The Media Arts minor is for students who have a serious interest in multimedia and digital art\*. The Media Art minor includes a series of courses in visual/graphic arts, film/video, audio arts, and art history.

A Media Art Minor requires completion of 2 units of work in art distributed as follows:

- 1. 3/3 unit of visual art <u>production</u> courses (usually AR).
- 2. 1/3 unit in visual art, critical studies in art, or audio arts directly related to digital media production.
- 3. 1/3 unit in Art History.
- 4. 1/3 unit Visual Art Capstone Experience. This can be either a 1/3 unit Independent Study/Project in visual art or a 3000-level course approved by the student and advisor. The capstone course must be taken last.
