INTERNSHIP (CPT) DATA SCIENCE GUIDELINES

OBJECTIVE

- The Internship program is an integral component of the Data Science degree intended to augment the Data Science students' professional development and career readiness.
- > The right balance between an internship and course coverage ensures the highest quality training of WPI Data Science graduating students

GUIDELINES

- 1. The maximum number of internship credits that can count towards your degree is 3.
- 2. Registering for an internship with **0** credits is allowed only after using the **3** credits that will count towards your degree
- 3. All internships must be relevant to the Data Science major.
- 4. Full-time internships during the MS degree are expected to be done during the summer semester.
- 5. During a full-time internship, students may register for at most 1 course.
- 6. During a full-time internship, students *may not register for a GQP*.
- 7. During a part-time internship, students may register for at most 2 courses.
- 8. During a part-time internship, students *may take GQP*, but no other courses concurrently.
- 9. A part-time internship is at most **20** hours a week.
- 10. Student must register for graduate internship course designated **DS5900**.
- 11. Student must submit all forms below electronically on the DS Graduate System.
 - Plan of Study
 - Official Offer Letter which must specify exact (or max) number of work hours per week
 - Unofficial WPI Transcript
 - Graduate Internship Registration Form
