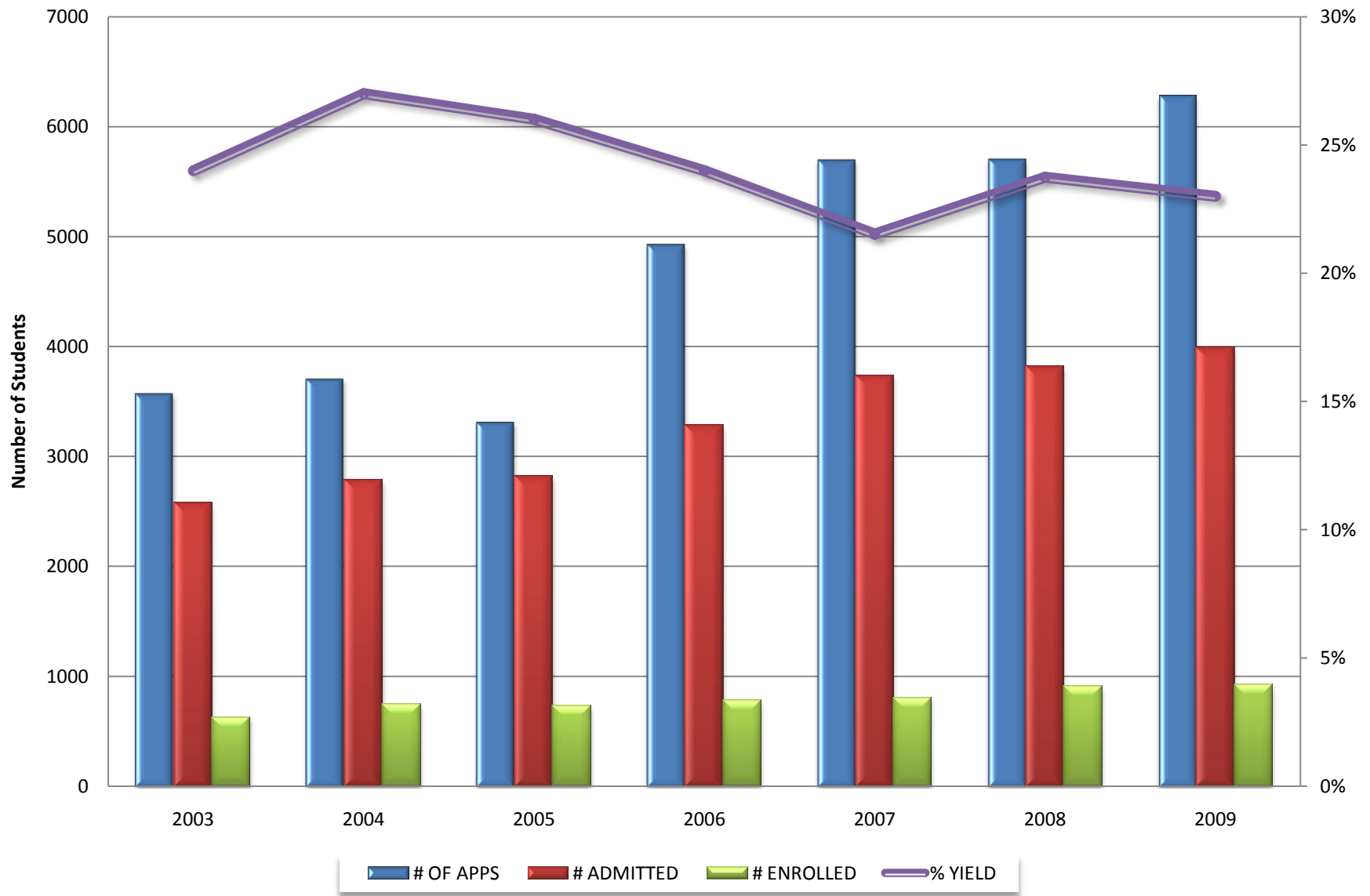

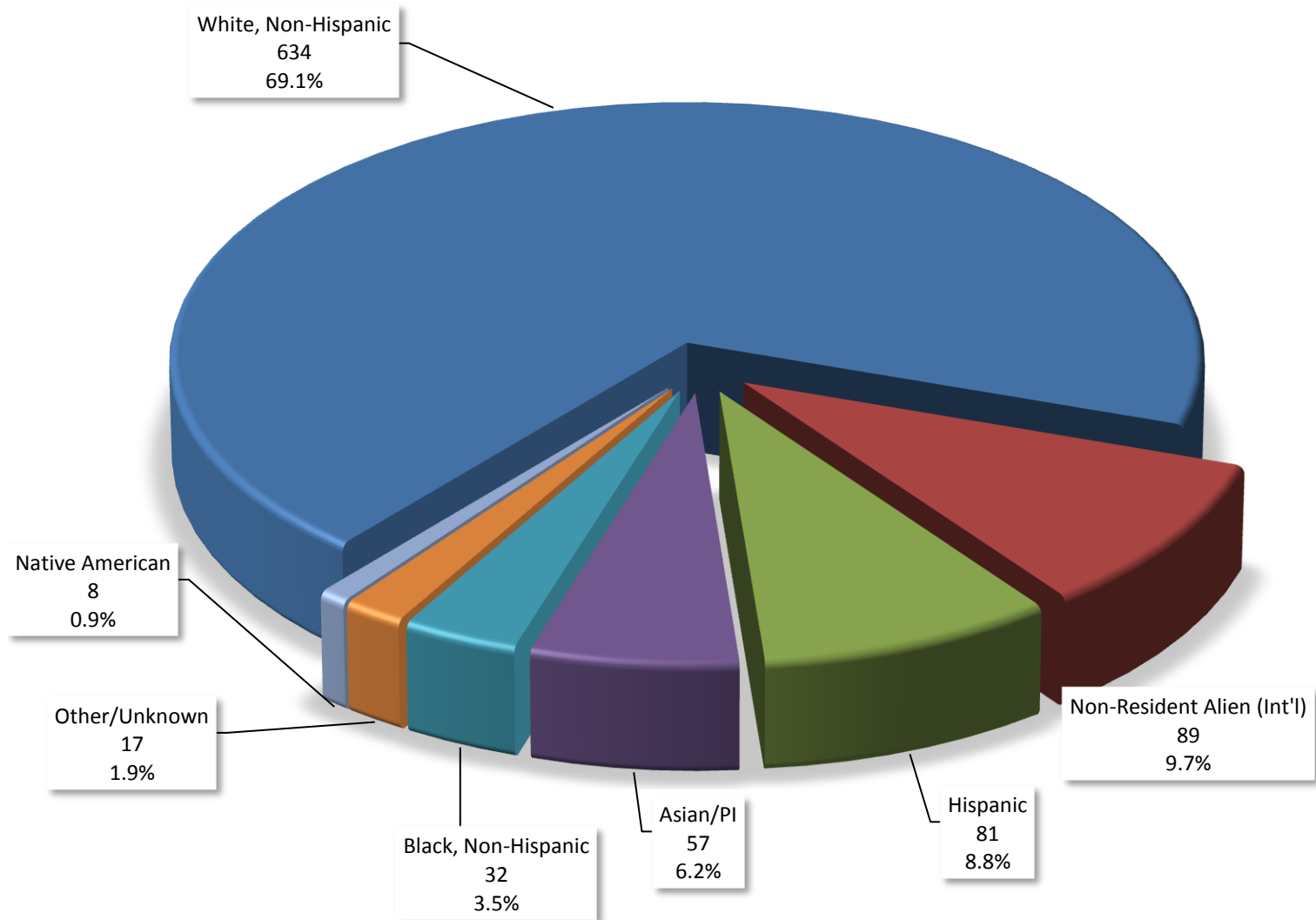

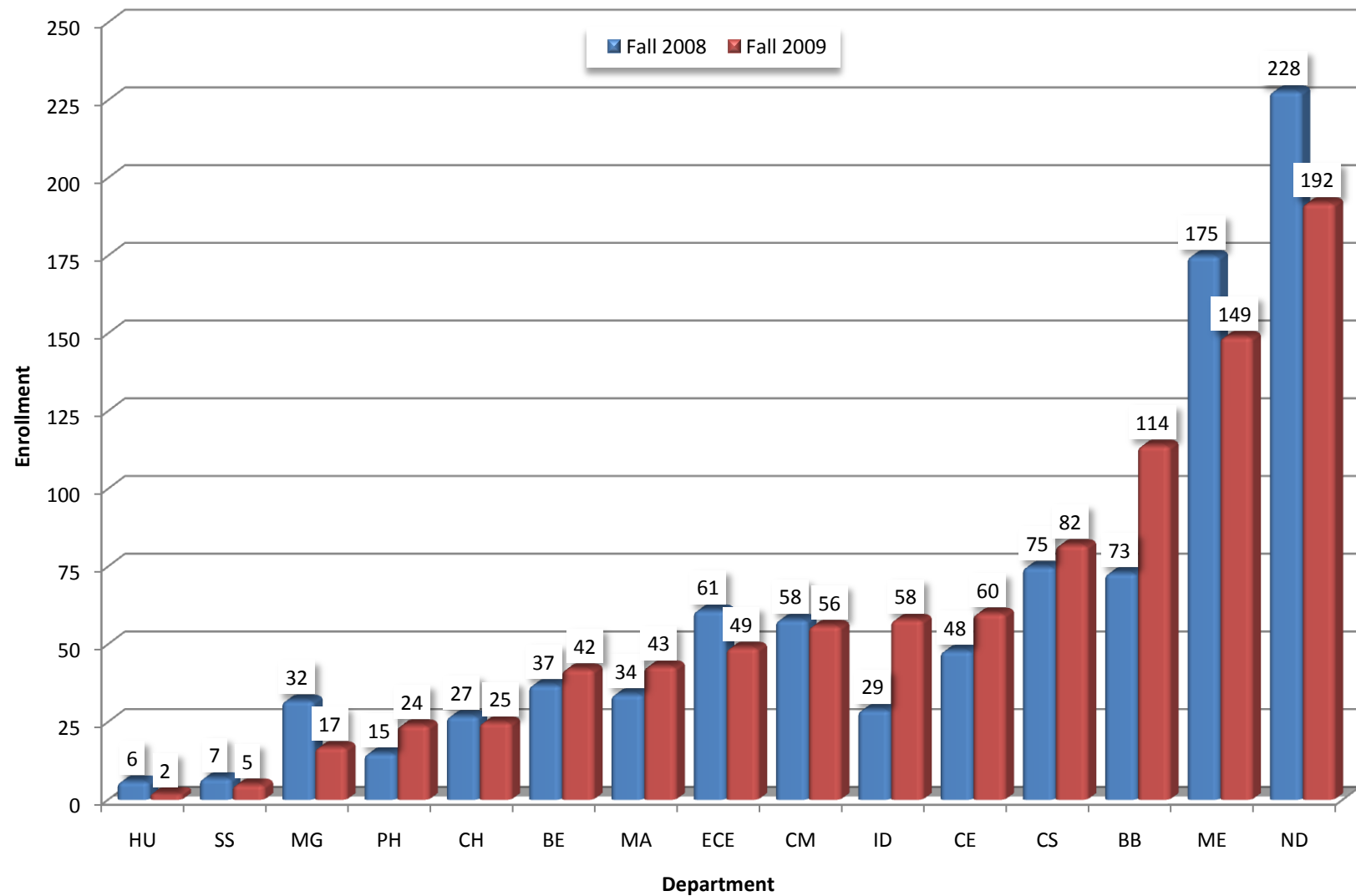
First-Time, Full-Time Freshman Ethnicity, Fall 2009

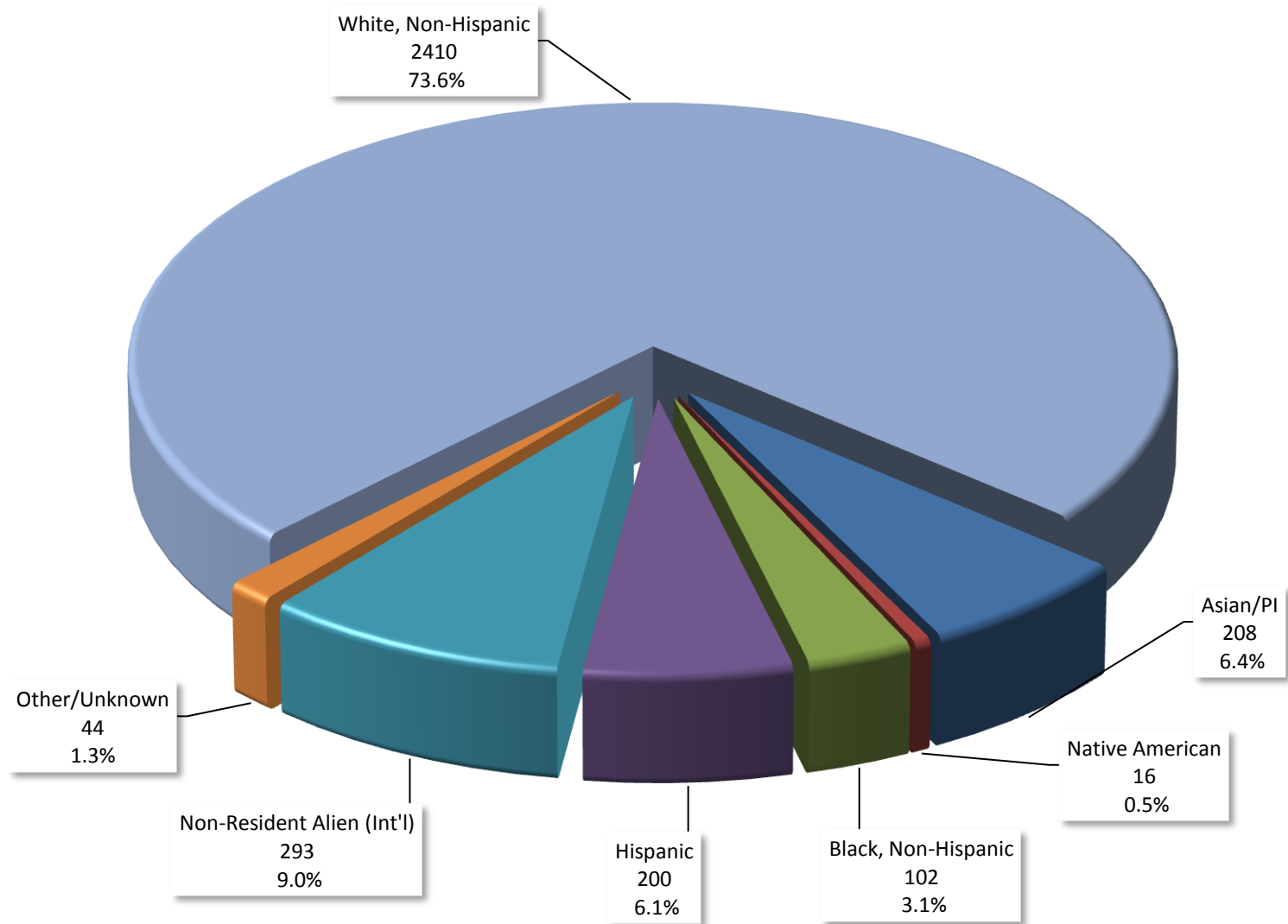

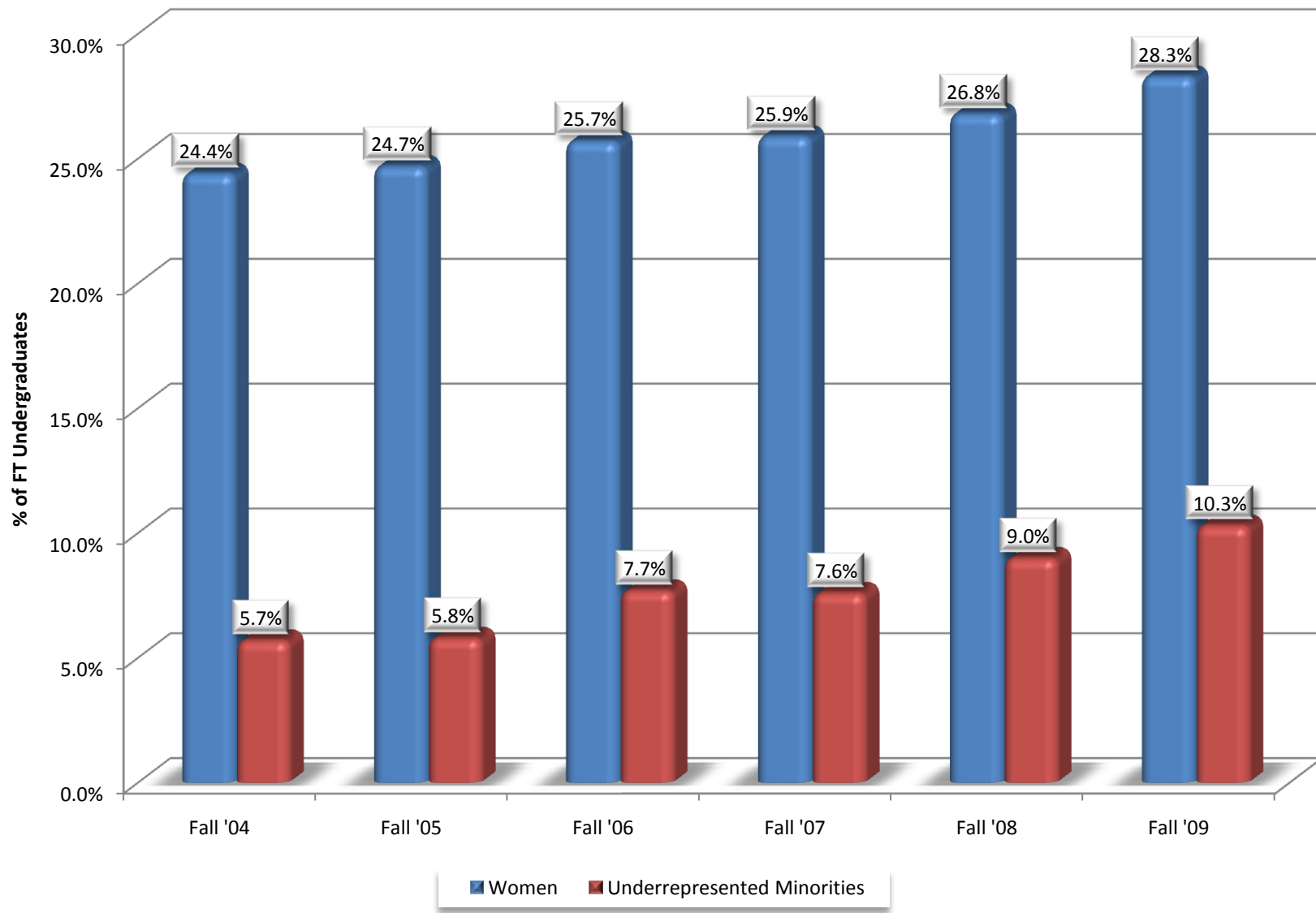

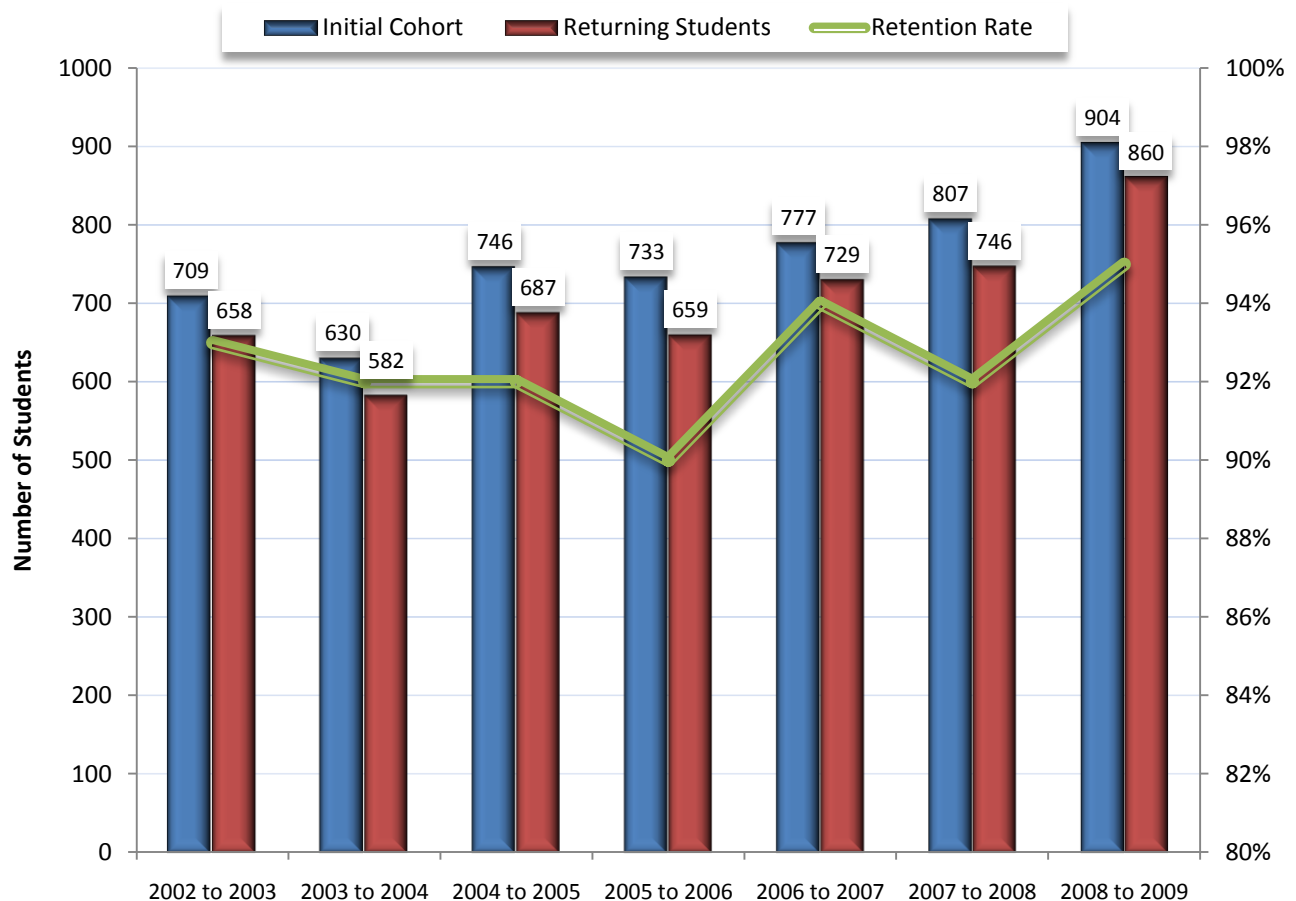

Freshman to Sophomore Retention Rates, 2002 to 2009

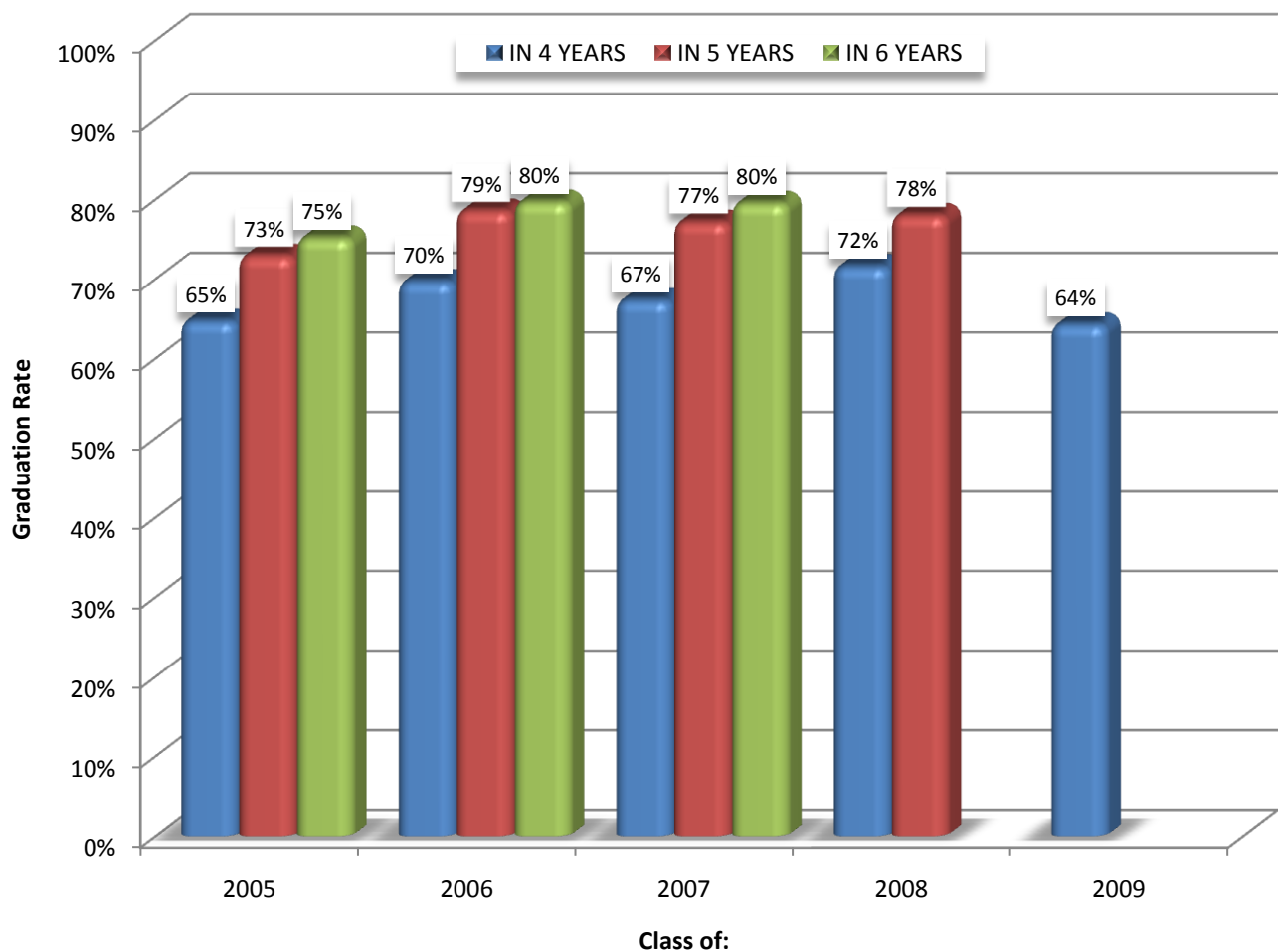

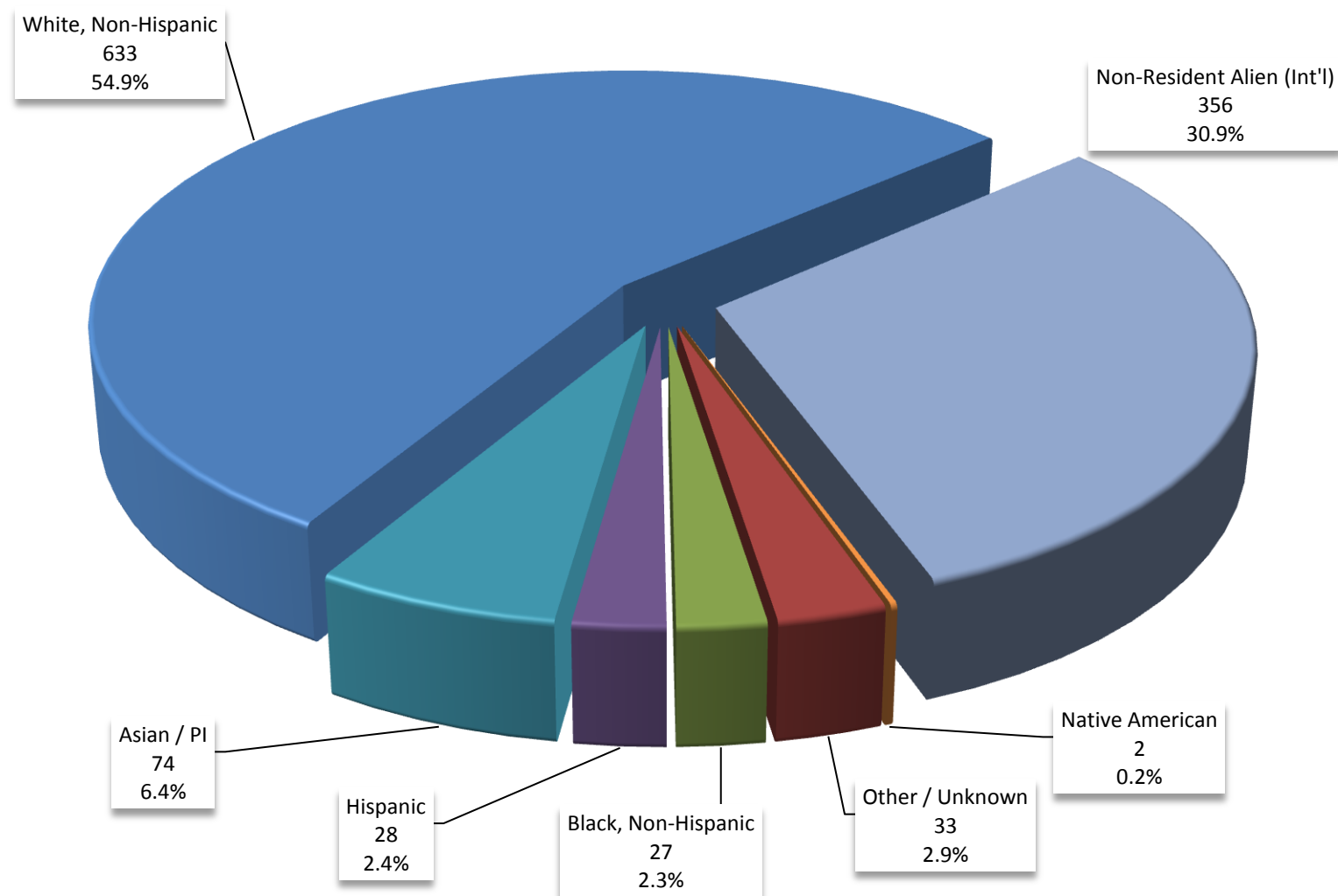

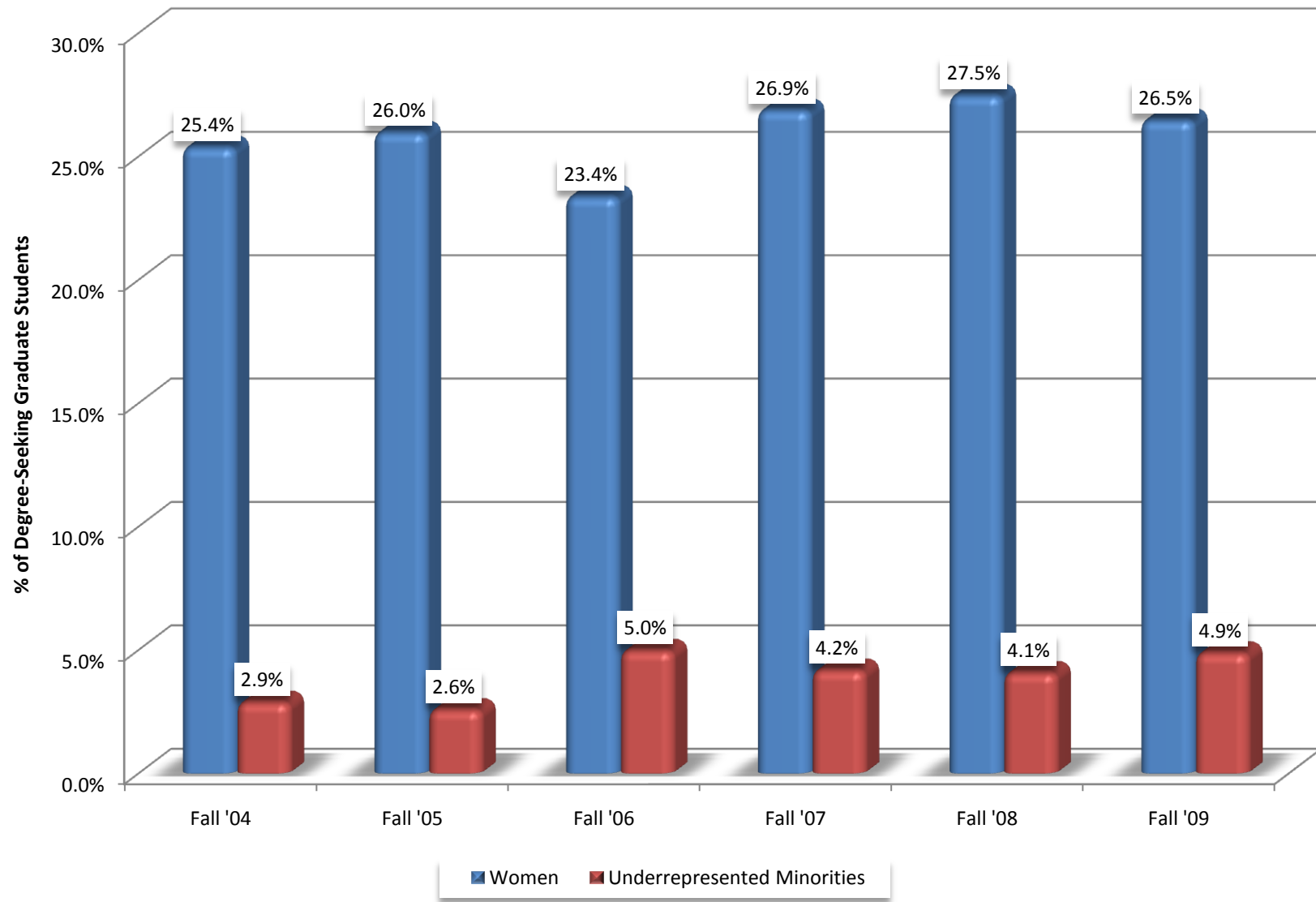
