WPI Yellow Ribbon Program Application ***Undergraduate students***

WPI has entered into an agreement with the Department of Veterans Affairs to participate in the Yellow Ribbon Program during the 2021-2022 academic year. WPI will award a total of 10 undergraduate students a WPI Yellow Ribbon Scholarship up to \$5,000 per academic year (fall and spring semesters only). Funds will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis determined by the date of receipt of all completed application requirements. To receive benefits under the Yellow Ribbon Program:
