Types of Funding

Grant

 A grant is used when the sponsor anticipates no substantial programmatic involvement with the recipient during the performance of the project. Grants are among the most flexible award mechanisms.

Cooperative Agreement

 A cooperative agreement is used when the purpose of the project is similar to that of a grant, **but** substantial programmatic involvement of, or coordination by, the funding agency is anticipated.

Subaward/Subcontract

— The transferring of a substantive portion of the research/program effort of the prime award to another institution or organization.

Types of Funding

Contract

 A contract is used when the principal purpose is to provide a prescribed service or "good" for the direct benefit or use of the funding agency.

Consulting

 A consultant is an independent contractor engaged to provide expert advice or services, typically for short or intermittent time periods.

Gift

 Unlike funds governed by agreements, gifts are awarded irrevocably and, generally, without contractual requirements.

Types of Funding Announcements

- Broad Agency Announcement (BAA)
 - An announcement of a federal agency's general research interests. Invites proposals, and specifies general terms and conditions for award.
- Program Announcement/Program Solicitation (PA/PS)
 - Announcement of sponsor's intent to support a general area of research, or some other activity, that furthers the goals and mission of the sponsor.
- Request for Application (RFA)
 - An announcement that indicates the availability of funds in a more "specific," or "targeted" area of interest to the sponsor.
- Request for Proposal (RFP)
 - An announcement that specifies a topic of research, methods, product delivery, and category of applicants.

Highlights

- In 2014, U.S. academic institutions spent \$63.7 billion on research and development in all Science & Engineering fields.
- Research collaboration involving multiple institutions and fields (collaborative and interdisciplinary research) mirrors recent trends in overall academic R&D.
- Six agencies (DHHS, NSF, DoD, DoE, NASA, DoA) provided over 92% of federal support for academic R&D in Science & Engineering in 2014.

Figure 3.3: FY2015 Award \$ by Sponsor Type






Figure 3.4: Federal Award \$ by Sponsor, FY2015



Contact Your Program Officer


- Program priorities can shift over time, sometimes substantially, while published materials remain unchanged.
- A PO's candid, informal response to the proposal's core theme is the best predictor of success, even though no guarantee is expressed or implied.
- PO's can and often do give valuable advice on matters related to program track, budget, collaborations, and project structure.
- If the proposed project is not a good fit with the identified program, the PO can often suggest better alternatives.


Grant Range: \$87,000-\$102,000 over two years


