## 2018-2019 Academic Year

WPI has entered into an agreement with the Department of Veterans Affairs to participate in the Yellow Ribbon Program during the 2017-2018 academic year. WPI will award a total of 2 graduate students a WPI Yellow Ribbon Scholarship <u>up to</u> \$10,000 per academic year (fall and spring semesters only). Funds will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis determined by the date of receipt of all completed application requirements. To receive benefits under the Yellow Ribbon Program:

- 1). You must submit an application for Post 9/11 benefits to the Department of Veterans Affairs. You will receive a Certificate of Eligibility explaining the VA's decision regarding your eligibility for the Yellow Ribbon program.
