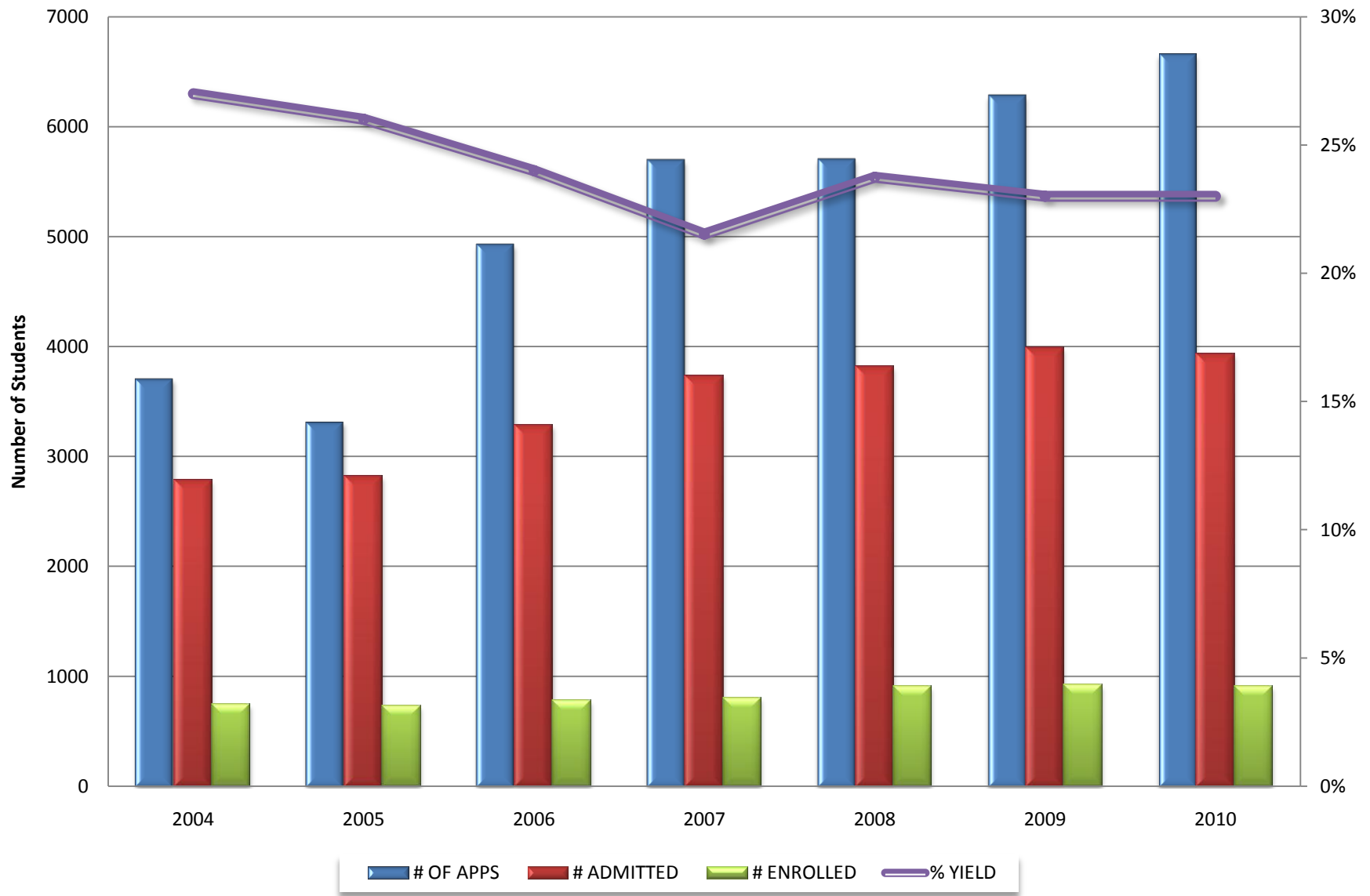

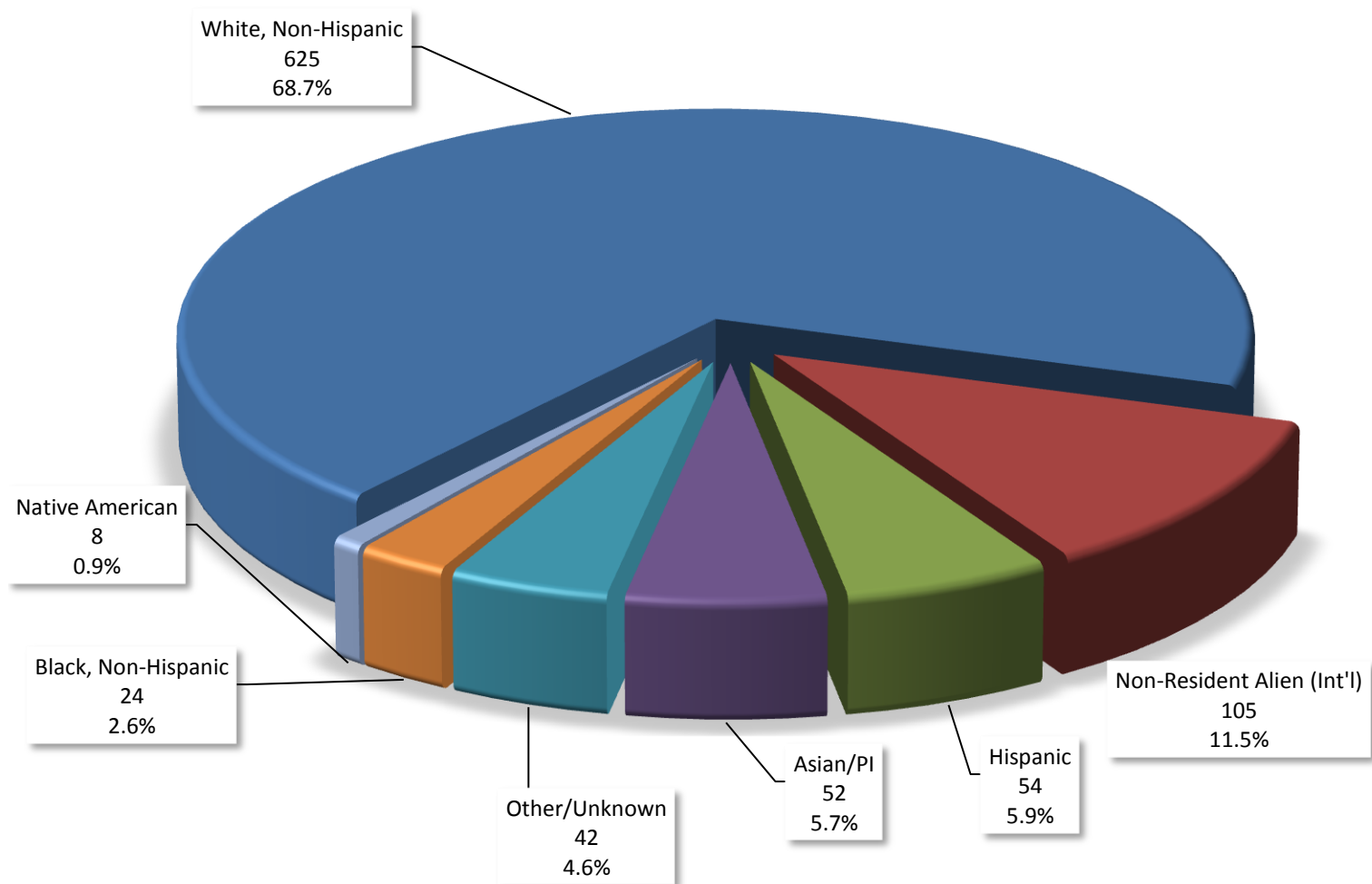

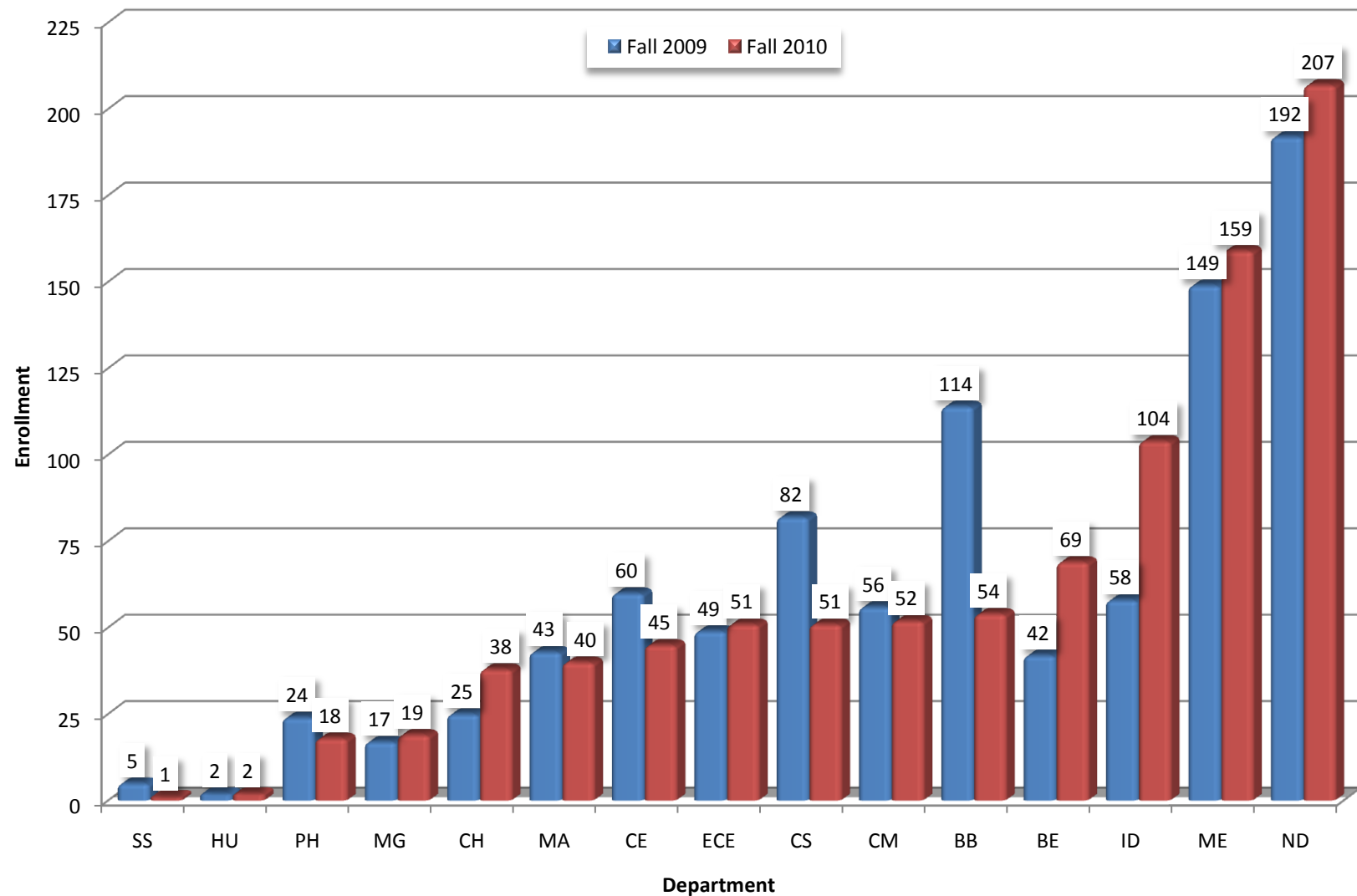
First-Time, Full-Time Freshman Ethnicity, Fall 2010

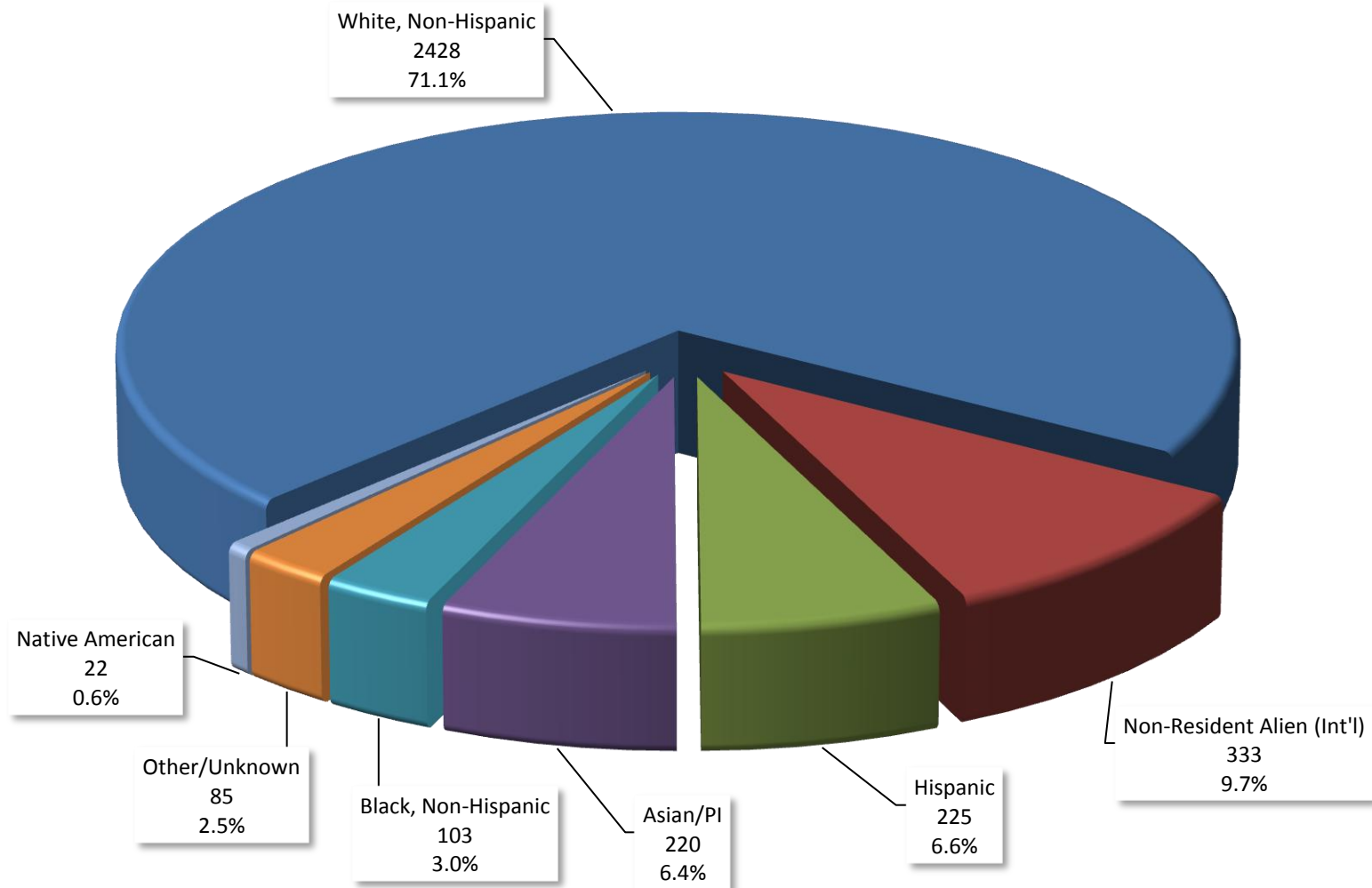

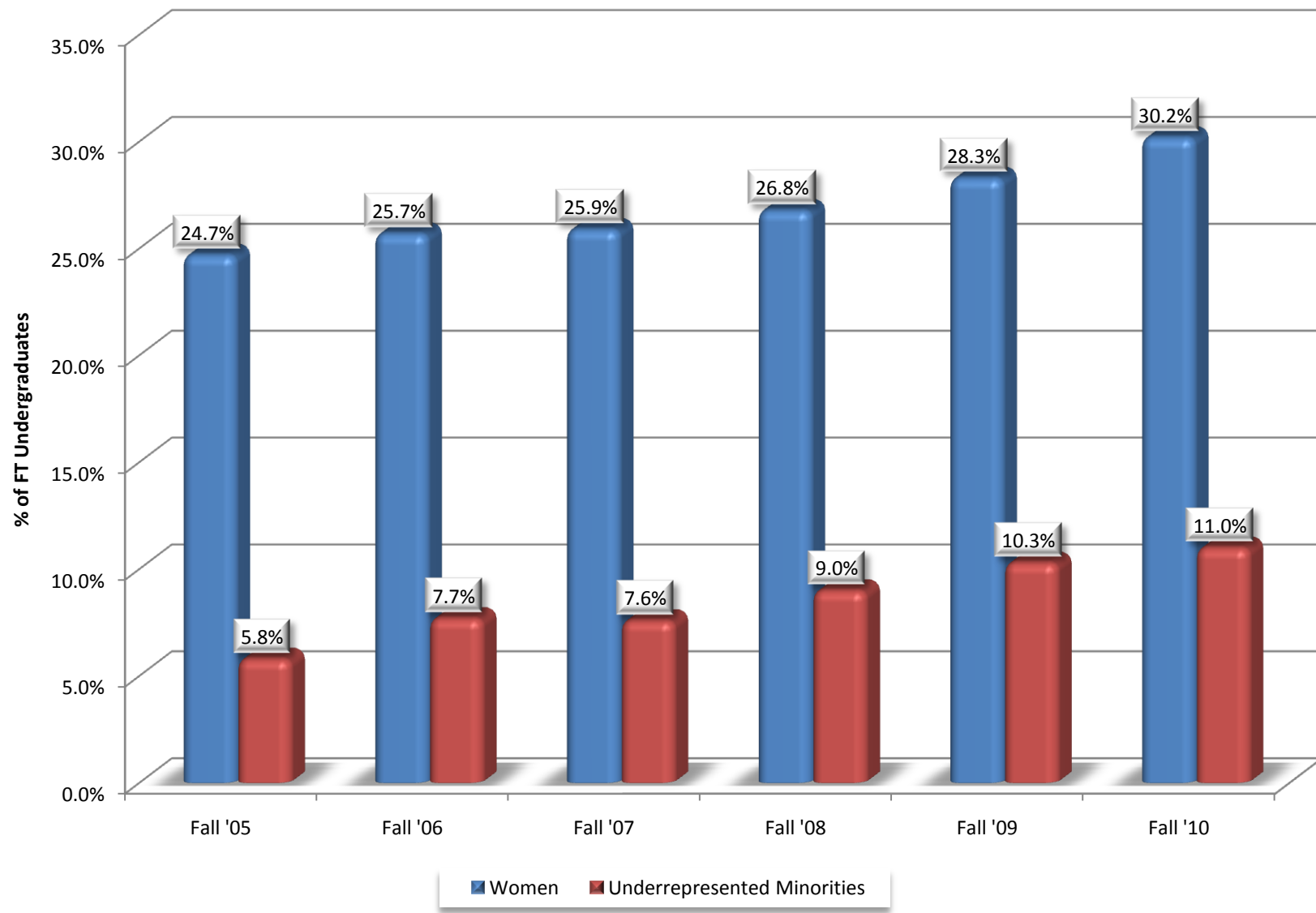

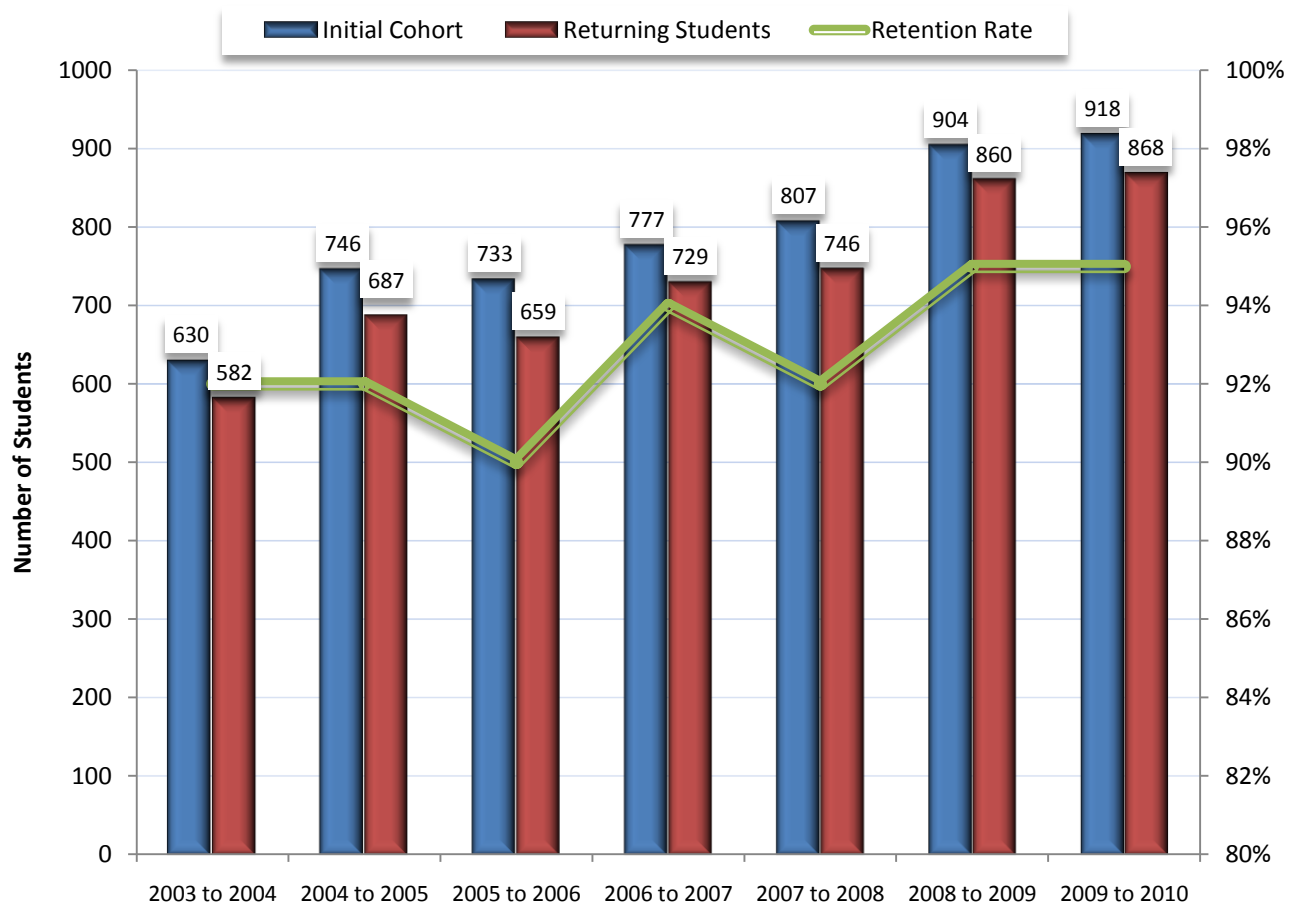

Freshman to Sophomore Retention Rates, 2003 to 2010

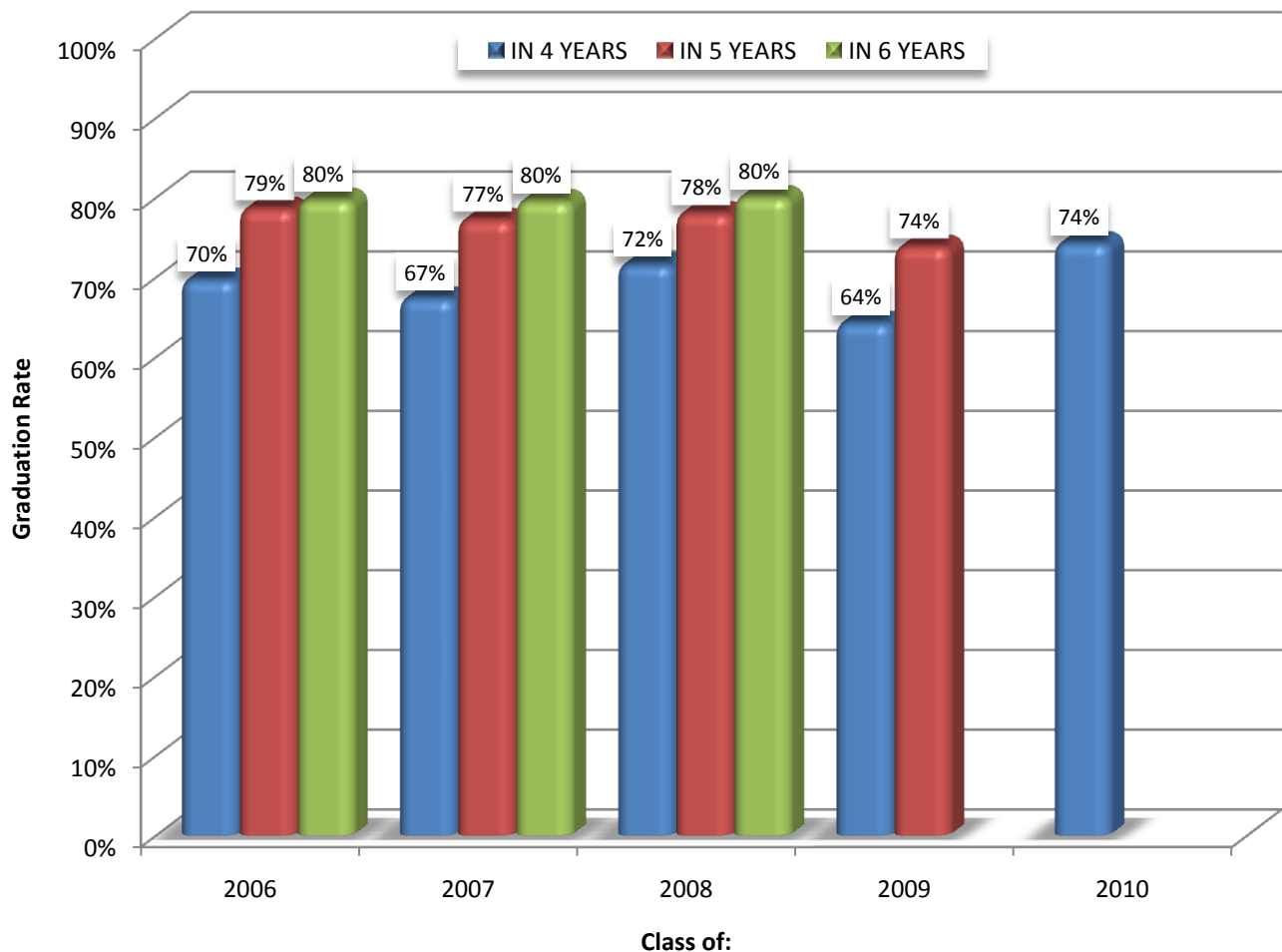

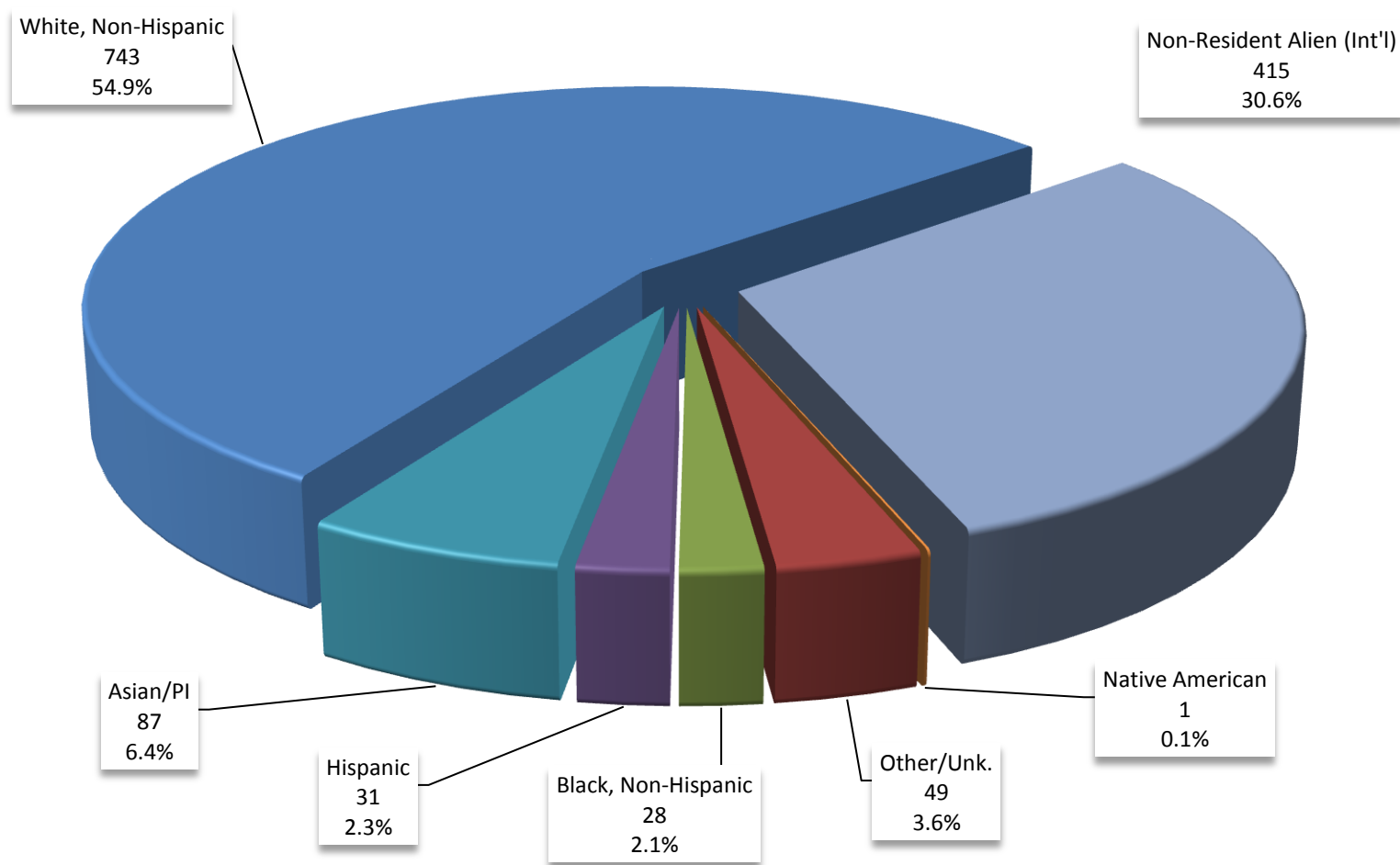

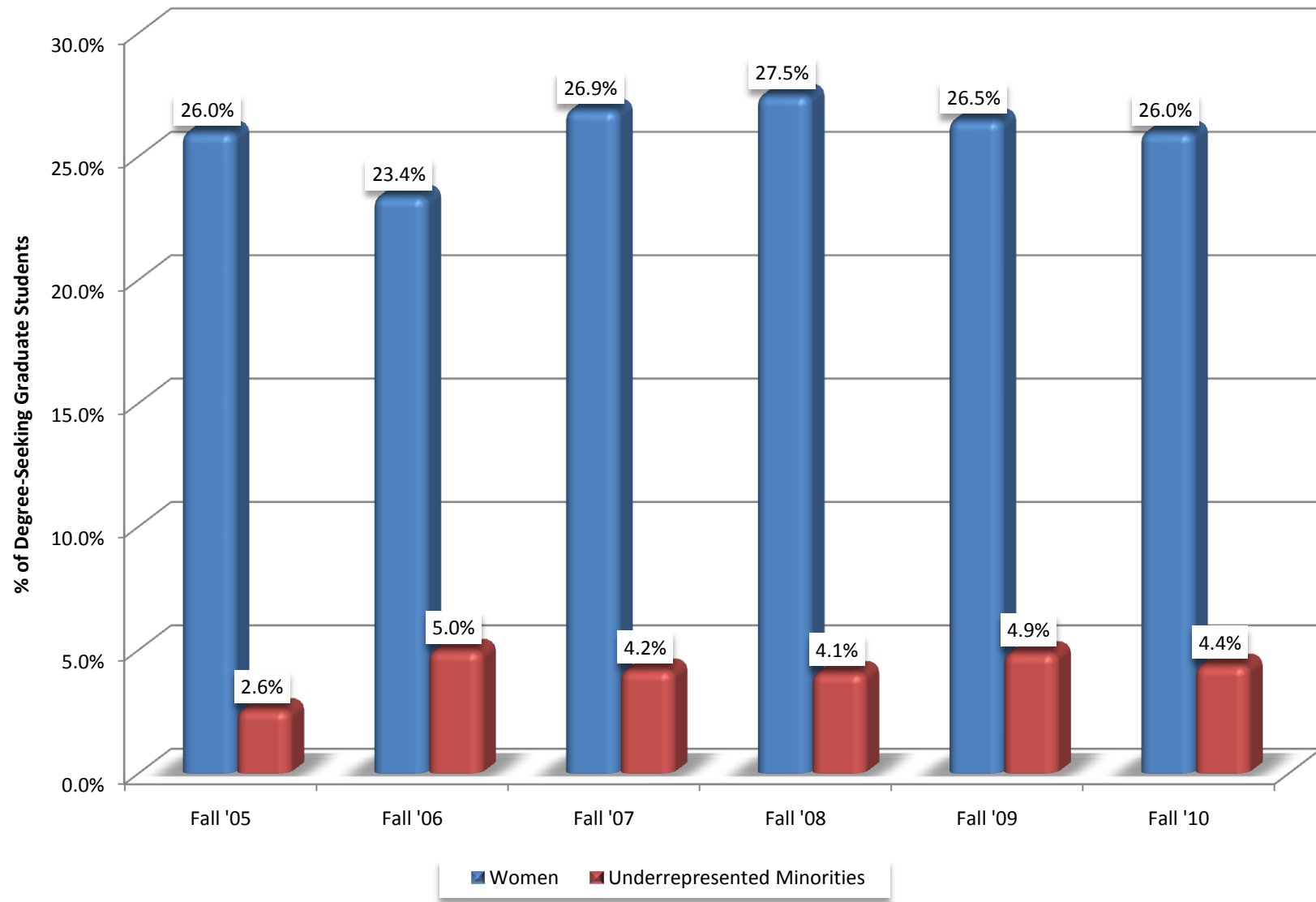
