



Accepted Student Days FAQ

Q: When are the Accepted Student Days for 2019?

A: Accepted Student Days will be held April 3, 10 and 17 on the WPI campus.

Q: Will the schedule for each Accepted Student Day be available prior to the event?

A: Yes. Please view the current sample schedule available on the web as an example and the actual schedule for the day will be posted about a week before the event and is subject to change.

Q: What group of students would benefit from the Accepted Student Day?

A: The Accepted Student Day is only for current accepted WPI students for the Class of 2023.

Q: When should I plan to arrive?

A: On-site check-in will begin at 8 AM in the Sports and Recreation Center. We will provide a light breakfast. The welcome will start at 8:30 AM.

Q: Where do I park?

A: Parking is available in our parking garage located at 151 Salisbury St. [View the map of campus for your reference.](#) The parking garage is also adjacent to the Sports and Recreation Center for your convenience. Additional details will be sent a few days prior to the event to the email addresses provided at the time of registration. Please note that a parking permit is not required for these events.

Q: Where do I go if I arrive late?

A: If you arrive between 9:00 am and 11:00 am please still check in at the Sports & Recreation Center. After 11:00 am, please check in at the Bartlett Center.

Q: Can I pay my deposit to join WPI's Class of 2023 on Accepted Student Day?

A: Yes! Please visit the Bartlett Center and a member of the Admissions Staff will assist you in paying your deposit.

Q: If I am unable to stay for the full duration of Accepted Student Day, can I still attend?

A: Absolutely! Our program officially ends at 4:00 PM but we understand that some of our guests may need to leave early.

Q: Can I bring a guest(s) with me to Accepted Student Day?

A: We encourage you to bring parents, siblings, guardians or other guests to accompany you to the Accepted Student Day. We ask that you indicate how many guests you are bringing with you upon registering.

Q: Will I have Internet access?

A: Yes, on-campus wireless will be available for all our guests. This information will be located in your program booklet given to you upon your arrival.

Q: Will I be able to learn about my intended major?

A: Yes, most majors will offer a presentation during the program.

Q: Will campus tours be offered?

A: Yes, campus tours and resident hall tours will be offered throughout the day.

Q: Does WPI accommodate special dietary concerns?

A: Chartwells at WPI accommodates nearly all food allergy and dietary concerns. Shavaun Cloran, WPI's Registered Dietician, will be available during the event for any specific questions or concerns.

Q: Does WPI accommodate accessibility requests?

A: Absolutely.
