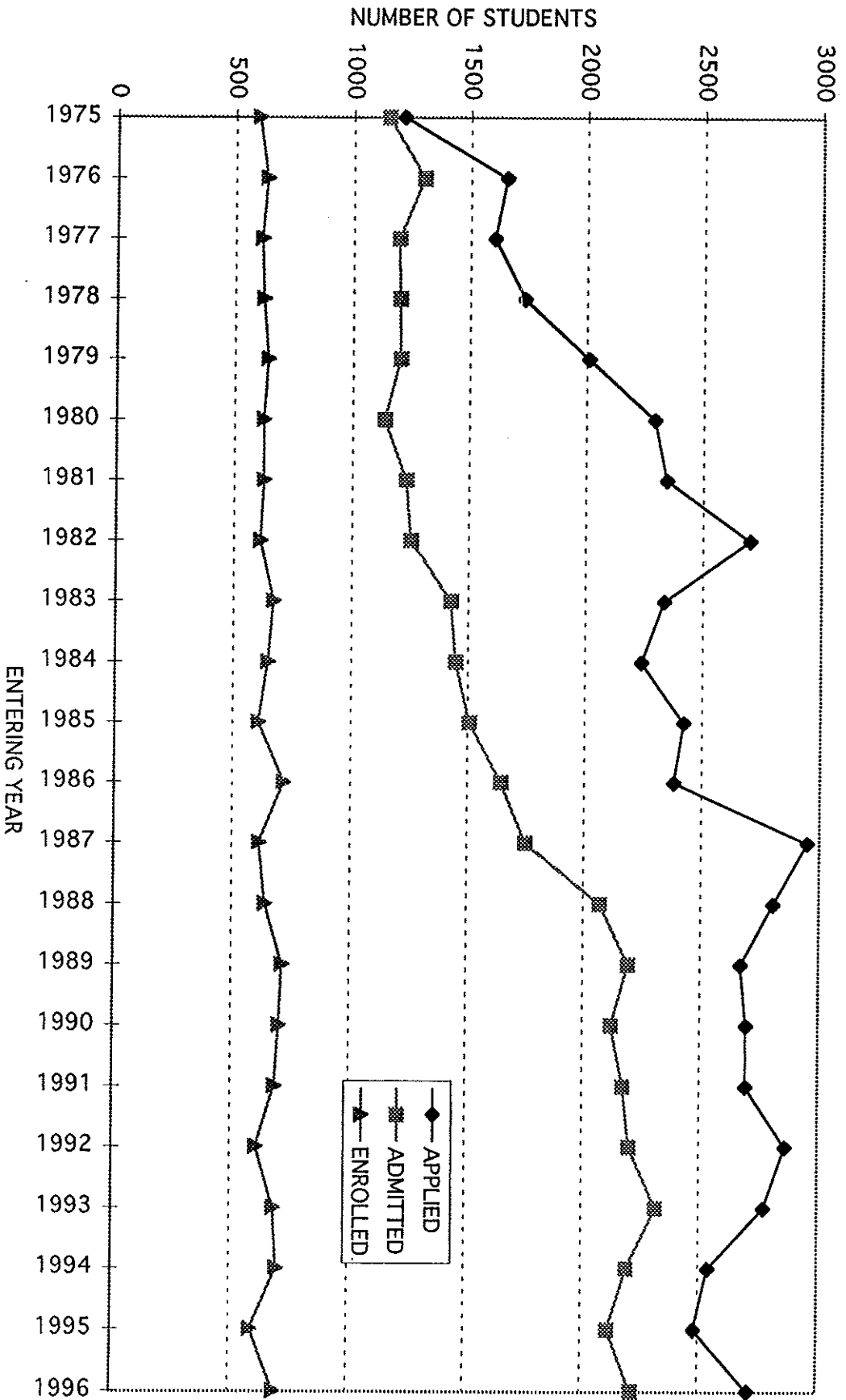

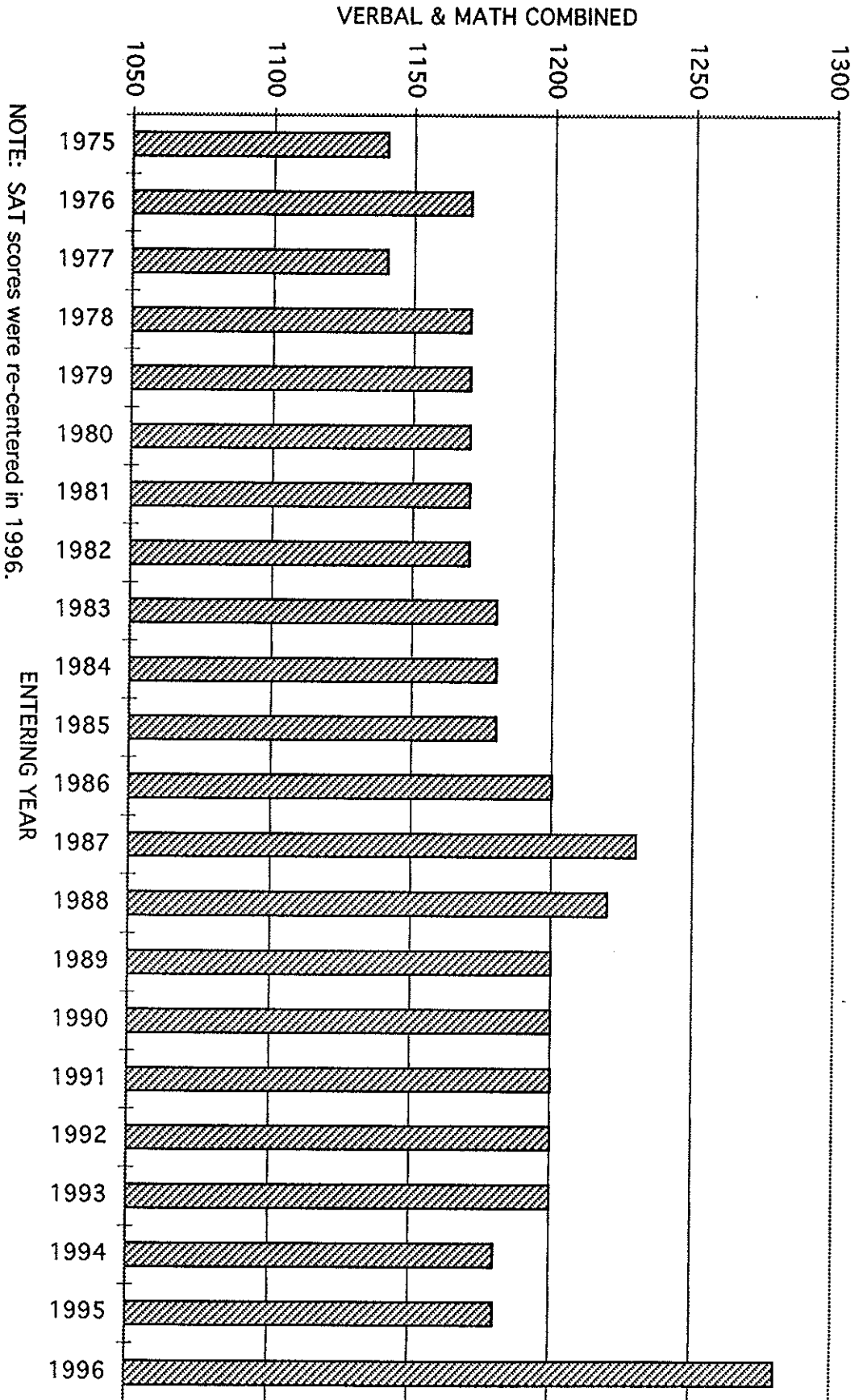

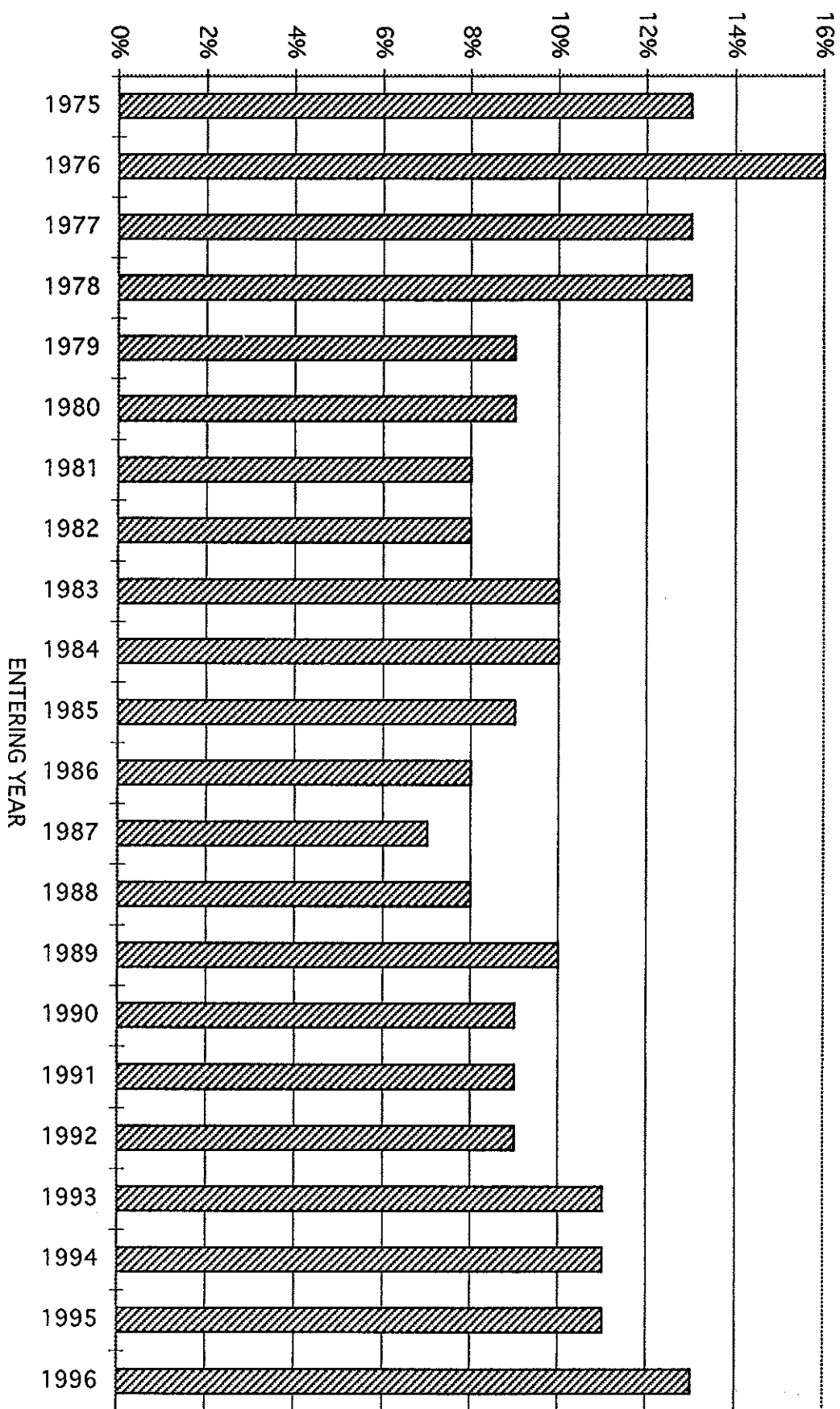
UNDERGRADUATE ADMISSIONS DATA

MEDIAN CLASS RANK



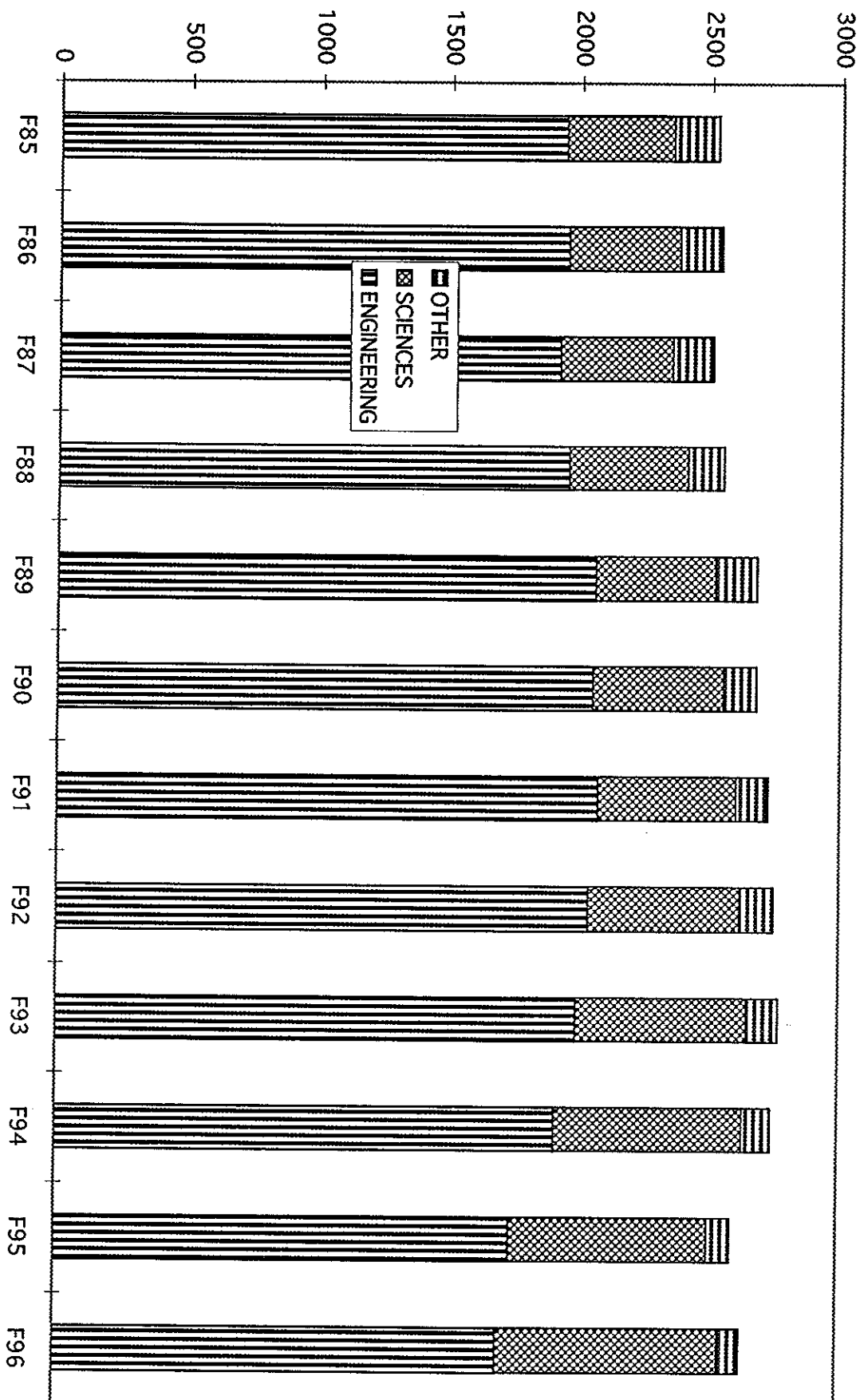

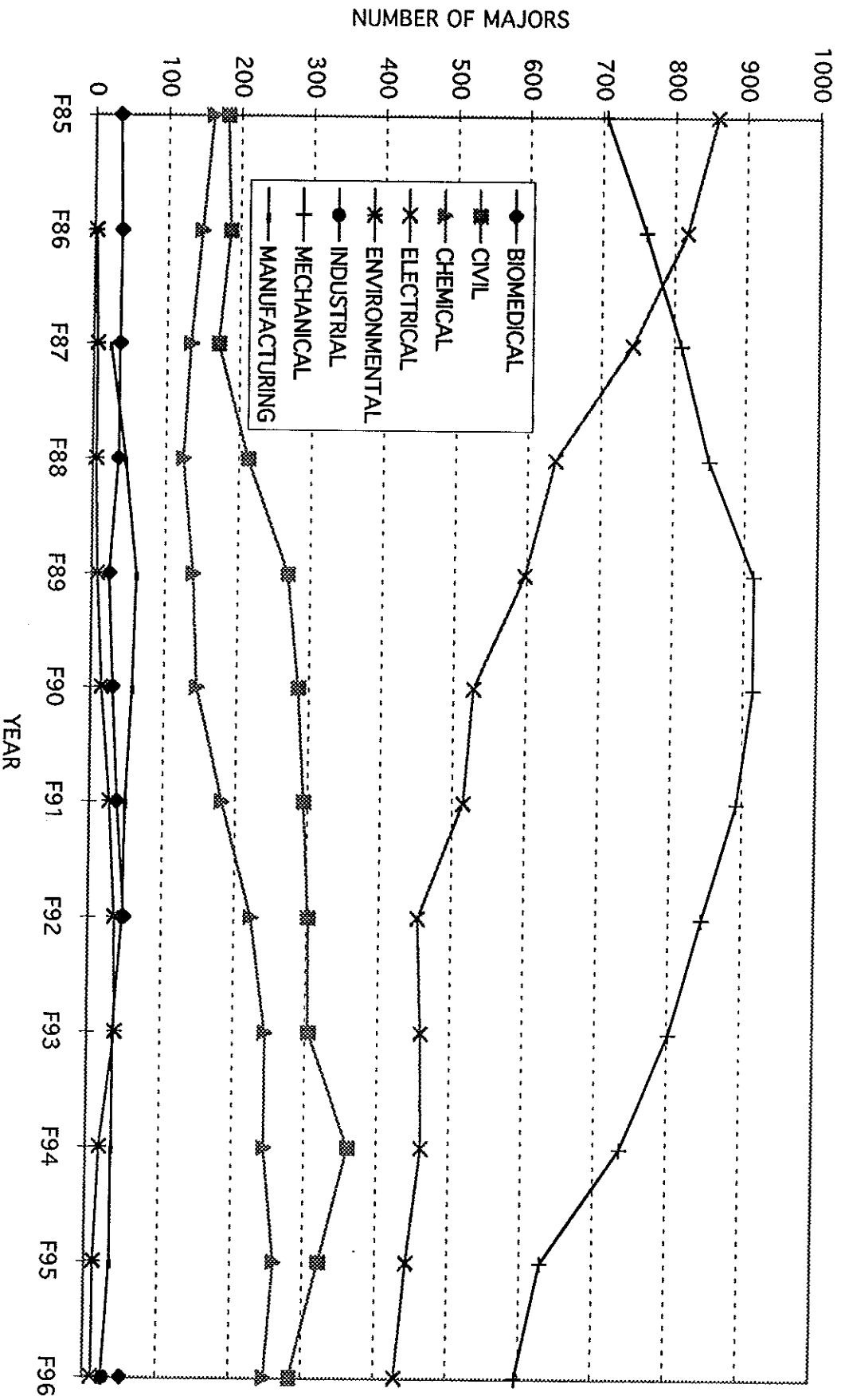

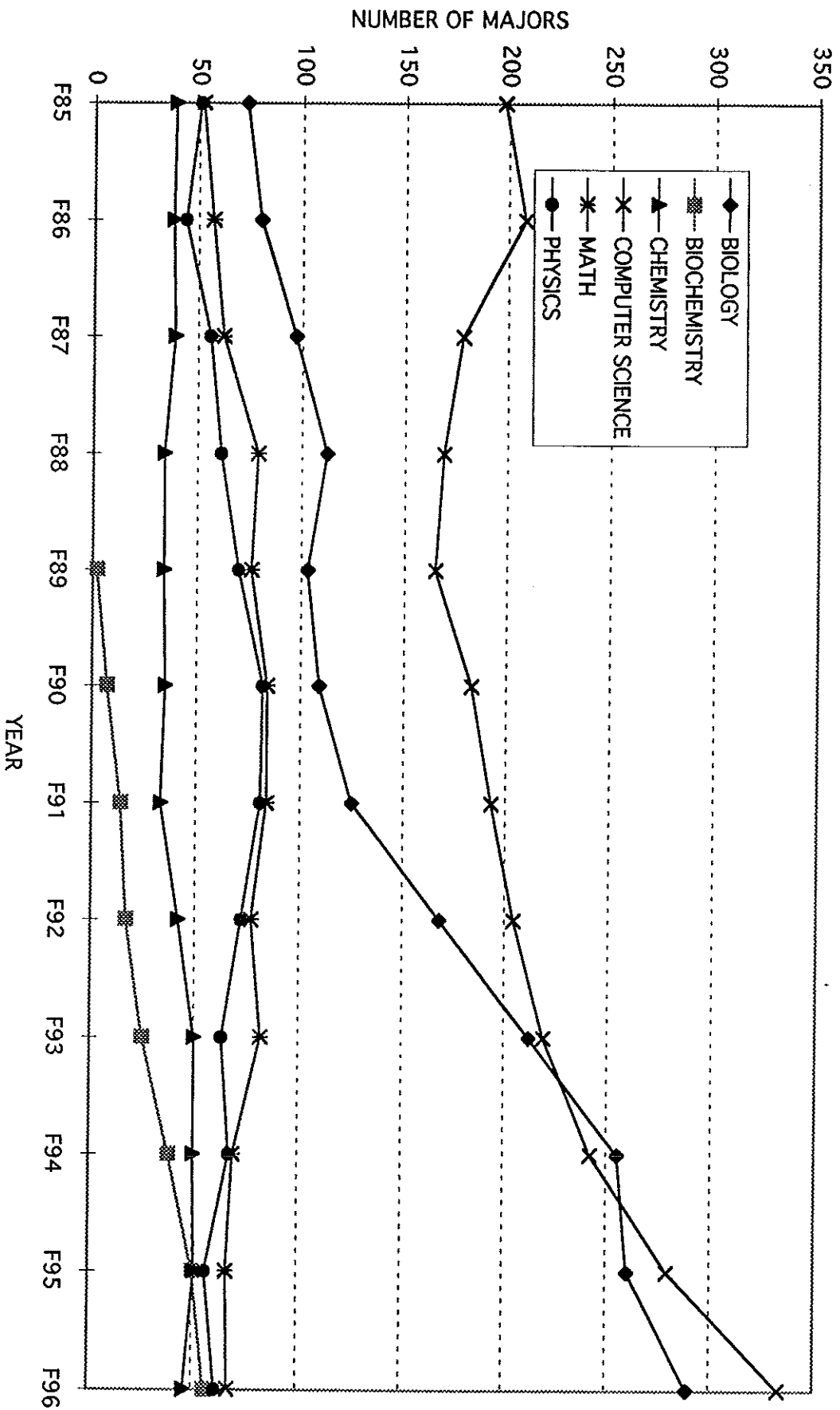
UNDERGRADUATE ENROLLMENT BY CATEGORY



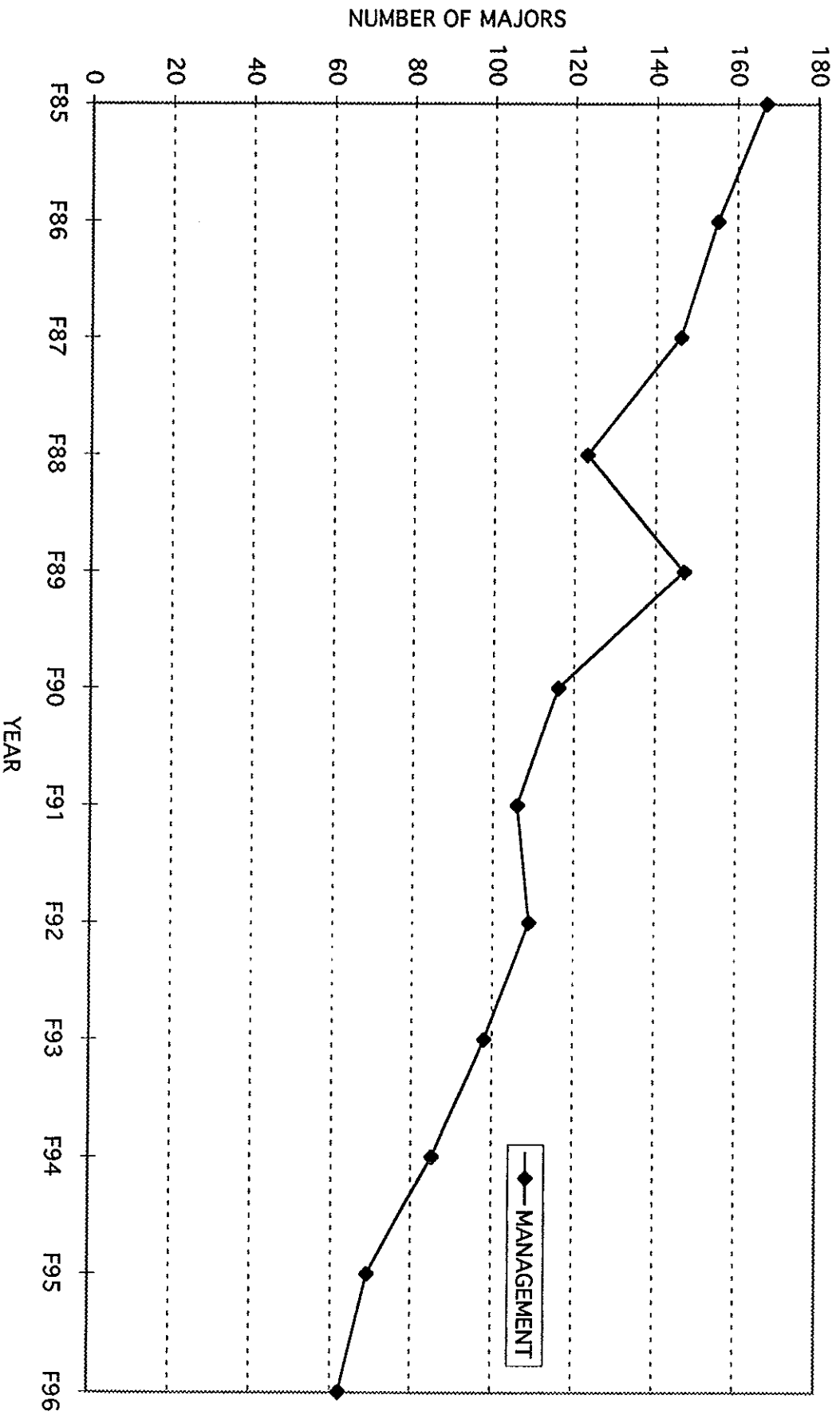
UNDERGRADUATE ENROLLMENT - ENGINEERING

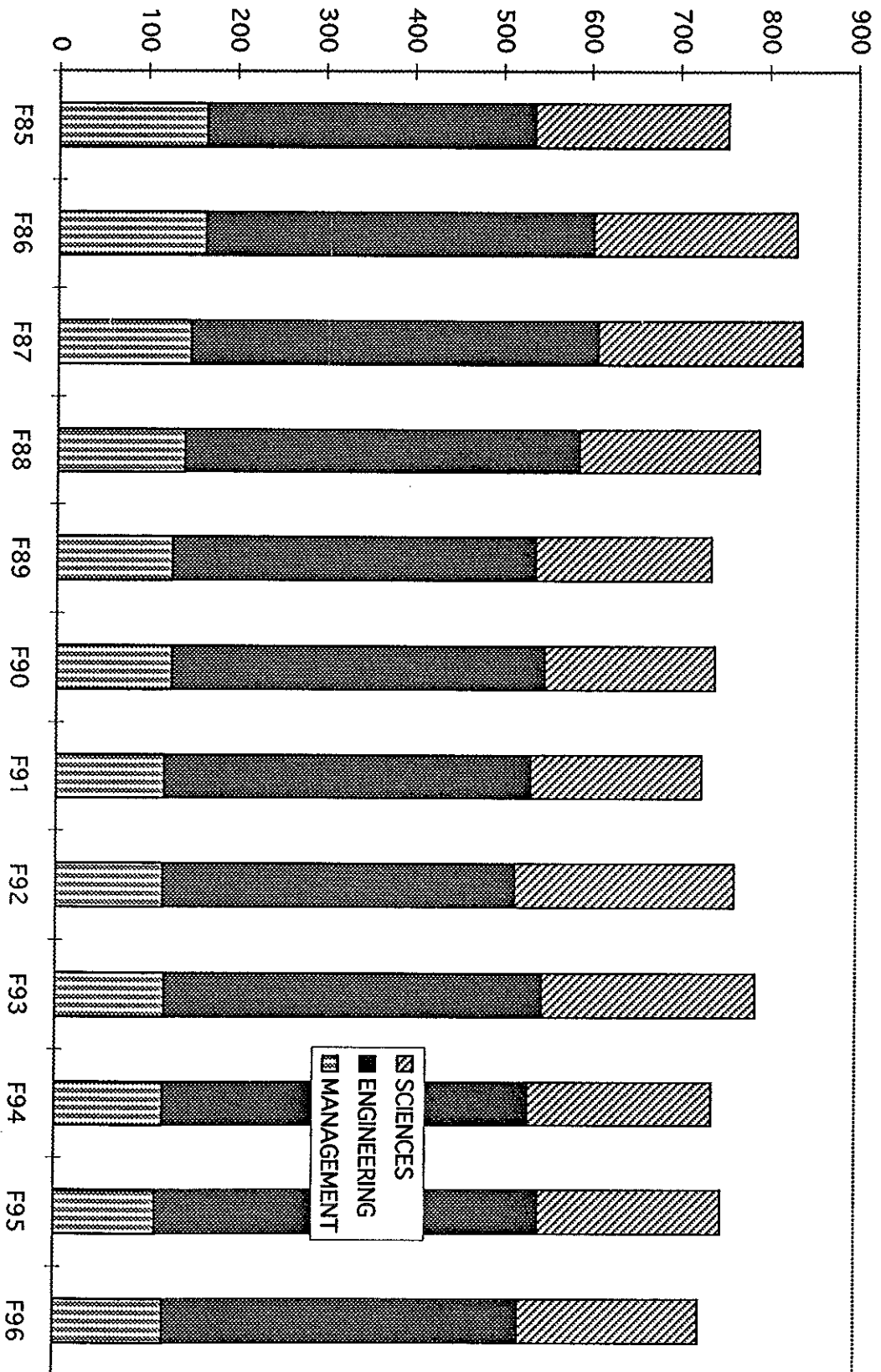

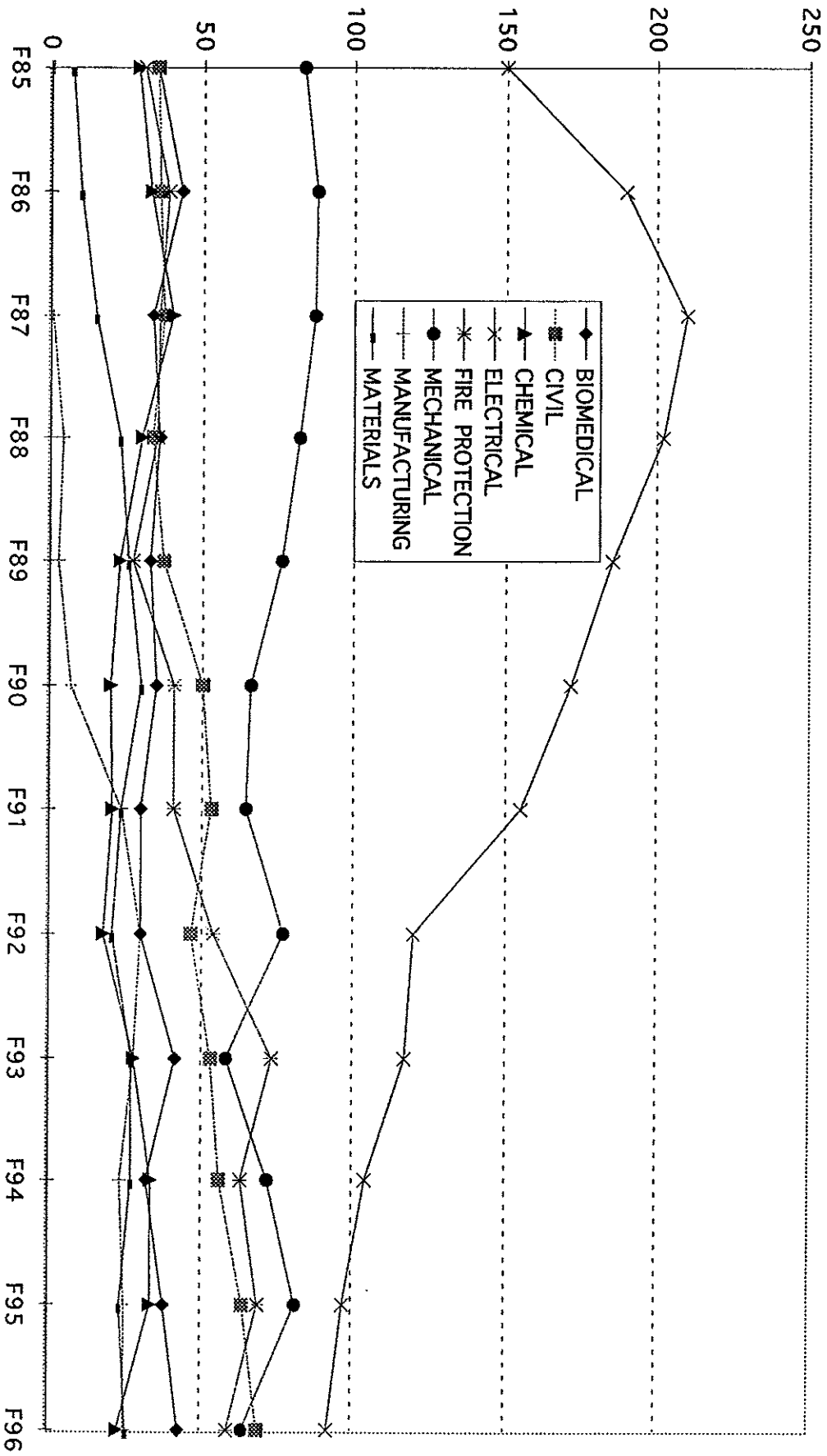

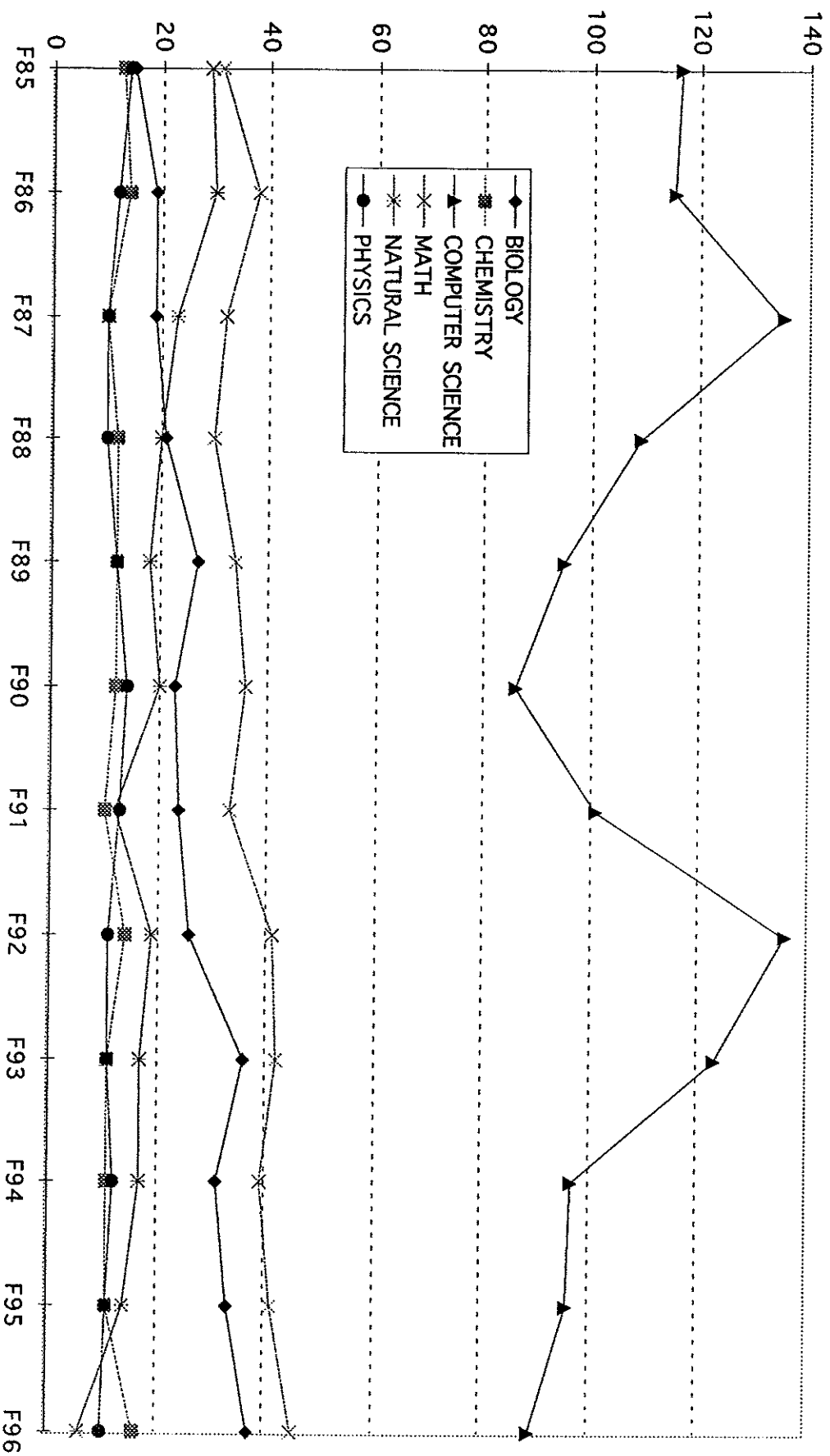
GRADUATE ENROLLMENT BY CATEGORY



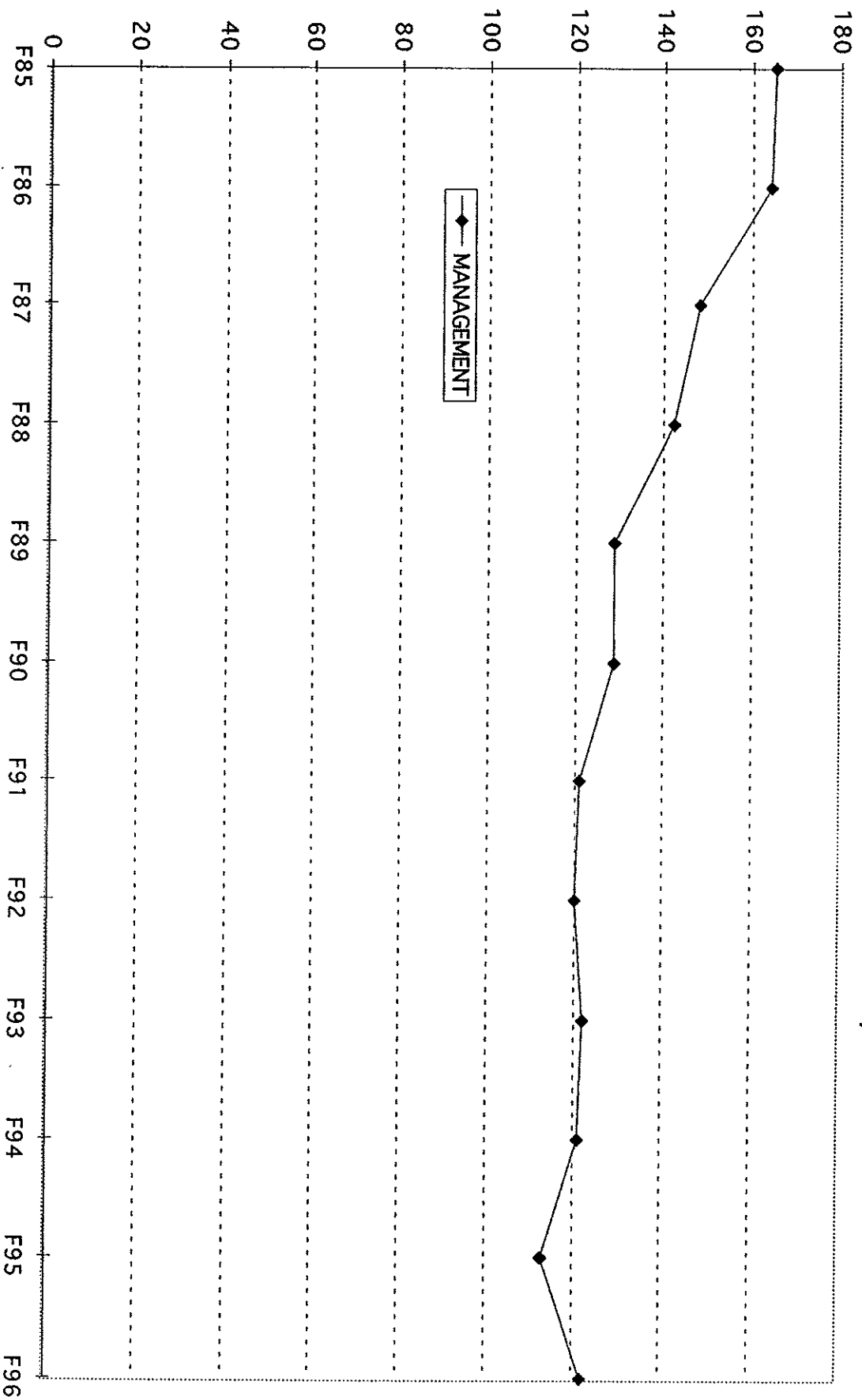
GRADUATE ENROLLMENT - ENGINEERING (FT AND PT DEGREE-SEEKING STUDENTS)

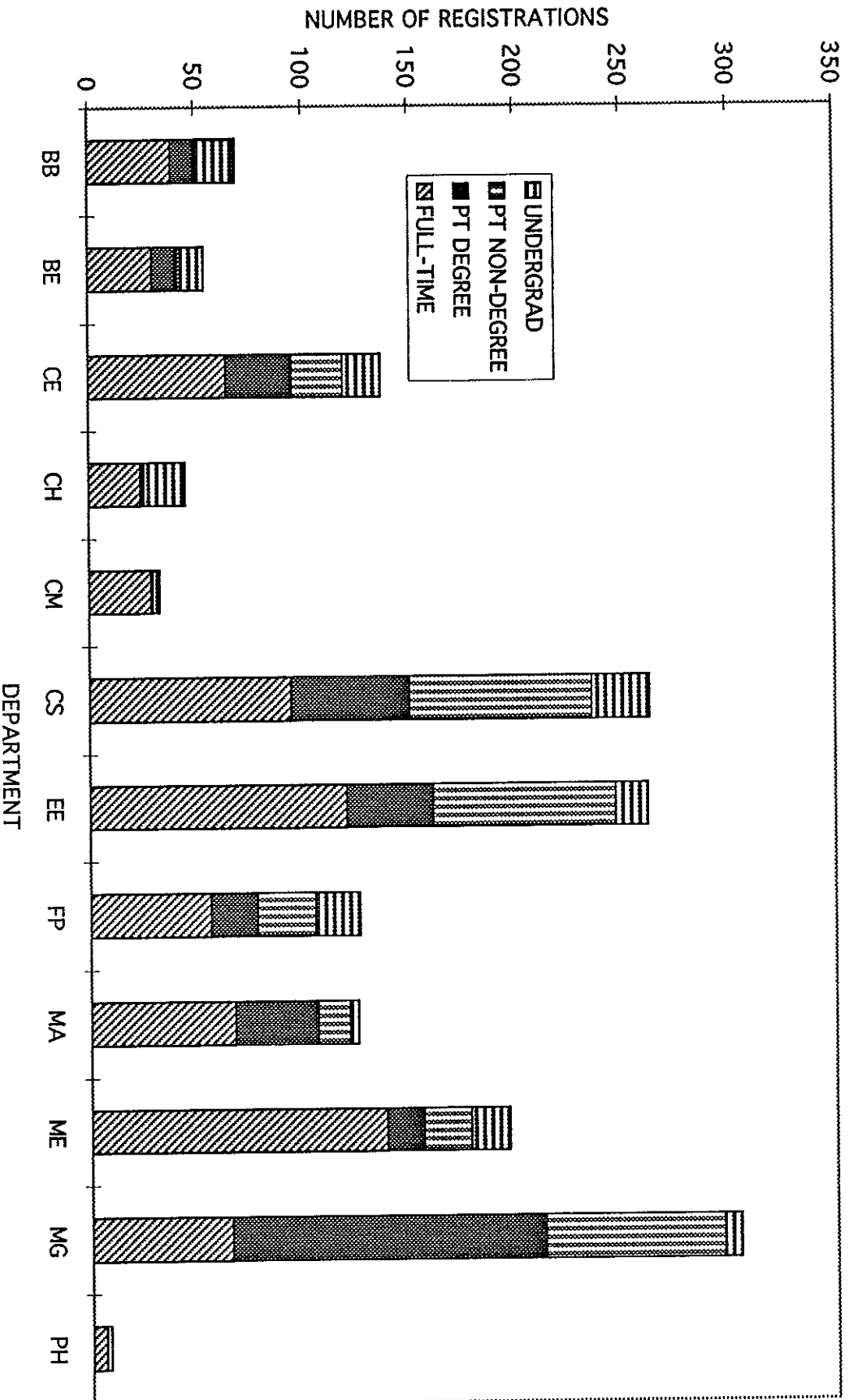

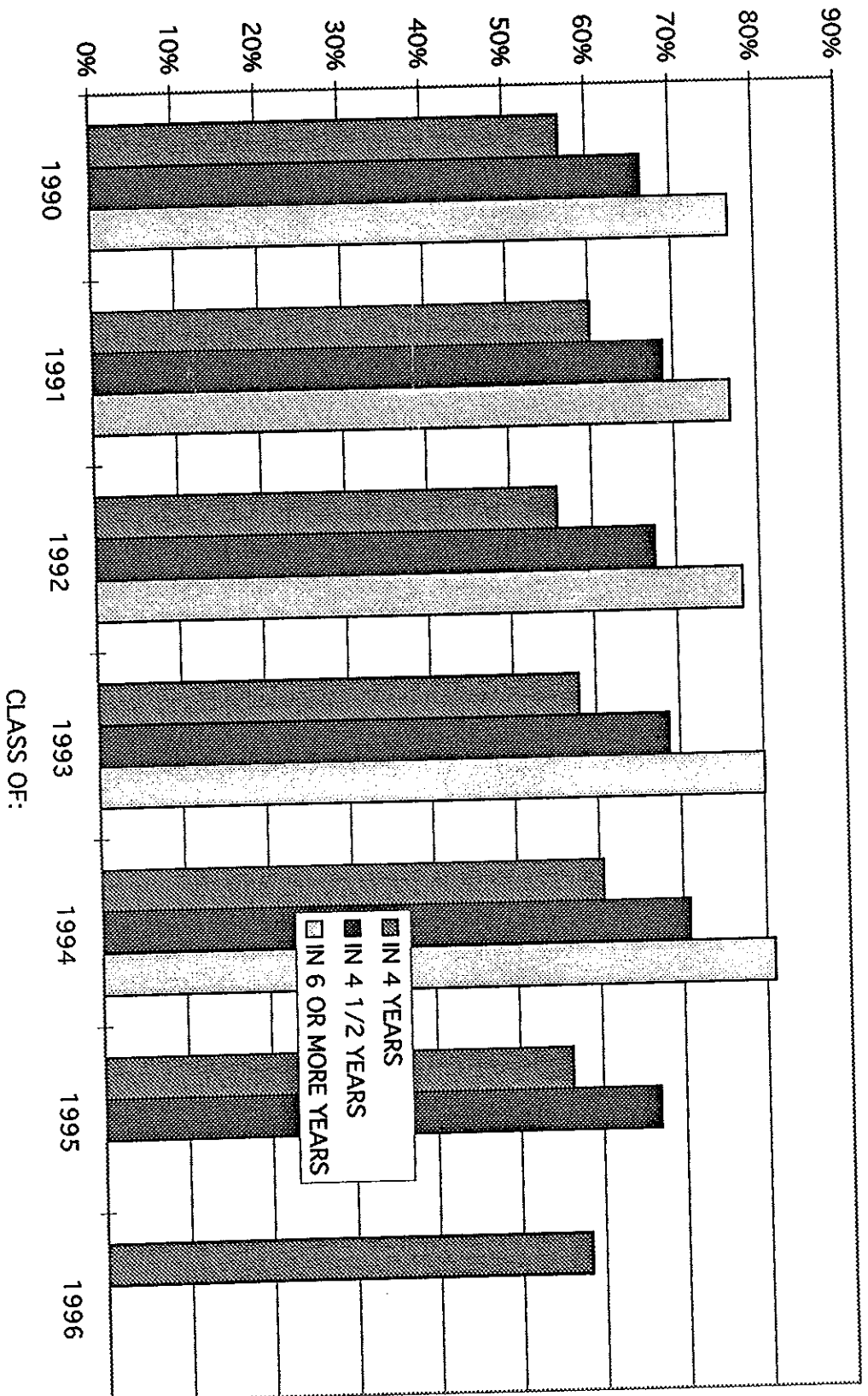
