## Dear Faculty,

The proposal deadline for the National Science Foundation (NSF) Major Research Instrumentation Program (MRI) <a href="https://www.nsf.gov/pubs/2015/nsf15504/nsf15504.htm">http://www.nsf.gov/pubs/2015/nsf15504/nsf15504.htm</a> is January 11, 2017.

The MRI program assists with the acquisition or development of a shared research instrument that is, in general, too costly and/or not appropriate for support through other NSF programs. For the purposes of the MRI program, a proposal must be for *either* acquisition (Track 1) *or* development (Track 2) of a single, well-integrated instrument.

Since the MRI is a limited submission program (no more than 3 proposals per institution, out of which no more than two for instrument acquisition), an internal review process is required.

Faculty member interested in submitting a proposal should provide by October 31, 2016:

- 1. a brief (1-3 pages) abstract of the "project" and
- 2. a budget outline with accompanying narrative explanation. Proposals require a 30% cost-share commitment. Budget outlines must indicate how the cost-share will be accomplished.
